I. Jurisdiction

 The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 42.17A RCW, the state's campaign disclosure and contribution law; Chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative Procedure Act; and Title 390 WAC. These charges incorporate the Report of Investigation and all related exhibits by reference.

II. Allegations

- 2. Staff alleges that Marc Boldt, a candidate seeking election to Clark County Council Chair in 2015, violated the following:
 - RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 by failing to timely file Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports), and Summary Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken by the campaign, and by failing to maintain campaign records for expenditures that were disclosed on C-4 reports.
 - RCW 42.17A.220 by failing to timely deposit monetary contributions within five business days of receipt into the campaign bank account.
 - RCW 42.17A.445 by failing to properly document or to maintain documentation verifying the payment made to Mr. Boldt for lost wages as a result of campaigning.

• RCW 42.17A.710 by failing to disclose income received on the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) filed for all of calendar year 2015.

III. Facts

- 3. On April 16, 2015, Marc Boldt filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) declaring his candidacy for Clark County Commissioner in 2015, selecting the Full Reporting option and listing his Political Party Preference as Republican. Mr. Boldt was listed as Treasurer, and the sole principal officer for the campaign.
- 4. On May 19, 2015, Mr. Boldt filed an amended C-1 report disclosing that he was running for Clark County Council Chair, and listing his Political Party Preference as "None." The Clark County Council Chair is a new position that had been created as result of recent vote changing the Clark County Charter Review.
- 5. Mr. Boldt served as Clark County Commissioner from 2005 to 2012, and prior to that, he served as a State Representative in the 17th Legislative District from 1994 to 2004.

Allegation 1: Failure to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports (RCW 42.17A.235 & .240)

- 6. The Marc Boldt Campaign (Campaign) failed to timely file four C-4 reports during the 2015 election cycle that included the May C-4 report, the 21-day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report, the Post-Primary Election C-4 report, and the 21-day Pre-General Election C-4 report.
 - The 2015 May C-4 report was filed 11 days late by the Campaign on June 21, 2015, and disclosed \$4,250 in monetary contributions received by the Campaign, and \$1,886 in expenditures made that included \$636 for the candidate filing fee.
 - The 21-day pre-Primary Election C-4 report was filed on July 25, 2015, disclosing \$4,575 in monetary contributions received and expenditures totaling \$4,537 that included \$2,598 for yard signs and materials, and \$796 for newspaper advertisements. The C-4 report was filed 11 days late by the Campaign and nine days prior to the August 4, 2015 primary election being held.
 - The Post Primary Election C-4 report was filed on September 15, 2015, five days late by the Campaign disclosing \$6,703 in monetary contributions received and \$5,095 in expenditures made that included \$2,548 for three newspaper advertisements, \$1,000 for campaign management, and \$828 for campaign robo-calls.

- The 21-day pre-General Election C-4 report was filed 14 days late by the Campaign disclosing \$9,950 in monetary contributions received and expenditures totaling \$14,483 that included \$5,916 for newspaper advertisements, \$4,305 for campaign signs and materials, and \$2,000 for campaign management.
- The 21-day pre-General Election C-4 report was filed one week prior to the November 3, 2015 general election.
- 7. Staff found there were 23 monetary contributions received by the Campaign totaling \$5,850 that were listed on various C-3 reports filed by the Campaign that were disclosed late. The 23 monetary contributions were disclosed one to 15 days late, and represented 8.8% of total monetary contributions received by the Campaign.

Allegation 2: Failure to timely deposit campaign contributions (RCW 42.17A.220).

- 8. Staff reviewed the C-3 reports and C-4 reports filed by the Campaign to determine whether the date the contribution was received and deposited had been timely reported, and to confirm the deposit dates listed on Schedule A to C-4 report.
- 9. Staff's review found there were 23 monetary contributions listed on various C-3 reports filed by the Campaign that were held for more than five business days prior to being deposited. The 23 contributions totaled \$5,850 and were deposited by the Campaign one to 18 days late.

Allegation No. 3: Failure to maintain campaign records for expenditures that were disclosed on C-4 reports (RCW 42.17A.235)

- 10. RCW 42.17A.235(6) requires the candidate or campaign treasurer to "preserve books of account, bills, receipts, and all other financial records of the campaign or political committee for not less than five calendar years following the year during which the transaction occurred."
- 11. Staff requested that Mr. Boldt provide a response to staff's questions concerning several expenditures disclosed on the Post-General Election C-4 report for political advertisements and consulting work, and for repayment made to an individual for the rental of a truck for the Campaign.

