The Attorney General's Office has completed its initial review of the allegations you made against Largo Wales in your citizen action notice under RCW 42.17A.765(4). I noted that your allegations went beyond the provisions of the state campaign finance laws. I will not be addressing those issues.

Based on the office's evaluation, the AGO has determined that the matter should be left to the discretion of the Public Disclosure Commission. Under the recently passed House Bill 2938, the State Legislature determined that the Commission and its staff should have the opportunity to review and act on allegations under RCW 42.17A.
