<p>1 of 2</p> <p><a href="#">Michael Fertakis</a> reported via the portal (<i>Tue, 27 Jul 2021 at 10:33 AM</i>)</p> <p>According to Ben Johnson's campaign website's domain registration records, the domain was registered on 5/20/21 yet his campaign did not officially file with the PDC until 6/17/21 which is in violation of the two weeks of becoming a candidate provision since he purchased the campaign website 28 days ahead of filing.
