Micaiah Ragins has indicated that a cursory investigation has found that we are indeed missing at least one filing, a post general election report? Is there any other documentation you might need from us? Is there an appropriate way to file that extremely late report besides ORCA? Is there even a point in filing it so late?

Upon reading the attached complaint, I have found that the only accusation of law breaking contained in this screed, and it is a screed, is that there may have been malicious withholding of information from the PDC.

No officer, or treasurer, of the PAC, ever knowingly withheld information from the PDC. Any errors found, are just that, errors. Any efforts required to correct them to the satisfaction of the PDC will be made if requested.

Should the PDC choose to investigate further, we will cooperate to the best of our abilities with that investigation.
