According to RCW 42.17A.205, candidates must file a C-1 report within two weeks of officially announcing for office.

This weblink lists when an individual becomes a candidate – I’m looking at fifth bullet “Publicly announcing candidacy..”

The purpose of the C-1 Candidate Registration discloses office sought, reporting option, committee officers, treasurer's name, location for public campaign records inspection, and bank used for campaign account.
