# File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

Glen Morgan reported (Tue, 5 Jun at 3:03 PM) via Portal Meta

To Whom it May Concern –

It has come to my attention that the candidate for San Juan County prosecutor has failed to abide by **RCW 42.17A.240** and **WAC 390-16-205** by failing to properly break down expenditures made on their behalf by their vendor "TIF and GIF".

On their C4 covering the time period of May

2018 (<a href="http://web.pdc.wa.gov/rptimg/default.aspx?docid=4725476">http://web.pdc.wa.gov/rptimg/default.aspx?docid=4725476</a>), Gaylord's campaign failed to properly itemize the expenditure for website and social media services. Form C4 states the following:

"for each payment to a candidate, campaign worker, PR firm, advertising agency or credit card company, attach a list of detailed expenses or copies of receipts/invoices supporting the payment".

Gaylord's campaign did not attach any document to the list, listing only a payment of \$1000 to Tif And Gif for "website and social media services".

Specifically, the campaign did not account for the domain name purchased by TIF and GIF. (See attached domain registration document indicating the domain was actually purchased by the vendor and not by the campaign.)

The charges for the work performed by TIF and GIF must be properly itemized by the campaign per WAC 390-16-205. (See rule attached.) According to this rule: "expenditures made on behalf of a candidate or political committee by any person, agency, firm, organization, etc. employed or retained for the purpose of organizing, directing, managing or assisting the candidate's or committee's efforts shall be deemed expenditures by the candidate or committee. In accordance with WAC 390-16-037, such expenditures shall be reported by the candidate or committee as if made or incurred by the candidate or committee directly."

The cost of the design work must be separated from the cost of the website and submitted via an amended C4.

It should be noted that Gaylord is an experienced political candidate and the San Juan County Prosecutor. He is knowledgeable about Washington State's campaign finance laws and is even one of the few prosecutors in the State of Washington who has actually brought lawsuits under this this statute, so there is no excuse for his failure to comply or follow the law.

# Expenditures by agents, employees—Reporting.

Expenditures made on behalf of a candidate or political committee by any person, agency, firm, organization, etc. employed or retained for the purpose of organizing, directing, managing or assisting the candidate's or committee's efforts shall be deemed expenditures by the candidate or committee. In accordance with WAC 390-16-037, such expenditures shall be reported by the candidate or committee as if made or incurred by the candidate or committee directly.

Example A: If a campaign committee pays a consultant \$5,000 to prepare and mail a political advertising brochure, all costs associated with the project shall be itemized by identifying each service provided, vendor utilized and amount attributable to each:

Example B: If a campaign committee pays a consultant to perform tasks such as fund-raising, survey design or campaign plan development, and the consultant does not subcontract with other vendors, the expense shall be reported as follows:
