Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on December 27, 2017. Your complaint alleged that 43rd Legislative District Democrats and officers may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 for dissolving before debts, obligations, activity, and functions have ceased, for failure to timely report contributions and expenditures, and failure to preserve financial records.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 29872 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.
- On November 1, 2017, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 29872 was filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC will defer to their judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
