As noted in the enclosed letter to Benjamin Karpelman, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1) and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking further enforcement action in this matter.

PDC staff is reminding you of the importance of timely filing C-3 and C-4 reports for a political committee, to disclose contribution and expenditure activities, including the receipt of in-kind contributions, in accordance with RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 and all applicable rules. Staff is also reminding you that all contribution and expenditure activities conducted on behalf of a political committee must be reported, even if not otherwise reportable. PDC staff expects in the future that you will file timely and accurate contribution and expenditure reports in accordance with PDC laws and rules.
