PreserveMukilteo distributed literature promoting their campaign in May 2020, as reported by <u>The Herald</u> and The Mukilteo Beacon.

On April 17, 2020, Mr. Zieve <u>reported</u> to the PDC the organization of the political committee but did not disclose his contribution of \$22,144.95 made on that same day <u>until September 26, 2020</u>. This is over five months from when the contribution was made and four months from the first media reports of the political campaign's activities.

This late filing appears to be in violation of RCW 42.17A.235(1) which states that "on the day the treasurer is designated, each candidate or political committee must file with the commission a report of all contributions received and expenditures made prior to that date, if any".