- 12. Mr. Boldt stated that the expenditures to the Camas Post and The Columbian were the last political advertisements undertaken by his Campaign prior to the 2015 general election, and that the expenditure to High 5 Media services was for finalizing a mailer that was distributed prior to the general election. Mr. Boldt stated that he did not have the invoices for those three expenditures.
- 13. Concerning the truck rental, Mr. Boldt stated that his mother in-law rented a truck for him to use for the campaign using her credit card when his pickup truck "quit working around September 15, 2015." He stated that he had been using his truck to maintain campaign signs, and the Campaign had already paid \$500 for miscellaneous repair expenses made to his truck, and that his truck quit working after the primary election.
- 14. Mr. Boldt stated that the Campaign did not have the invoices for the rental truck expenditures.

Allegation No. 4: Failure to properly documents lost wages (RCW 42.17A.445)

- 15. RCW 42.17A.445 prohibits the personal use of campaign contributions except for payments made to cover a candidate's lost earnings that were incurred as a result of campaigning. The statute states that a candidates claimed loss of earnings shall be verifiable and that "...any candidate claiming lost earnings as a result of campaigning for office, shall maintain documentation as part of the campaign record and books of account in accordance with RCW 42.17A.235."
- 16. Mr. Boldt stated that his Campaign repaid him \$3,400 on November 14, 2015, for lost wages he incurred as a result of his campaigning for Clark County Council Chair in 2015. He stated that he worked as a truck driver for three different trucking companies during 2015, and that one trucking company, Gilbertson Transport employed him as a truck driver from April or May through December of 2015. He stated his schedule as a driver for Gilbertson Transport was day to day, and that he was paid on a daily basis which he estimated to be about \$140 per day. He stated that he received a W-2 report from Gilbertson for 2015, for wages paid to him totaling between \$17,000 and \$18,000.
- 17. Mr. Boldt stated he took a total of 45 days off from his job working for a trucking firm to campaign for office, and that he kept a record of the total number of days he had taken off, but that he was "...not sure of exact dates."

- 18. Mr. Boldt stated that of the 45 days that he ended up taking off to campaign, he received repayment by the Campaign for slightly more than one-half of those days. The remaining days that he was not repaid for lost wages were days that he merely took off from working at Gilbertson Transport.
- 19. Mr. Boldt failed to provide any documentation from his employer to verify that he had requested or been authorized time off from work to campaign, and he failed to maintain any documentation for the lost wages issue or any Campaign expenditures.

Allegation No. 5: Failure to disclose income on F-1 report (RCW 42.17A.710)

- 20. Staff reviewed the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) filed by Mr. Boldt on April 13, 2015, covering the previous 12 months as required for a newly declared candidate. The F-1 report disclosed no income in Section #1 of report.
- 21. Staff reviewed the F-1 report filed by Mr. Boldt on April 5, 2016, covering financial activities for all of calendar year 2015. The F-1 report filed by Mr. Boldt disclosed that he received income in Section #1 as a Clark County Councilmember, but no income was disclosed from the trucking firm for which he was reimbursed for lost wages.

IV. Law

RCW 42.17A.220 requires candidates to timely deposit monetary contributions received into the campaign bank account or depository within five business days of receipt.

RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 require candidates to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including C-4 reports that are required 21 and 7 days before each election, and in the month following the election, regardless of the level of activity. Beginning five months before the election, weekly C-3 reports are required to be filed every Monday disclosing contributions received and deposited during the previous week. The treasurer or candidate "...shall preserve books of account, bills, receipts, and all other financial records of the campaign or political committee for not less than five calendar years following the year during which the transaction occurred."

RCW 42.17A.445 prohibits the personal use of campaign contributions except for (1) "...payments to cover lost earnings incurred as a result of campaigning.... Lost earnings shall be verifiable as unpaid salary, or when the individual is not salaried, as an amount not to exceed income received by the individual for services rendered during an appropriate, corresponding time period.

All lost earnings incurred shall be documented and a record shall be maintained by the candidate or the candidate's authorized committee in accordance with RCW 42.17A.235."

