Dear Faaluaina Pritchard:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) received your request for an appeal of the Order issued in the case cited above. However, because your request was not received or could not be scheduled within 21 days of the November 17, 2022 Order, it is considered a request for reconsideration under WAC 390-37-150.

The Order was issued pursuant to a full adjudicative proceeding held on October 27, 2022, in which you were found in violation of RCW 42.17A.700 and assessed a penalty of \$1,000 with \$500 suspended if paid within 30 days of the date of the Initial Order.

RCW 42.17A.700 requires elected and appointed officials to file a F-1 report on or before April 15, 2022.

Based on your request, an Order Reconsideration Hearing has been scheduled in your case, as provided below. The Hearing will be held before the full Commission, in accordance with RCW 42.17A.110 and .755, and WAC 390-37-144. You will have an opportunity to explain your view of the matter if you choose to attend the Hearing.
