

I've attached several documents for your review:

- Washington Citizens for Liberty General Ledger. Expenditures for general expenses and legal fees related to the attached Federal Lawsuit Wise v Inslee are shaded in yellow.
- Copy of Wise v Inslee - Federal lawsuit challenging termination of employees due to vaccine mandate. This case is not related to any political or campaign activity.
- Washington Citizens for Liberty - Amended Annual Report: The report submitted in the complaint was the initial filing. Per Washington Secretary of State procedures and guidelines the Amended Annual Report corrects an error that listed Pam Orebaugh and Natalie Gauvin as "Initial Directors." Both Pam Orebaugh and Natalie Gauvin have been removed and I am the sole Director, Governor and CEO of Washington Citizens for Liberty, a Washington Nonprofit Corporation. A clerk from the SoS office guided me through the process and the form, policy and process have been reviewed by my legal team.

I'd like to take this opportunity to once again point out the error in the complaints regarding Washington Citizens for Liberty having an IRS 501(c)(3) exemption. As stated previously as well as several times to Bryan Taylor in social media conversations and again last Monday at a Liberty Lake Town Hall event, the 501(c)(3) application has been submitted but not yet approved. As I'm sure you are aware, due to COVID processing times are delayed. Bryan Taylor initially and continues to make this false claim and I would hope the PDC investigate and correct this error.
