On January 25th, 2018 at 11:26 am, I observed a violation of RCW 42.17.130, while passing through the School zone at Huntington Middle School, located at 500 Redpath St. Huntington Middle School reader board reads: VOTE YES KELSO SCHOOLS, facing to the north. Photo images of the violation are avialable upon request.

When these kinds of actions are taken by political campaigns, it does not allow the equal opportunity for the expression by the opposing view, in public domain. Will the VOTE NO KELSO SCHOOLS campaign be afforded the same opportunity to use the School district owned property and equipment for their message?

Other observations made; proponents of this Kelso School District 2018 levy campaign have purchased campaign sings that specifically target voters of each SD #458 school. For example: a campaign sign placed on Kelso School district property at Barnes Elementary reads "Barnes Strong" and at Wallace Elementary School, campaign signs that read "Wallace Strong".

Each school building in SD #458 has these signs. The signs are placed at several locations, on school property, too include a sign that is placed above the entrance of Catlin Elementary School. These signs provide information (web site address www.wearekelso.net) regarding the benefits of citizens passing this ballot measure.

One of the corner stones of democracy is allowing the voice of the opposing view the right to express her/his political point of view. The current campaigning tactics that are being employed by proponets of SD # 458 levy measure are promoting an environment where the opposing point of view could be shut out.
