Dear Patrick Barker:

On November 17, 2020, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) disclosing financial activities for calendar year 2019 to the PDC by April 15, 2020.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- Patrick Barker filed a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) with the PDC on November 30, 2020; and
- Patrick Barker completed a Statement of Understanding (SOU) and paid a \$100 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging a violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failing to timely file the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report). The \$100 penalty assessed resolves the allegation listed in your complaint.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
