The following letter and attachments are the response to the allegations made by Conner Edwards against the Tye for Thurston Campaign.

Tye Menser's in-kind contribution of \$1178.28 for his filing fee was inadvertently filed as a contribution from the candidate's personal funds on 5/14/2018. This type of accounting error was made for an additional in-kind contribution of \$145.90 from the candidate that was filed on that same date. Those transactions are reflected as a total contribution from the candidate's personal funds of \$1,324.18 shown on line 1.b from the C3 from 5/14/2018 (please see attached C3).

The C4 for 5/1-5/31 has been amended to show both the in-kind contribution for \$1178.28, and the in-kind contribution for \$145.90 (please see attached C4). The accounting errors on the attached C3 have been deleted.

In my role as the Treasurer for the Tye for Thurston Campaign I have endeavored to be open and transparent about our financial activities. I have used my best understanding of the law to perform this job, and operated without intent to mislead the public in any way.

Please accept my sincere appreciation for the work that is done by the PDC. Thank you for your time in considering my response to these allegations.
