Mason County Superior Court recently ruled that MCFD6 had altered official public records related to District spending. The records were falsified by the District and then provided to the State Auditor during the District's last audit. Voters should carefully consider the credibility of any information provided by this Fire District.

MCFD6 is already taxing at the highest allowable statewide rate. Per capita taxes for emergency services are already the second highest in Mason County. Why has the district spent \$56,000 defending itself from citizen complaints and lawsuits since January 2020?
