Complaint Description
<p><u>Glen Morgan</u> reported via the portal (Fri, 26 May 2023 at 8:15 AM) To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has recently come to my attention that Spokane City Councilperson Betsy Wilkerson has committed various violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The violations are detailed below. I realize I recently filed a previous complaint against this campaign, but for some reason, at the time, I missed these additional violations, so it seemed worthwhile to file a second complaint with additional violations:</p> <p>1) Illegal acceptance of overlimit in-kind contribution, and attempting to mislead the PDC/Public by claiming something else (Violation of RCW 42.17A.405(14) – see WAC 390-16-207)</p> <p>Spokane Councilperson Betsy Wilkerson lists two in-kind donations from “Sterling Strategies” of Oakland, CA for “Donor list acquisition.” (See PDC Report number: 110145673 which Amends 110145672 and covers the period: 04/01/2023 to 04/30/2023 attached).</p> <p>Sterling Strategies, now Sterling Data Company, on its website promotes itself as, “AI-Driven Donor Acquisition For Fundraising.”</p> <p>Wilkerson lists TWO in-kind donations of the donor list acquisition on 4/14/23. The first, designated as “fair market value” in the amount of \$1,200 for the primary election (the maximum amount allowed). The second, also “fair market value” in the amount of \$279 for the general election. The donation received on 4/14/23 is \$1,479 and the entire product “the donor list” was received on 4/14/23.</p> <p>This violates the maximum amount that a person or an entity can give to an election – which in this case, after the new inflation adjusted numbers recently increased on April Fools Day this year - for the primary election this equals \$1,200.</p> <p>In essence, Betsy Wilkerson's fuzzy accounting demands that we believe that although she was gifted and gobbled down an entire \$1,479 hamburger today, she insists that she is only going to digest 80% of that hamburger over the next three months (the primary). Then, she will go about the business of processing the 20% digestion deferral of Betsy's Big Burger that she ate in April over the three months of the general (August through early November).</p> <p>Washington State campaign finance laws may not always make sense, but they also don't work that way, despite Betsy Wilkerson's attempts to create some form of new accounting method through a bizarre depreciation or re-amortization schedule. An entire yard sign donated today needs to be reported today, not 80% of that yard sign.</p>

What is more likely? That Betsy Wilkerson is introducing a new accounting method to the PDC. Or, that she wanted the donor list immediately and rather than simply paying the donor the \$279 portion that is over the limit? Instead, she chose to break the law and she decided it was more appropriate and convenient to cook the books.

Wilkerson's history of campaign finance violations are not, shall we say ... Sterling, like this vendor's name implies. This is just one example, so let's explore some more:

2) Falsification or attempt to conceal true employer of campaign contributor (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240)

I also noted that the Betsy Wilkerson campaign also willfully reported false employment information for one of her major contributors. In this case, a \$500 contribution from Ben Stuckart (a frequent flyer political candidate) inaccurately identifies Mr. Stuckart as "not employed." However, this is not true, as Betsy Wilkerson knows full well. Mr. Stuckart is actually employed by one of the grant grifting operations financed by the City of Spokane directly as a vendor. Specifically, Stuckart is employed by the Spokane Low Income Housing Consortium as their "Executive Director" as this corporation's website clearly states in the attached website page.

To be fair to the Wilkerson campaign, it is possible that Stuckart's job as "Executive Director" is in reality a no-show position, in which case it may appear from the outside that he is "Not employed," but regardless of this lack of doing the work, that is no excuse to conceal Mr. Stuckart's theoretical "employment," this campaign must go back and correct the false information they have reported on their C3 form (See **PDC C3 Report # 110141940** attached)

I will also point out for the record – Wilkerson has been able to semi-accurately classify Stuckart's changing employment in the past (See **PDC C3 Report #110015700** attached) where Stuckart was called a "consultant" in the employment description back then.

Finally, not to overemphasize this bizarre attempt to conceal the true employment of a major donor – this same major donor wrote an op-ed in the Spokesman Review (the local paper of record) calling out the city to give more money to their organizations:

[Lerria Schuh and Ben Stuckart: Regional effort on homeless would unify resources, strategy | The Spokesman-Review](#)

While it is true that many local papers have experienced declining circulation and readership, it seems unlikely that a City Councilmember like Wilkerson would interact with Stuckart on a regular basis so often and in so many ways and then claim that Stuckart is "not employed."

3) Attempt to conceal the identity of organizations on which boards the candidate participates as an officer (Violation of RCW 42.17A.710)

This is another violation that just seems foolish, sloppy, and bizarre. Why break the law in this way on top of all the other lawbreaking? Some questions have no good answer, but let me provide a specific examples of this violation. Attached is the current report for the Carl Maxey Center which clearly indicates that Wilkerson is a Board member, yet this fact is not reflected on

her F1 submitted to the PDC. Many local non-profit organizations like this are recipients of grants grifted and lobbied through the local government and there is no good reason to conceal the truth or even attempt to follow the law in this case.

4) Accepting contributions for political campaign that never happened. Failure to either refund contributions or properly reclassify them (Violation of RCW 42.17A.405(2))

This is a general notice of widespread violations from the Wilkerson 2021 campaign. Please note, there was no primary election for this political election because only two candidates registered to run for this office. On numerous occasions after the 2021 filing week had ended, and it was apparent that there would be no primary election, the Wilkerson campaign continued to accept contributions designated for the Primary election that never happened. For example, see attached C3 (**PDC C3 Tracking #110023824**), where you can see a \$1,000 contribution received on June 4, 2021 designated for the Primary election (that never happened). These funds were never reclassified as General election funds, nor were they returned to the donor. There are many contributions like this throughout the 2021 campaign.

The Wilkerson campaign needs to correct all the erroneous C3 reports from the 2021 campaign by either designating these illegal primary contributions as general election contributions or refunding them to the original donor.

I realize that I am probably only scratching the surface of the lawbreaking here. There is apparently always more to find, but by passing this information to the PDC, I can hand off the investigation to the professionals. Please feel free if you need more information.
