Dear South Kitsap School Supporters (SKSS) (2), Gerry Austin, Treasurer:

Enclosed is a copy of an electronic letter sent to Robert Parker concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC).

As noted in the enclosed letter to Robert Parker, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1) and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking further enforcement action in this matter.

However, PDC staff is reminding South Kitsap School Supporters about the importance of listing the full amount of contributions on C-3 reports, reporting processing fees as expenditures, and including the quantities of items purchased on all future PDC reports in accordance with the statutes and rules. PDC staff expects in the future that SKSS will report the full amount of contributions received, will report processing fees as expenditures, and will include the number of items purchased, in accordance with PDC laws and rules.