RCW 42.17A.710 describes the content of an F-1 report, and that the filer must disclose income sources, real estate holdings, assets and investments, and creditors if they meet the reporting thresholds.

Respondent.

I. Background and Allegations

- 1.1 On April 16, 2015, Marc Boldt filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) declaring his candidacy for Clark County Commissioner in 2015, selecting the Full Reporting option, and listing himself as Treasurer and his Party Preference as Republican. **Exhibit #1.**
- 1.2 Mr. Boldt served as Clark County Commissioner from 2005 to 2012. Prior to that, he served as State Representative, Position No. 1 in the 17th Legislative District from 1994 to 2004.
- 1.3 On May 19, 2015, Mr. Boldt filed an amended C-1 report disclosing that he was running for Clark County Council, and listing his Political Party Preference as "None." **Exhibit #2.** The Clark County Council Chair is a new position as result of the Clark County Charter Review which changed from a County Commission with three elected Commissioners to a County Council with four elected Council members and an elected Clark County Council Chair.
- 1.4 On October 29, 2015, Kenny Smith filed a complaint with the PDC against the 2015 Marc Boldt for Clark County Council Chair Campaign (Campaign), alleging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failing to timely file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Campaign Summary Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken during the 2015 election cycle. Specifically, the complaint alleged that Mr. Boldt had not filed any C-3 or C-4 reports since August of 2016.
- 1.5 In the August 4, 2015 Primary election, Mr. Boldt received the most votes from amongst five candidates which included incumbent Clark County Commissioners, David Madore, Tom Mielke, and Jeanne Stewart.

- 1.6 Mr. Boldt was elected Clark County Council Chair in the November 3, 2015 general election, receiving 39.3% of the votes in a three-way race against Mike Dalesandro (36.5%), and the write in campaign of Liz Pike (24.3%).
- 1.7 On January 4, 2016, PDC staff sent a letter to Mr. Boldt informing him that staff has opened a formal investigation into the complaint filed by Mr. Smith, and requesting he provide a response to the allegations listed in the complaint, and to five additional staff questions concerning the C-3 and C-4 reports filed by his Campaign. **Exhibit #3.**
- 1.8 On September 1, 2016, prior to staff completing the Report of Investigation, Kelly Hinton filed a complaint alleging that Mr. Boldt received a \$5,000 loan repayment from his 2012 campaign for County Commissioner but that he failed to disclose the initial loan. Specifically, Mr. Hinton stated in his complaint that on August 29, 2012, Mr. Boldt was listed as having received a \$5,000 loan repayment on the C-4 report, but the Campaign failed to file a C-3 report and Schedule L disclosing the initial \$5,000 loan.
- 1.9 The complaint filed by Kelly Hinton against Marc Boldt has been combined with the earlier Kenny Smith complaint filed against Mr. Boldt.

II. **Detailed Findings**

- 2.1 Candidates appearing on the 2015 primary and general election ballots who selected the Full Reporting option were required to file weekly C-3 reports every Monday beginning June 1, 2015, disclosing contributions that were received and deposited the previous seven days.
- 2.2 RCW 42.17A.220 requires candidates to timely deposit monetary contributions received into the campaign bank account or depository within five business days of receipt.
- 2.3 Candidates under the Full Reporting option in 2015 were also required to file monthly C-4 reports by the 10th of each month disclosing contribution and expenditure activities incurred in the previous calendar month, and candidates appearing on the 2015 primary and general election ballots were required to file the following C-4 reports;
 - A 21-day Pre-Primary election C-4 report was due on July 14, 2015, covering the period June 1 through July 13, 2015.
 - A 7-day Pre-Primary election C-4 report due on July 28, 2015, covering the period July 14 through July 27, 2015.
 - A Post-Primary election C-4 report by September 10, 2015, covering the period July 28 through August 31, 2015.
 - A 21-day Pre-General election C-4 report was due on October 13, 2015, covering the period September 1 through October 12, 2015.

- A 7-day pre-General election C-4 report due on October 27, 2015, covering the period October 13 through October 26, 2015.
- A Post-General election C-4 report by December 10, 2015, covering the period October 27 through November 30, 2015.

