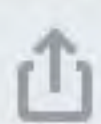

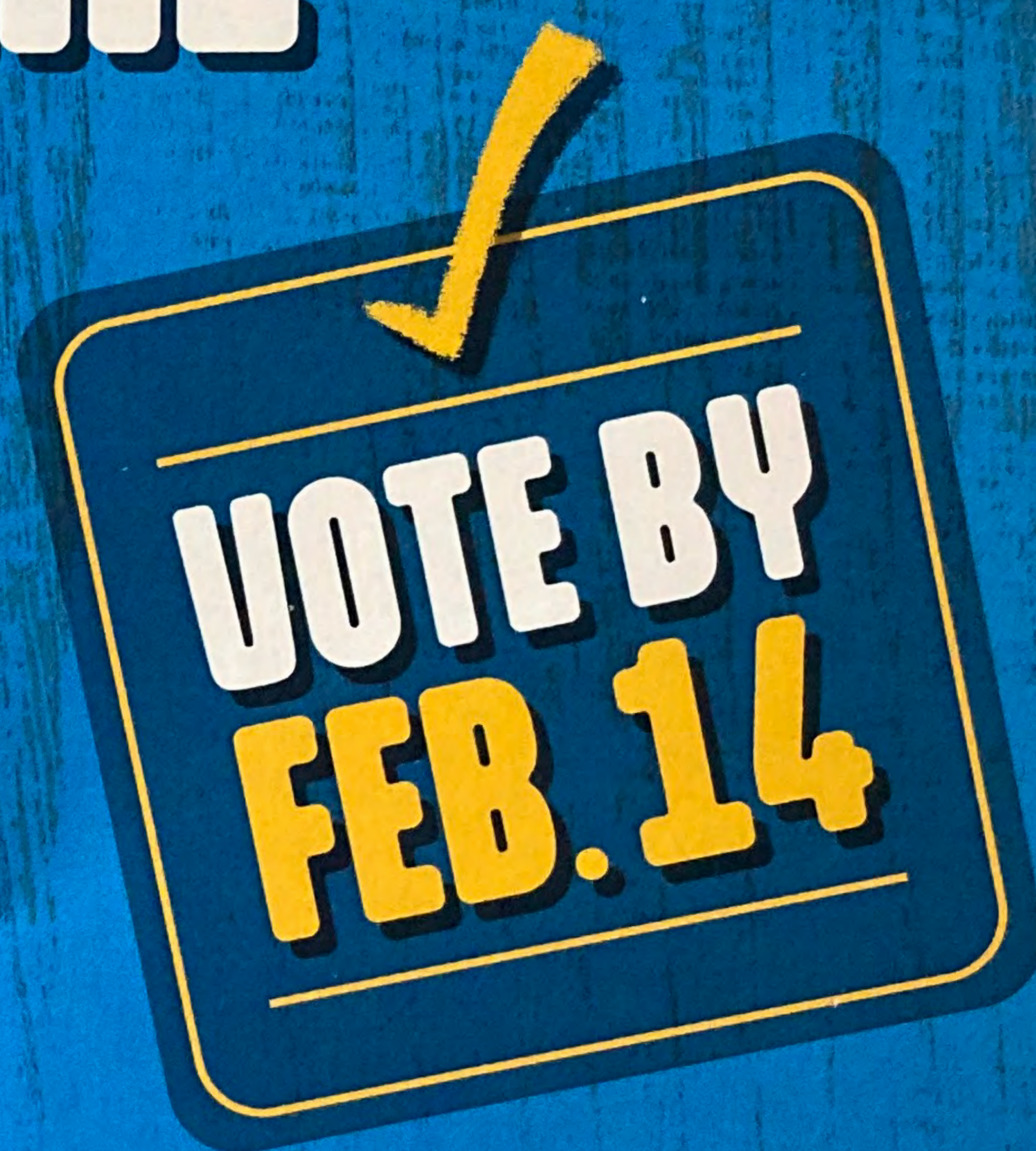

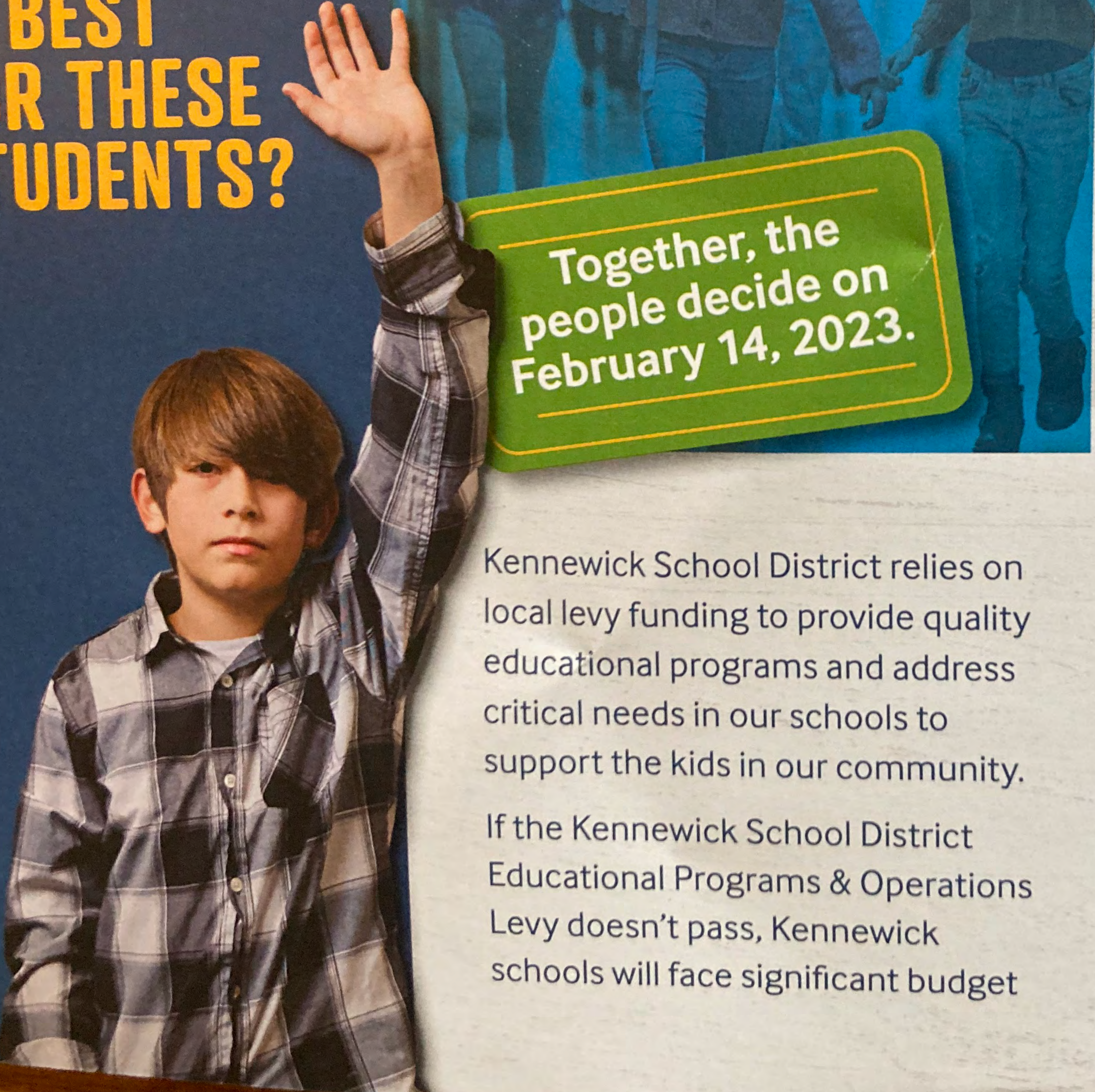

Kennewick School District relies on local levy funding to provide quality educational programs and address critical needs in our schools to support the kids in our community.

If the Kennewick School District Educational Programs & Operations Levy doesn't pass, Kennewick schools will face significant budget

cuts across the board with a \$38 million shortfall for the 2023-24 school year. This could require drastic cuts to athletics, activities, and staff.

If it does pass, our local students will have a **SAFER, MORE SECURE, FULLY-STAFFED** experience.

