I. Background, Complaint and Allegations

- 1.1 Jennifer Tyler (Tyler) was a 2018 candidate seeking the office of Chelan County Sheriff. Tyler was a first-time candidate in 2018.
- 1.2 On September 9, 2018, Tyler filed a Candidate Registration (C-1) with the PDC declaring her 2018 candidacy for Chelan County Sheriff, establishing the Tyler for Sheriff Campaign (Campaign) and selecting the Full Reporting Option. The only officer listed on the C-1 report was Laurie Smith, Treasurer.
- 1.3 On July 16, 2019, Glen Morgan filed a complaint with the PDC alleging "the Campaign violated campaign finance laws by accepting more than \$300 in anonymous contributions from donors. Specifically, it appears that she accepted \$721.25 in anonymous contributions, which is \$421.25 more than the allowable anonymous contribution limit defined in RCW 42.17A.220 (4)." Exhibit #1
- 1.4 On October 7, 2019, the PDC held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing) After Opening a Formal Investigation for Tyler, PDC Case 54838. Tyler did not participate in the hearing.
- 1.5 Tyler did not respond to the original complaint, however upon repeated requests from the PDC, she responded on October 7, 2019, via e-mail stating, "I have located the donor information for the funds. What do I do?". One day later, on October 9, 2019, she sent an image to the PDC of return envelopes, which she stated were the addresses of those donors. Exhibit #2
- 1.6 As noted above, Tyler was a first-time candidate in 2018, and after receiving 620 write-in ballots in the August 7, 2018 Primary Election, registered with the PDC. Tyler was not elected to the position of Chelan County Sheriff in the November 2018 General Election, receiving 35.59 percent of the 32,125 votes cast.

II. Investigative Findings

- 2.1 PDC statutes, rules and reporting requirements state that a person becomes a candidate when they do one of these things: accept a contribution or spend money for that person's campaign; reserve space or purchase advertising to promote that person's candidacy; authorize someone else to do any of such activities on behalf of that person; state publicly that the person is seeking office; or file a declaration of candidacy.
- 2.2 Candidates who selected the Full Reporting option, and participated in the 2018 general election, were required to comply with the following:
 - Monetary contributions must be deposited into the committee bank account within five business days of receipt, and the Campaign is required to file one Monetary Contribution (C-3) report for each bank deposit. Monthly C-3 reports are due by the 10th of each month disclosing contributions received and deposited during the previous calendar month, and weekly C-3 reports are required every Monday beginning June 1, for contributions received and deposited the previous five business days.
 - ➤ A 21-day Pre-General Election Summary Full Campaign Contributions and Expenditures report (C-4 report) was required to be filed by October 16, 2018, covering the period September 1 through October 15, 2018; a 7-day Pre-General Election C-4 report was required to be filed by October 30, 2018 covering the period October 16 through October 29, 2018; and a 2018 Post-General Election C-4 report due no later than December 10, 2018 covering the period October 30 through November 30, 2018.
 - ➤ In addition, Last Minute Contribution reports (LMC) are required to be filed for the 21-Day period prior to the 2018 general election covering the period October 16 through November 5, 2018, if the campaign receives contributions of \$1,000 or more from one source during that timeframe.
- 2.3 The anonymous contribution limitations are found in RCW 42.17A.220(4), which states in part that aggregate anonymous or unidentified contributions that are received by a candidate in any election are limited to one percent of the total monetary and in-kind contributions received in the current calendar year once the campaign exceeds \$30,000 in total contributions, or three hundred dollars.
 - Anonymous contributions may not be deposited or spent but instead are required to be returned to the contributor provided his or her identity can be ascertained. If the donor cannot be ascertained, the contribution shall escheat to the state and shall be paid to the state treasurer for deposit in the state general fund.
 - ➤ The Campaign filed three C-4 reports during the 2018 general election, which included one amended C-4 report. The initial C-4 report covered the period of September 9 through October 15, 2018 and was timely filed September 19, 2018, and then timely amended October 16, 2018. This C-4 report covered a portion of the 21-Day Pre-General C-4 reporting period. Exhibit #3
 - ➤ On November 1, the Campaign filed the 7-Day Pre-General Election C-4 report covering the period October 16 through 29, 2018, disclosing \$18,273.87 in total monetary contributions received, \$13,962.11 in total expenditures made, cash on hand of \$4,311.76, and \$6,000 for candidate in-kind loans. The 7-Day Pre-General Election C-4 report was filed two days late. **Exhibit #4**

- ➤ The Campaign filed a total of nine C-3 reports during the 2018 Election. On October 29, 2018, the Campaign filed a C-3 report disclosing the receipt of a \$673 anonymous contribution that had been received and deposited on October 22, 2018.
- ➤ The C-3 reports disclosed that the Campaign received a total of \$721.25 in total aggregate anonymous contributions as of October 29, 2018, which exceeded the \$300 anonymous contribution limits by \$421.25. Exhibit #5
- ➤ The Campaign exceeded the anonymous contribution limits by \$421.25 and failed to either re-attribute the anonymous contributions or escheat them to the WA State General Fund in accordance with RCW 42.17A.220(4).
- ➤ The Campaign failed to file the statutorily required Post-General Election C-4 report, due no later than December 10, 2018.

