Box 2065, Wenathee, WA 98807 for failure to file campaign reports as required by the PDC. They have been supporting advertising for the two challengers in the Douglas County Commissioners Races, District 1, Carol Kavanaugh, www.carolkavanaugh.org; and District 2, Ed Daling, www.eddaling.org. Radio ads have been running for Ed Daling since August of this year. His flyers were paid for by the PAC and came out several weeks ago, which means they were in progress even more weeks ago. Newspaper advertising has been running in the Wenatchee World for both for quite some time. I can track down information on local media for you if you wish.

I called Mr. Tony Perkins on the PDC line last week, he told me that he had contacted the NCHBA PAC, "Affordable Housing Council," had been filing regularly weekly reports in the mail, they must have been lost. Undoubtedly the dog ate their homework in school as well. Their C1pc shows that they registered on Jan. 12, 2012, and checked off full reporting.

Please feel free to contact me at 509-683-1949. If you cannot reach me at this home number, you may use my cell 509-679-4822; the home number has better reception in the country. I want to compliment Mr. Perkins, he is a wonderful representative of your office. I hope the PDC will be able to investigate and take action on this matter; as a concerned citizen, I am more than tired of special interest groups, in this case the dominant special interest group in the area, buying elected officials, and there is no doubt that is what is happening here.

We are in receipt of your letter, dated March 21, 2013, informing our organization of the complaint filed by Ms. Humphrey. We appreciate the opportunity to respond to the allegations stated in Ms. Humphrey's attached complaint filed on October 29, 2012.

I will begin by stating that the North Central Affordable Housing Council (NCAHC) has always respected the requirements laid out in Washington State's Public Disclosure Law, as well as the PDC's efforts to help ensure compliance of these requirements. As such, we have always strove to ensure that the NCAHC remains compliant.

My assistant, Kim Fenner, is designated as our PDC contact—meaning that she is responsible for completing our PDC reporting requirements on an ongoing basis. Until an inquiry with Jennifer Hansen on **September 14, 2012**, we had been completing our reports manually and submitting them in hardcopy via the postal service.

On that date, I visited the PDC website in order to research a few items. In doing so, I noted that our report information was not posted, which precipitated Kim's call to Jennifer that morning. According to Kim's notes of that conversation (attached), Jennifer looked under various possible scenarios of names under which our reports may have been filed, but could not find any of them under any of the search criteria used. She indicated that there was no explanation as to why the PDC would not have our reports.

At that point, Kim asked what we needed to do to remedy the situation. Jennifer explained that it would be best to get the NCAHC setup using the online reporting option, and then to go back and reenter the information included in our hardcopy reports from the beginning of 2012. Jennifer assisted Kim in getting the ORCA software setup and our online account established.

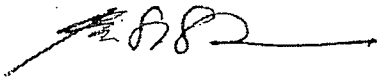

I thoroughly reject Ms. Humphrey's off-the-cuff, "undoubtedly the dog ate their homework" remark. Our reports were originally submitted, and were submitted punctually. As for Ms. Humphrey's assertion that we're, "buying elected officials", well, if supporting candidates in elections has become something akin to "buying candidates", I can only respond by stating that, while that may be her perception, those of us who work hard to support candidates we believe in, don't share her point of view.

Again, I sincerely thank you for the opportunity to respond to this complaint. I hope that my response—along with the supporting documents I included—help to provide added clarity as the PDC staff completes their investigation of Ms. Humphrey's allegations. 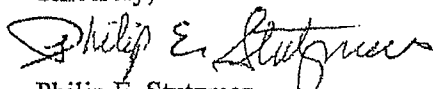

Enclosed is a copy of a complaint received October 29, 2012 from Kathy Humphrey alleging that North Central Affordable Housing Council (NCAHC) violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to report its contributions and expenditures. The complaint noted that NCAHC registered as a political committee on January 12, 2012 but had failed to report its contributions and expenditures on Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) and Campaign Summary Receipts & Expenditures reports (C-4 reports). The complaint alleged that NCAHC had been sponsoring political advertising in support of two candidates for Douglas County Commissioner, Carol Kavanaugh and Ed Daling, without reporting the expenditures on its C-4 reports.