If it passes, the district will receive an additional \$15 million per year in state Local Effort Assistance (LEA) funding. LEA funding supports districts like Kennewick so our kids have the same educational opportunities as other districts in Washington, but only if the levy passes.

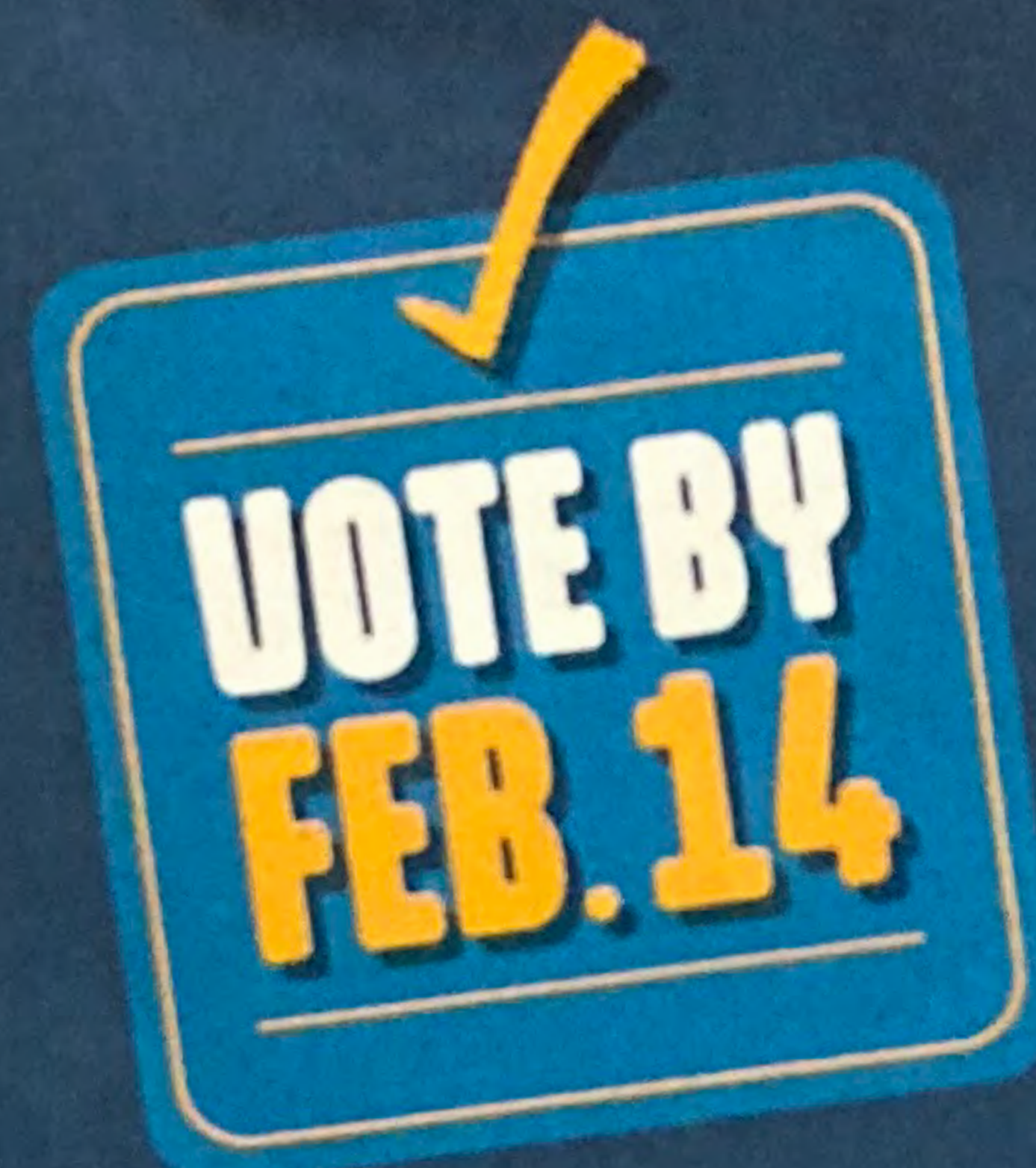
