Dear Julie A. Smith:

On January 14, 2022, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) notified you of an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file an annual Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) disclosing financial activities for calendar year 2020, which was due to be filed no later than April 15, 2021.

PDC staff have reviewed this matter and found the following:

- The PDC received your F-1 report on February 1, 2022.
- You completed a *Statement of Understanding* (SOU) and paid a \$100 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (the Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging a violation of RCW 42.17A.700 for failure to timely file the F-1 report due by April 15, 2021. These items were postmarked on February 2, 2022 and resolve the allegation listed in your complaint.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a). The PDC will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.