PDC staff will investigate Ms. Humphrey's allegations and notify you of the results when the investigation is complete. To assist our investigation, please respond to the allegations in writing by April 4, 2012. When PDC staff member Tony Perkins spoke with you on October 29, 2012, you indicated that paper copies of the committee's reports had been mailed to the PDC. If the reports were previously filed, please provide copies of the paper-filed reports.

Good Morning NCAHC Trustees,

I just became aware of an issue and I want you to be aware of, too. As NCAHC treasurer, Ryan Kelso has been approached by both KPQ and the PDC regarding the NCAHC reports with the PDC. Specifically, the representative with the PDC indicated that there have been a couple recent "inquiries" related to our lack of reports relative to our contribution activities. He specifically cited that a radio station had been "nosing around".

Steve Hair—news director for KPQ—contacted both Ryan and me, seeking comment on a story that they're obviously trying to drum up a story—specifically, citing our support of Carol Kavanaugh. We have been manually completing our required reports in hardcopy format. In one of my recent reviews of the PDC website, it came to my attention that our reports were not represented on their site. I had Kim contact the PDC a few weeks ago to inquire as to why none of our reports were posted.

After much discussion, this PDC representative indicated that they could find none of our reports and couldn't understand why. This representative got Kim signed-up to use the PDC's new online reporting system and instructed Kim to "resubmit" all our reports since the first of the year. Kim has been doing that and will be finished today. I had Kim contact the PDC representative that left a message for Ryan, making him aware of the fact that she has been working with Jennifer (another PDC representative) on this issue in order to get it remedied. In that conversation, he indicated to her that there have not been any complaints yet, but that a radio station has been "nosing around" and that we needed to be aware.

I wish that I could say that this tact by Steve Hair (and, presumably, Ken Stanton) surprises me, but it doesn't. As soon as I heard Ken Stanton recently refer to the NCAHC as nothing more than "the Builders' Super PAC", I felt that there would be an effort to try to make a story. I have absolutely no idea how the PDC would have "lost" our submitted reports, but we have been proactively working with them to get the situation resolved.

Dear Mr. Stutzman,

I am writing as a follow-up to my letter, dated March 27, 2013, specific to being informed that a complaint had been filed with the PDC against the North Central Affordable Housing Council (NCAHC).

Last Friday afternoon, I received a courtesy call from Mr. Young, informing me that the PDC staff had completed their investigation of this complaint, and that, as a result of the investigation, the PDC would be filing charges.

The primary intent of this letter—in addition to reiterating the facts that I stated in my earlier response—is to communicate to you and the Commission, a few points that are very important to me that the Commission consider.

First, I want to convey that our organization never has and never will operate in disregard of the established laws and rules. While that may seem a trite statement, I assure you that it is not. I have included a couple of email messages (**attachments #1 and #2**) that I sent to my assistant—last September—that I believe give some indication of our desire to follow the PDC's reporting requirements.

As I stated in my March 27 letter, I have no explanation why our reports were not received by the PDC, as outlined in Mr. Young's memorandum. However, I attest that my assistant—Kim Fenner—prepared these reports and submitted them according to the required reporting timelines. I've included copies of those original reports with this letter (**attachments #3, #4, #5 and #6**) for your review. I further attest that there is no mal-intent, or wonton disregard by our PAC.

Hindsight being twenty-twenty, I should have included protocol measures to ensure that our reports were being received and posted. In doing so, I would have been aware of any deficiencies far sooner. I did not regularly visit and view the PDC website until last September, when I began doing so because of our increased activity in supporting a couple local candidates in the 2012 Primary and General Elections.

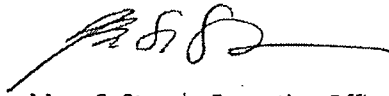

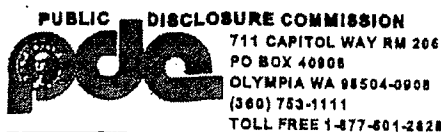

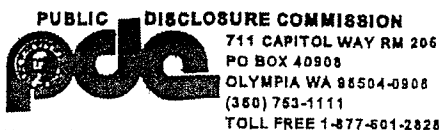
