Subject: Request for review of PDC Order, Case 38939

Dear Commissioners,

On October 9 I received a PDC Order for Case 38939 that presented various Findings of Fact and concluding that I failed to file an F-1 report by April 16, 2018 as required. The Order further imposed a penalty of \$250 and imposed a requirement to file the missing F-1 report.

I would like to respectfully correct several errors in the Findings of Fact and request that the penalty be eliminated. Further, I respectfully assert that I do not currently have any outstanding obligation to file any additional F-1 reports.

Regarding Finding of Fact number 1, it is stated that I am a candidate for SCHOOL DIRECTOR of MERIDIAN SD 505. This is not true. I resigned my position on the Meridian School Board as of June 2017 and I am not currently a candidate for that office. Indeed, no SCHOOL DIRECTOR positions for MERIDIAN SD 505 are currently up for election this year. As evidence that I am not a candidate for this position, I am enclosing a sample ballot for Whatcom County as available on the county auditor's website.

Regarding Finding of Fact number 2, it is stated that as a candidate for election I was required to file an F-1 report by April 16, 2018. Since I am not a candidate for election, I respectfully submit that this Finding of Fact is in error. In fact, I did have an obligation to file an F-1 report by April 16, 2018 because my term ended partway through 2017. However, I was not aware of this requirement and mistakenly understood that the F-1 that I filed in 2017 covered the end of my school board term, that ended in June 2017. I was apparently sent reminders to file my F-1, but those reminders were sent to my old Meridian School Board e-mail address that no longer functioned after June 2017. Therefore, I did not receive notifications or reminders that I had a requirement to submit an F-1 by April 16, 2018. As evidence of this, I am enclosing a copy of a letter that was provided by the Meridian School District attesting to the disposition of my school district e-mail.

Regarding Finding of Fact number 3, it is stated that I did not file my missing F-1 prior to the date of my PDC hearing. In fact, I did file my 2017 F-1 report on August 22, 2018. A copy of that report is enclosed.

Regarding Finding of Fact number 4, it is stated that I have no prior violations. I agree with this Finding of Fact.

The Conclusions of Law are based on incorrect Findings of Fact. Therefore, I respectfully submit that the Conclusions of Law are therefore erroneous for the above-described reasons.

Based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, an Order is given requiring me to pay a penalty of \$250, to "cease and desist" from failing to file F-1 reports, and to file the missing F-1 report by November 5, 2018. Since the order is based on erroneous Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, I respectfully request that the Order be vacated.

Proposition 2018-5 Low-Income Housing Levy

The City of Bellingham Council adopted Resolution No. 2018- 09 concerning property taxes for low-income housing and related services.

This proposition would replace and enhance existing levies to fund housing and housing services for people with low or very low incomes by authorizing a (1) property tax increase of \$0.12/\$1,000 in assessed valuation (to \$2.25/\$1,000) for collection in 2019-2028 (the 2019 amount would be used to compute the limitations for subsequent levies for collection in 2020-2028); and (2) regular property tax levy of up to \$0.24/\$1,000 under RCW 84.52.105; each for ten years, together generating \$4,000,000 annually.

Ferndale School District 502

Proposition 2018-7 General Obligation Bonds - \$112,000,000

The Board of Directors of Ferndale School District 502 adopted Resolution No. 5-2018 authorizing bonds to fund several capital projects. This proposition authorizes the District to (1) construct and equip a new high school facility to replace the existing Ferndale High School, modernize the Performing Arts Center and provide for Districtwide critical maintenance, safety and security needs including controlled building access and LED security lighting; (2) issue \$112,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 22 years, and (3) levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as provided in Resolution #5-2018.

Proposition 2018-4 Authorizing Increase of Property Tax Levy