Allegation No. 1: Failure to timely file C-4 reports (RCW 42.17A.235)

2.4 The Campaign filed a total of seven C-4 reports during the 2015 election cycle as detailed in the chart below, of which the Campaign failed to timely file four C-4 reports, including the 21-day Pre-Primary and 21-Day Pre-General Election C-4 reports. (Exhibit #4)

Allegation No. 2: Failure to timely file deposit campaign contributions (RCW 42.17A.220) and disclosed those contributions on C-3 reports (RCW 42.17A.235 and .240)

2.5 Staff reviewed the C-3 reports filed by the Campaign. The review found the Campaign complied with the C-3 filing requirements based solely on the information disclosed on the C-3 and C-4 reports, which consisted of reviewing the date: (1) The contribution was received and deposited into the bank account; (2) The C-3 reports were electronically filed; and (3) The deposit date listed on Schedule A to C-4 report.

- 2.6 Staffs' review found 23 monetary contributions listed on various C-3 reports filed by the Campaign that were held for more than five business days prior to being deposited, and were also disclosed late by the Campaign. **Exhibit #5.**
- 2.7 The 23 individual contributions totaled \$5,850 in contributions that were deposited one to 18 days late into the Campaign bank account, and were disclosed one to 15 days late. The \$5,850 in late deposited and disclosed contributions represented 8.8% of all contributions received by the 2015 Campaign as detailed in the chart below.

Allegation No. 3: Failure to maintain campaign records for expenditures that were disclosed on C-4 reports (RCW 42.17A.235).

- 2.8 RCW 42.17A.235(6) requires the candidate or campaign treasurer to "preserve books of account, bills, receipts, and all other financial records of the campaign or political committee for not less than five calendar years following the year during which the transaction occurred."
- 2.9 The "books of account" maintained by the Campaign should have included invoices, receipts, notes or other memoranda for campaign expenditures made to vendors, copies of cancelled checks, copies of contribution checks, and other internal documents for campaign contribution and expenditure activities.

Allegation No. 4: Failure to properly documents lost wages (RCW 42.17A.445).

- 2.10 RCW 42.17A.445 prohibits the personal use of campaign contributions except for (1) "...payments to cover lost earnings incurred as a result of campaigning." The statute goes on to state "Lost earnings shall be verifiable as unpaid salary, or when the individual is not salaried, as an amount not to exceed income received by the individual for services rendered during an appropriate, corresponding time period." Any candidate claiming lost earnings as a result of campaigning for office, shall maintain documentation as part of the campaign record and books of account in accordance with RCW 42.17A.235.
- 2.11 As part of this investigation, staff reviewed the expenditures listed on the 2015 Post General Election C-4 report filed by the Campaign. **Exhibit #6.** The C-4 report disclosed that the Campaign received \$4,565 in monetary contributions received and made \$11,599 in expenditures during the reporting period. The \$11,599 in expenditures represented 24.7% of the \$46,912 in total Campaign expenditures made and included the following:
 - \$3,900 expenditure made to Mr. Boldt on November 14, 2015, with the description listed as "Lost wages-miscellaneous vehicle expenses."
 - \$3,100 expenditure made to High 5 Media on November 4, 2015, with the description listed as "Services"
 - \$651 expenditure made to the Camas Post on November 10, 2015, with the description listed as "Printing Services."
 - \$500 expenditure made to The Columbian on November 15, 2015, with the description listed as "Newspaper ad."
 - \$1,919 expenditure made to Judy Chipman, as repayment for an AMEX card charge she made to the Avis Car Rental to rent a truck for the campaign.

- 2.12 Staff's review of the expenditures listed on the 2015 Post General Election C-4 report included an attempt to ascertain if the expenditures listed on the C-4 report should have been disclosed earlier as an orders-placed, debt or obligation. Based on that review, staff requested that Mr. Boldt provide a response to staff's questions concerning the post-election expenditures and lost wages claimed.
- 2.13 Staff also questioned whether or not the proper documentation had been maintained by the Campaign, and requested Mr. Boldt provide back-up documentation to verify the lost wages and vehicle expenses. Staff also attempted to confirm the order dates for the newspapers advertising and consulting services that had been provided to the Campaign and requested Mr. Boldt provide the back-up documentation for those expenditures, but none was provided.
- 2.14 On July 19, 2016, PDC staff issued a subpoena to Mr. Boldt requesting his appearance to conduct an interview scheduled for August 4, 2016.

