<p>Glen Morgan</p> <p>Wed, 21 Jun 2023 at 6:59 PM</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that Michael Steadman has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A) during his current political campaign for Thurston County Commissioner (District 5), and in pretty much every other campaign he has participated in the last 5 years. The details are as follows:</p> <p>1) Failure to accurately or honestly report in-kind contribution of campaign signs from previous political campaign for different office. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>I was driving around Lacey recently, partly because I recently filed a few complaints against two politicians running for Lacey City Council, and I wanted to see what type of signs and potential violations were being openly committed by some of the politicians running for office up there. This caused me to stumble on just another blatant example of a willful violator of Washington State's campaign finance laws. In this complaint I will address Michael Steadman, current candidate for Thurston County Commissioner (District 5). I noticed these recycled, "caution" orange campaign signs for Micheal Steadman's campaign. I've attached one sign as an example, but if the PDC desires more photos and evidence, it is easy and pleasant to drive around and take more photos.</p> <p>However, I believe that only one photo as an example of this campaign sign is necessary because it illustrates the violation when combined with the missing information on the campaign's filed documents. It appears, from what can be gathered from the missing and illegally unreported information, that the 2023 Steadman for Thurston County Commissioner (Position 5) is reusing an unknown number of older, used campaign signs from the 2020 Steadman for Thurston County Commissioner (position 3) campaign. The evidence is the fact that the campaign signs the 2023 Steadman TC Commissioner (Pos.5) campaign is using all have stickers with the number "5" on them placed over the old 2020 Steadman TC Commissioner (po.3) campaign signs which have a number "3" on them covered up by the sticker.</p> <p>Further evidence is the fact that the 2023 Steadman campaign also has purchased 1,000 stickers on 4/21/23 from Capital Press specifically "for signs" (See PDC C4 report</p>

#110146601 attached). While the stickers appear to be accurately reported on this C4, the in-kind contribution of campaign signs from a different campaign have not been reported and are being used illegally and remain unreported to this day.

The PDC provides very clear and helpful guidance on their website, linked here under “How to report use of old campaign signs”:

How to report use of old campaign signs | Washington State Public Disclosure Commission (PDC)

The PDC clearly states the Steadman campaign must report the following (quote from the above link on the PDC’s website):

“Once the fair market value is established, you have a few options for reporting it:

Transfer as an in-kind contribution. In the last campaign, work backwards from the last contribution received to see who donated up to the amount that would cover the new fair market value of the used signs. Seek written permission from those individuals to move the value of the signs to the new campaign. Then, in the new campaign in ORCA, enter the signs in Transactions>Contributions>In-kind Contributions. The contributor will be the candidate's previous campaign, and, in the description, you would enter "TRANSFER WITH PERMISSION SIGNS."

Candidate pays the previous campaign. The candidate, using the new "fair market value" of the used signs could pay the previous campaign that amount. Then, in the new campaign, report the signs under Transactions>Contributions>In-kind Contributions. The contributor would be the candidate, and, in the description, you would enter something to the effect of "SIGNS PURCHASED FROM 2017 CAMPAIGN."

New campaign purchases the signs. This purchase would be reported in the new campaign under Transactions>Expenditure>Monetary Expenditures. The vendor would be, for example, "CANDIDATE NAME 2017 CAMPAIGN." You would then deposit these funds into the old campaign, which would require that campaign to file a C-3 and C-4.”

Clearly, the Steadman campaign chose to follow none of these options and instead chose to break the law and abuse the public’s trust in failing to even pretend to comply.

For PDC staff reference, I will point out that the recent PDC clarification on the transfer of funds from previous campaigns for different offices will require the Steadman Campaign to report each of these donors from the previous campaign who gave written permission, along with the total amount they have approved to be transferred to this new, unique campaign. As an aside – I suggest updating this page on the PDC website to more accurately reflect this information for greater clarity for campaigns that seek to make some effort to comply. However, in this case – the Steadman campaign didn’t even bother to make an effort to pretend they were willing to comply with the law.

Of course, once I noticed the open willingness of this campaign to flagrantly and with malice break Washington State's campaign finance laws, I decided it might make sense to review some of the other political campaigns Michael Steadman has launched over the past few years and see if the lawbreaking was habitual. It turns out, no surprise, this is just the most recent example of a long pattern of behavior in lawbreaking conducted by this politician. I'll expand on those violations below.

