I received additional photos early this morning that were taken from the Citizens for Stanwood Camano School PAC facebook page, and are attached here. These photos mention thanking the SCEA, or Stanwood Camano Education Association (teacher's union), and show staff and a school administrator who appear to be in a classroom environment working on the PAC mailers. The Administrator is identified as Ryan Ovenell, a High School Principal, please add him to the witness list. He appears to be sharing a list of names with another member of the PAC. Is this a list obtained from school records?

Finally, please add the Stanwood Camano Education Association President, Nyda Goldstein, to the witness list as they are mentioned in this one photo as participating with the PAC. Did they also contribute money?

What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

Kirsti Shafer Daniels operated a political action campaign under the name "Concerned Citizens for Stanwood Camano Schools", and acted as Co-Chair with other unknown respondents. This PAC raised more than \$7,000 in 10 weeks, as well as purchased newspaper advertising and sending out thousands of mailers via USPS in support of the Stanwood Schools special election levy proposition 1 on April 26, 2022. Further. Ms. Daniels failed to file organization documents with the PDC as required by law, identify committee members and/or a treasurer, nor did she file any of the required monthly financial disclosure documents. In addition to this, she operated a Facebook page solely for the purpose of supporting the levy, identified as "Citizens for Stanwood Camano Schools", which included photographic evidence of their fundraising and PAC activities, as well as postings with time stamps during normal business hours that were apparently done on school premises (Ms.

Shafer works in the Office of the School Superintendent). It appears that The Superintendent, Dr. Deborah Rumbaugh, either knew, or should have known about Ms. Shafer's activities under RCW 42.17A.555, and either endorsed or quietly condoned these actions. The PDC should also be aware that the School Board President, Natalie Hagglund, posted videos on Ms. Daniels Facebook page for the Schools endorsing the proposition, and may be involved as a defacto co-chair or PAC organizer. Ultimately, it appears that there was collusion between the Board President, the Superintendent, and the District employee here to run and operate a PAC without registering or complying with any PDC laws, and using District facilities and employees in order to avoid regulation and advance their cause for a "yes" vote.