Allegation No. 5: Failure to file a C-3 report and Schedule L disclosing a candidate loan to the 2012 Campaign (RCW 42.17A.235 and .240)

- 2.15 In the complaint filed by Kelly Hinton, he alleged that the Campaign received a \$5,000 loan repayment on August 29, 2012, but he could not find that the Campaign filed a C-3 report or Schedule L disclosing the initial \$5,000 loan/contribution made by Mr. Boldt.
- 2.16 PDC staff reviewed the C-3 reports filed by the 2012 Campaign for re-election to Clark County Commissioner, and could not find a C-3 report had been filed disclosing the \$5,000 loan.
- 2.17 PDC staff reviewed the C-4 reports filed by the 2012 Campaign and found a \$5,000 loan was made to the Campaign on July 19, 2012, that was disclosed on the 2012 7-day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report as an attached Schedule L. In addition, the Campaign disclosed making a \$5,000 expenditure to Mr. Boldt on August 29, 2012, and listed the description as "Loan repayment" on the Post-Primary Election C-4 report. Exhibit #7.
- 2.18 Mr. Boldt stated he was the Treasurer for his 2012 Campaign, but that he was Treasurer in name only since he did not have anyone lined up for that position when he started his Campaign. Dawn Boldt, his spouse, began having her name listed on the C-3 and C-4 reports in the Treasurer's block beginning in early September 2012, but she was never formally identified as the Campaign Treasurer on the C-1 report.
- 2.19 Mr. Boldt stated that he recalled discussing that he was planning on making a loan to his Campaign, but that he never did. However, he noted that somehow a \$5,000 loan from him personally got entered into the Online Reporting of Campaign Activities software (ORCA). He stated that in order to "balance the account" the Campaign entered a \$5,000 loan repayment, rather than to file an amended C-4 report correcting out the loan. He stated that he knew that is not what the Campaign should have done, but it is what happened, there was no loan.

- 2.20 Staff requested that Mr. Boldt provide a copy of the 2012 Campaign bank statements covering the period of July 1 through August 31, 2012, and Mr. Boldt provided the requested bank statements on October 6, 2016.
- 2.21 Staff reviewed the bank statements which confirmed that the Campaign did not make a \$5,000 bank deposit on July 19, 2012, as listed on the Schedule L to C-4 report. In addition, the bank statements confirmed that the Campaign did not make a \$5,000 loan repayment to Mr. Boldt on August 29, 2012.

Mark Boldt Responses

- 2.22 On August 4, 2016, PDC staff conducted a telephone interview with Mr. Boldt. The statements made by Mr. Boldt during the interview and his prior email responses are incorporated into one response as listed below.
- 2.23 Mr. Boldt stated that the expenditures made by his Campaign to the Camas Post and The Columbian were the last political advertisements purchased prior to the 2015 general election. He stated the expenditure to High 5 Media services was for finalizing a campaign mailer that was mailed out prior to the general election. PDC staff had requested the invoices to verify the date the order had been placed, and whether or not the Campaign should have disclosed that expenditure on a C-4 report prior to the election.
- 2.24 Mr. Boldt stated the Campaign did not have the invoices for those three expenditures, and went on to state the following:
 - He ran his entire Campaign and served as the Campaign Treasurer and political consultant, and that he handled all aspects of the campaign's finances.
 - He received all monetary contributions made to his Campaign and deposited those contributions received into the campaign bank account, entered the contributor information into the Online Reporting of Campaign Activity (ORCA) filing software and electronically filed the PDC reports.
 - He placed the orders for all goods and services purchased by the Campaign, made the expenditures, and conducted all outreach and other campaign-related activities. He stated that High 5 Media assisted him with his Campaign's paid media.
 - He did a better job of keeping track of the monetary contributions received by his Campaign, than he did for the expenditures made by the Campaign.
 - He acknowledged that he did not maintain the invoices or any other back-up documentation for any of the expenditures made by the Campaign. During the interview, PDC staff discussed with Mr. Boldt the statutory requirement about maintaining campaign records for five years, including campaign invoices.

