I'd like to submit a possible reporting violation. I don't think 38th LD State Senate candidates Bruce Overstreet and Savio Pham are accurately reporting their contributions and expenditures. Overstreet has not reported any contributions or expenditures even though he's had a donate button live on his site for weeks (https://votebruceoverstreet.com/donate/) and has solicited donations on his Facebook page

(https://www.facebook.com/ElectBOverstreet/posts/206824456814909). In addition to website expenses, Overstreet has purchased yard signs (https://www.facebook.com/ElectBOverstreet/posts/199257337571621 and https://www.facebook.com/ElectBOverstreet/photos/a.186365225527499.10737 41827.186360748861280/195198844644137/?type=3&theater) and apparently T-Shirts (https://www.facebook.com/ElectBOverstreet/posts/210079379822750). It seems very unlikely he would have no contributions or expenditures to report.

While Savio Pham appears to have accurately reported his contributions, he has not reported any expenditures. In addition to spending on his website (https://www.savioforsenate.com/home), he appears to have had a campaign kickoff/meet and greet

(<u>https://www.facebook.com/SavioforSenate/posts/177032636476341</u> and <u>https://www.facebook.com/events/669151830085078/</u>), which likely required a rental fee or an in-kind donation.

I just wanted to bring this to the attention of the PDC, and see if there was any more information available about whether they are meeting their reporting requirements.

What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

Violates campaign finance laws and has transparency implications. Both candidates are not informing the public of their spending and/or donations thus misleading the public.
