Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the complaint filed on Oct 26th by Glen Morgan (case #59313). In his complaint, Mr. Morgan has two claims against the Committee to Elect Megan Dunn campaign. Below is our response.

1. The donation from UFCW 21 PAC was reported: <http://web.pdc.wa.gov/rptimg/default.aspx?repno=100940866>
2. Out of the eight print expenses that the campaign has made and reported, only a few had accidentally been submitted without the numbers printed on the description. Those few, minor examples have been updated and reports amended the same day we received the complaint from the PDC.

We believe that the small handful of issues in #2 are technical corrections that were promptly handled and do not constitute violations of the law.