Marc Boldt Report of Investigation PDC Case No. 1195 Page - 8 –

- 2.25 Mr. Boldt stated that Judy Chipman, his mother in-law, rented a truck from Avis Car Rental for him to use for the campaign using her credit card, after his pickup truck "quit working around September 15, 2015." He stated that he had been using his truck to maintain the campaign signs he had been putting up all around Clark County and to conduct campaign activities, but that his truck quit working after the primary election.
- 2.26 Mr. Boldt stated that the Campaign paid \$500 for miscellaneous repairs that had been made to his truck prior to his mother-in-law renting the truck, and that the rental truck was used by the Campaign until after the 2015 general election. He stated that he was not sure how much the truck cost to rent, but it was rented on a monthly basis and then prorated accordingly for anything less than a month.
- 2.27 Mr. Boldt stated that the \$1,919 his campaign paid to his mother in-law, reimbursed her for the total amount of the Avis truck rental that she had charged on her American Express credit card. The Campaign paid for the gasoline and he stated that he put about 4,000 miles on the rental truck, and he returned the rental truck once he finished picking up his campaign signs after the 2015 general election. He stated that he did not keep a mileage log, but he estimated that 95% of the rental trucks usage was for Campaign related activities.
- 2.28 Mr. Boldt stated that \$3,400 of the \$3,900 campaign expenditure made to him on November 14, 2015, was for lost wages he incurred as a result of his campaigning for Clark County Council Chair in 2015. The expenditure had not been disclosed prior to the election as an order-placed, debt or obligation by the Campaign, and the expenditure was reported after the general election on the Post-Election C-4 report. Mr. Boldt stated:
 - He worked as a truck driver for three different trucking companies during 2015, but that two of the trucking company jobs were for short-terms lasting a total of two weeks or less.
 - One trucking company, Gilbertson Transport employed him as a truck driver from April or May through December of 2015. He stated that his schedule as a driver for Gilbertson Transport was day to day, and he was paid on a daily basis which he estimated to be about \$140 per day.
 - He received a W-2 report from Gilbertson for 2015, and he thought it was for wages paid to him totaling between \$17,000 and \$18,000.
- 2.29 PDC staff requested that Mr. Boldt provide documentation concerning the lost wages issue, or some type of verification that he had requested or been authorized time off from work to campaign for the County Council Chair position. Mr. Boldt stated
 - He took a total of 45 days off from his job working for a trucking firm to campaign for office.

Marc Boldt Report of Investigation PDC Case No. 1195 Page - 9 —

- He kept a record of the total number of days he had taken off, but that he was "...not sure of exact dates."
- The 45 days that he took off work from Gilbertson Transport to campaign in 2015, included days that he only needed to take one or two hours off in order to attend a campaign event, since Gilbertson Transport needed a driver for a full shift.
- Of the 45 days that he took off to campaign, he received repayment by the Campaign for slightly more than one-half of those days. The remaining days that he was not repaid for lost wages were days that he merely took off from working at Gilbertson Transport.
- 2.30 Mr. Boldt failed to provide any documentation from his employer to verify that he had requested or been authorized time off from work to campaign, and he failed to maintain any documentation for the lost wages issue or any Campaign expenditures.

Allegation No. 5: Failure to disclose income on F-1 report (RCW 42.17A.710)

- 2.31 Staff reviewed the Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) filed by Mr. Boldt on April 13, 2015, covering the previous 12 months from April 16, 2015, the dated that he filed his C-1 report for the 2015 election. **Exhibit #8.** The F-1 report filed by Mr. Boldt listed no income in Section #1 of the F-1 report.
- 2.32 Staff reviewed the F-1 report filed by Mr. Boldt on April 5, 2016, covering financial activities for all of calendar year 2015. The F-1 report filed by Mr. Boldt disclosed that he received income in Section #1 as a Clark County Councilmember, but failed to disclose any income was received from any of the three trucking firms he worked for in 2015, including Gilbertson Transport, the trucking company for which he was reimbursed for lost wages. **Exhibit #9.**

III. Scope

- 3.1 PDC staff reviewed the following documents:
 - The complaint filed by Kenny Smith against the Marc Boldt Campaign on October 30, 2015.
 - C-1 reports, C-3 reports, and C-4 reports filed by the 2015 Marc Boldt Campaign.
 - E-mail exchange between Marc Boldt and PDC staff transmitted through the Freshdesk portal.
 - August 4, 2016, telephone interview under oath conducted with Marc Boldt. Exhibit #10 (audio file of telephone interview)

