WE have carefully reviewed the complaint filed by Cheryl Brown alleging that our 4 X 8 foot campaign signs are out of compliance with RCW 42.17A.320.

Ms Brown alleges; The fails to identify party affiliation and is "deceptive as to her party because the d looks to be part of her name, it is not set apart. I it also looks to be to small as compared to the largest letter on her sign."

After review of RCW 42.17A.320, WAC 390 and the PDC Advertising Guide, we believe our signs are in compliance.

The sign uses a capital D with a space between the Sponsor ID and the Party affiliation clearly setting it apart.

RCW 42.17A.320 refers sponsor ID not party affiliation the party affiliation is not specifically required to be 10% of the size of the largest size letter on the sign. However the upper case D is in fact 10%.

We believe this complaint is a frivolous complaint and request the matter be dropped.