III. Scope

- 3.1 PDC Staff reviewed the following:
 - > The complaint filed by Glen Morgan.
 - ➤ Telephone conversations and email communications with Jennifer Tyler (Candidate) and Laurie Smith (Treasurer).
 - > C-1, C-3, C-4 reports filed by the Tyler for Sheriff Campaign covering the 2018 general election.
 - ➤ The PDC database for Tyler for Sheriff Campaign contribution and expenditure information covering the 2018 general election cycle.
- 3.2 Chronology of PDC staffs attempted contacts with the Campaign concerning the complaint:
 - An email was sent July 17, 2019 with attached complaint sent to Campaign email address listed on the C-1. No response was received.
 - A phone call was made to July 25, 2019 to Laurie Smith, who provided a current phone number for Tyler. A call was placed to Tyler, but there was no answer and no option to leave a voicemail.
 - An email was sent July 25 with attached complaint to email address found through searching PDC records. A telephone voicemail response was received the evening of July 30, 2019.
 - > Staff spoke with Jennifer Tyler on July 31, 2019, outlining the complaint and detailing actions needed to bring Campaign into compliance.
 - An email was sent to Jennifer Tyler on July 31, 2019, following up on the phone call conversation held the same day, and detailing actions needed to bring the Campaign into compliance.
 - Emails were sent August 20 and August 27, 2019, requesting a response to the July 31, 2019 email. No response was received.

- ➤ A hearing notice for Notice of Case Status Review (Initial Hearing) sent October 2, 2019. No response was received.
- ➤ The Notice of Case Status Review (Initial Hearing) results were sent October 7, 2019. A response was received October 7, 2019, asking how to resolve the complaint.
- ➤ Emails were sent to Tyler October 8, 2019, noting she needed to follow the directions of staff's July 31, 2019 email.
- An email was received from Tyler on October 8, 2019, providing an image and information stating this was the donor and asking for additional time as she was travelling out of state to deal with a death in the family.
- In total, emails were sent and phone calls were made to Tyler in November 2019 and January, May, June and September 2020. The emails and phone calls requested Tyler complete the actions requested by the PDC. No response was received.

IV. Statutes

RCW 42.17A.220(4) states in part that "accumulated unidentified contributions ..., in excess of one percent of the total accumulated contributions received in the current calendar year, or three hundred dollars, whichever is more, may not be deposited, used, or expended, but shall be returned to the donor if his or her identity can be ascertained. If the donor cannot be ascertained, the contribution shall escheat to the state and shall be paid to the state treasurer for deposit in the state general fund." Candidates are advised to closely monitor the aggregate anonymous contributions received throughout a calendar year, to ensure that the \$300 or one percent limitations are not exceeded.

RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 require candidates to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures. Under the full reporting option, until five months before the election, C-3 and C-4 reports are required monthly when contributions or expenditures exceed \$200 since the last report; on the twenty-first day and the seventh day immediately preceding the date on which the election is held; and on the tenth day of the first month after the election.

Complaint Description

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that Jennifer Tyler during her 2018 campaign for the Chelan County Sheriff's office violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**).

1) Accepting Illegal Over limit Anonymous Contributions (Violation of RCW 42.17A.220 (4))

Tyler violated Washington State's campaign finance laws by accepting more than \$300 in anonymous contributions from donors. Specifically, it appears that she accepted \$721.25 in anonymous contributions, which is \$421.25 more than the allowable anonymous contribution limit defined in **RCW 42.17A.220 (4)**.

Upon reviewing the expenditures by this candidate's political committee, there is no evidence supporting any claim these funds were eschewed to the Treasury of the State of Washington as is required in law. Therefore this is a violation of the statute, and these funds should be immediately forfeited to the Washington State Treasury.

I've attached the relevant C3 contribution reports which detail all the anonymous contributions received by this committee during the 2018 calendar year. **This candidate must forfeit \$421.25 to the Washington State Treasury immediately**. In this way, these funds can be squandered along with the rest of the general fund tax dollars, but at least this forfeiture of anonymous dark money funds may discourage others from doing the same in the future.

This candidate and the campaign committee should be warned about not taking secretive, dark money anonymously to fund political campaigns. This is a serious violation of Washington's State campaign finance laws and counter to the spirit and intention of transparency in the political process.

The public has a right to have candidates for political office who do not fund their political campaigns by secretive, anonymous dark money funding as this campaign chose to do. This

At least it will send a message to future dark money anonymous donors that their money is not welcome, even in campaigns like this one.

Hi Jennifer, Per our phone conversations and the email sent July 31, in your case, if you do know who made the contribution, it must be listed on a C-3 report or returned to the contributor. Knowingly concealing a contribution is a serious offense. Once you make the determination of what you intend to do, it does need to be reported. If you do identify the contributor and keep the contribution, amend the C-3 report listing the anonymous contribution and instead identify the contributor.

If you are either returning the contribution or forfeiting to the state, this should be reported on a C-4 report.

In addition, according to PDC records, your campaign is missing its Post-General C-4 (which was due December 10, 2018) and End of Election cycle C-4 (which was due Jan. 10, 2019).


