Thank you for amending the campaign's C-4 reports on June 12, 2023. On these reports, we are unable to locate an entry for the pizza obtained for Ardor staff that was mentioned in a 4/13/23 Facebook post and is one of the subjects of this complaint. The campaign reported receiving a \$100 in-kind contribution on 3/2/23 from Keballas for "Food for sign printing" which may have been for pizza, but this occurred over a month *before* the 4/13 Facebook post about bringing pizza to Ardor staff and is therefore unlikely to be the same instance.

• Please kindly indicate if the pizza from on or about 4/13 has been disclosed by the campaign and, if so, on which report it can be found. If it was reported as a "non-itemized expenditure," please be sure to state this in your response as non-itemized expenditures appear as part of a lump sum amount that does not include descriptions and we cannot easily discern what is included.

As a reminder, we have not yet received your written response to the complaint allegation, which was due <u>6/20</u>. An email will suffice. Although you are not required to respond, it is to your benefit to do so as this is your chance to let us know what happened (and why) from your perspective, including any mitigating factors you want us to know. 




Thank you for providing this information - we greatly appreciate it.

It appears that the \$96.36 expenditure for Bravas Pizza on 4/7 might be included in the lum sum of \$491.95 for "non-itemized expenditures" that appears on the campaign's amended April C-4 report because we are unable to see an itemized expenditure entry for Bravas Pizza on the April C-4 report (see below):



• Can you kindly confirm whether the 4/7 pizza expenditure was included in the \$491.95 "non-itemized expenditures" total shown above? The amended April C-4 report is <u>report</u> 110152403.

Unfortunately, ORCA upgrades and the dollar amount threshold increase for reporting expenditure details on the C-4 report, which went into effect on April 1, 2023, prevent me from being able to "see" the details the campaign entered into ORCA for the expenditures included in the \$491.95 lum sum total in section #3 of the report. The dollar amount threshold for reporting expenditure details increased from "more than \$50" to "more than \$200" on 4/1/23 - see RCW 42.17A..240(7) and WAC 390-05-400.