IV. Laws

- 4.1 **RCW 42.17A.220** requires candidates to timely deposit monetary contributions received into the campaign bank account or depository within five business days of receipt.
- 4.2 RCW 42.17A.235 and 240 require continuing political committees to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures. Under the full reporting option, until five months before the general election, C-4 reports are required monthly when contributions or expenditures exceed \$200 since the last report. C-4 reports are also required 21 and 7 days before each election in which the committee makes expenditures, and in the month following the election. Contributions are reported weekly during this same time period, and must be disclosed on Monday for contributions deposited the previous seven days.
- 4.3 **RCW 42.17A.235(6)** states "The treasurer or candidate shall preserve books of account, bills, receipts, and all other financial records of the campaign or political committee for not less than five calendar years following the year during which the transaction occurred."
- 4.4 **RCW 42.17A.445** prohibits the personal use of campaign contributions except for (1) "...payments to cover lost earnings incurred as a result of campaigning.... Lost earnings shall be verifiable as unpaid salary, or when the individual is not salaried, as an amount not to exceed income received by the individual for services rendered during an appropriate, corresponding time period. All lost earnings incurred shall be documented and a record shall be maintained by the candidate or the candidate's authorized committee in accordance with RCW 42.17A.235."
- 4.5 **RCW 42.17A.710** describes the content of an F-1 report, and that the filer must disclose income sources, real estate holdings, assets and investments, and creditors if they meet the reporting thresholds.

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) previously notified you that Kenny Smith filed a complaint against your 2015 campaign for Clark County Council Chair on October 29, 2015. The complaint alleged that you violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Campaign Summary Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken by your campaign.

PDC staff reviews and investigates complaints in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act. Staff considers all responses received as part of its initial review, and based on that review, complaints are either returned, dismissed with no or minor action, or assigned to an investigator for further investigation.

Based on staff's review, we have opened a formal investigation concerning the allegations against you as listed in the complaint, and it was assigned PDC Case No. 1195. Once an investigation is opened, staff will contact the Respondent to: (1) obtain an initial or supplemental response; (2) request additional information or documentation; or (3) conduct an investigative interview under oath, either in-person or by telephone. Any violations and penalties the Commission assesses against Respondents are civil in nature.

Your campaign has already filed the missing 7-Day pre-general election C-4 report. PDC staff notified you by email of the complaint on October 29, 2015, but could not find where you have provided a formal response concerning the late filing of the C-3 reports or the 21-day Pre-general election C-4 report. Staff reviewed your C-3 and C-4 reports, including the amended Postgeneral election C-4 report, and have questions about the expenditures disclosed on that report.

Staff is requesting that you provide a response to the complaint concerning the late filed C-3 and C-4 reports, and staff's questions about some of the expenditures listed on the Post-general election C-4 report <u>by January 19, 2016.</u>

Be sure to include any mitigating factors that contributed to the C-3 reports or the 21-day Pregeneral election C-4 report being filed late by your campaign, and respond to the following questions from PDC staff:

- You disclosed two expenditures to High Five Media, one on November 1, 2015 (\$379) and one on November 4, 2015, and listed the description as "Services." What specific services were provided to the campaign? When were the orders placed with High Five Media by you or your campaign for those services? Please explain.
- You disclosed a November 10, 2015 expenditure to the Camas Post totaling \$651 for printing services. What printing services were provided to the campaign? Was it for a mailer or campaign flyer? If yes, when did the campaign take possession of the printed materials and when did it present the materials to the public? When was the order placed with the Camas Post by you or your campaign for printing services?
- You disclosed a November 15, 2015 expenditure to The Columbian Newspaper totaling \$500 for a newspaper advertisement. When did the newspaper advertisement run? Was it a campaign political advertisement or thank-you advertisement? Typically, newspaper advertisements are paid for prior to the advertisement running, so please explain if this advertisement ran prior to the general election being held.
- You disclosed two expenditures to Avis Car Rental, one on November 19, 2015 for \$1,918.48; and one on November 29, 2015 also for \$1,918.48, and listed the description as "truck rentals" for the campaign, and you noted on one expenditure "Judy Chipman AMEX card paid." What services were provided to the campaign by the truck rentals? When were those services provided to your campaign? Who is Judy Chipman? When did she make an out of pocket expenditure to benefit your campaign? Please explain.
- Finally, you disclosed a November 14, 2015 expenditure totaling \$3,900 made to you personally for "Lost wages-miscellaneous vehicle expenses." Please provide the back-up documentation for the lost wages and vehicle expenses.