2) Total failure to report and describe expenses, the illegal concealment of required information from the public (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-037, WAC 390-16-205)

Since the Steadman campaign was already openly willing to flagrantly violate Washington State's campaign finance laws with their current 2023 campaign for the Thurston County Commissioner Position 5 race, I wondered whether the public could better understand exactly how many campaign signs the failed Steadman 2020 campaign for Thurston County Commissioner Position 3 race had purchased. It turns out the Steadman campaign concealed that information as well. For example:

On a variety of this campaign's C4s they failed to provide specific amounts of signs that were purchased from various vendors as explicitly required by WAC 390-16-037 (see example B). A small sampling of these violations are as follows:

A. On 6/11/19, Steadman spent \$837.49 on "yard signs" with vendor "Inbound Designs" – concealing legally required details of how many signs were purchased (PDC C4 Tracking #100915767 see attached)

B. On 6/6/19, Steadman also spent \$500.00 on "signs, website, etc" with vendor "Mike Whitlatch" – concealing not just the legally required details of how many signs were purchased, but also how the expenses break down with the other random catch all expenses lumped into this "vendor" payment. Did Steadman pay this vendor to destroy competitor signs? Did Steadman pay this vendor to hack websites? No transparency, clarity or legally required details here. (PDC C4 Tracking #100915767 see attached)

C. On 10/2/20, Steadman spent \$2,406.80 on "yard signs" with vendor "Capital City Press" – concealing legally required details of how many signs were purchased (PDC C4 Tracking #101005633 see attached)

D. On 10/8/20, Steadman spent \$1,868.85 on "5-way mailers" with vendor "Capital City Press" – again concealing legally required details of how many mailers were purchased (PDC C4 Tracking #101005633 see attached)

E. On 4/12/19, Steadman spent \$2,311.71 on “Yard Signs” from vendor “Inbound Designs” – again, as is his habit, concealing legally required details of how many signs were purchased (PDC C4 Tracking #100903504 see attached)

F. On 12/24/19, Steadman spent \$408.22 on “slim jims, doorbellers” from vendor “Capital City Press” – again concealing legally required details of exactly how many slim jims were purchased (PDC C4 Tracking #100953940 see attached)

G. On 11/06/20, Steadman spent \$1,682.74 on “5-way mailer” with vendor Capital City Press – again, as is typical with this campaign – concealing legally required details of exactly how many mailers were purchased (PDC C4 Tracking #110002423 see attached)

This campaign had a professional, paid treasurer and was easily able to at least pretend to comply with the statute. Every ORCA class put on by the PDC explicitly instructs those who take the class about these requirements. It is possible to comply with the law and not break it habitually, if it is your desire to do so.

Keep in mind, if the public is trying to figure out how so many mystery 2023 Steadman signs are popping up in Thurston County, and they can’t figure out who is donating these to the campaign, and even if they presume the candidate is repurposing campaign from some other campaign, but the public can’t go back and even figure out how many of those older signs could potentially be used, there is a clear problem here. Critical information has been concealed from the public for years now. This campaign must go back and correct the illegal reports filed in the past and bring themselves into at least marginal semi-compliance today.

Once I noticed these obvious problems, I then looked deeper into this candidate’s troubled relationship with Washington State’s campaign finance laws. Which then led to more troubling discoveries:

3) Possible theft, misappropriation or just missing campaign funds, possibly for personal use (Violation of RCW 42.17A.445, RCW 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-238) or Secret, concealed contributions from undisclosed sources (Violation of RCW 42.17A.220(4))

Since I was already browsing this candidate’s campaign history and I seem to keep finding violations everywhere I looked I noticed some very concerning trends in mystery funds appearing or disappearing from various Michael Steadman campaigns. I will start out by detailing the specifics:

A. The 2023 Michael Steadman for Thurston County Commissioner (position 5) campaign begins the campaign breaking the law with the very first C4 they file. In fact, the first C4 filed by this campaign begins with a reported balance of \$1,000 (PDC C4 Report # 110135175, see attached). Where did these secret funds come from since there had never been a race for Thurston County Commission position 5 in history? Position 5 was created by the voters of Thurston County when they agreed to expand the Thurston County Commission seats from 3 to 5. There was no previous fund balance of \$1k, this is just an illegal, secret

contribution which has been inserted into this campaign in a stealthy way to conceal the true source from the public.

B. Similarly to the above 2023 example, the Steadman for Thurston County Commissioner (position 3) campaign begins that campaign as well by breaking the law with the very first C4 they file. In that campaign, the first C4 begins with a reported mystery balance of \$848.23 (PDC C4 Report #100898755, see attached). Again, where did these secret funds come from since Steadman had no previous campaign for Thurston County Commission position 3? Keep in mind, the final C4 closing this account appears to indicate a balance of \$1,642.76. (PDC C4 Report # 110004434, see attached). Where did those funds go? If the Steadman campaign transferred them to the 2023 campaign, that would be illegal, at least as they reported it in their campaign account, and then, even if so, what happened to the extra \$642.76, which remains unaccounted for today.

C. Then, I looked at the Steadman for Lacey City Council campaigns, and the troubling pattern continues. For example, on the last C4 filed by the Steadman for Lacey City Council 2017 campaign, this successful race ended with \$2,395.74 in the account (PDC C4 Report # 100811508 see attached). Please note this C4 was clearly marked as the last report for this campaign. Then, when Steadman runs for reelection in 2021, his campaign begins with a balance of \$1,242.88 (PDC C4 Report # 110009687). Where did the missing \$1,152.86 go? Did Steadman pocket the funds and fail to report this fact? Did someone else steal it? What happened?

Okay, so then I thought I would check to see if Michael Steadman has a Surplus Funds account. Even though there are no reports of transfers to or from a Surplus Funds account by the Steadman campaign on campaign C4s, this politician has raised somewhere around \$200,000 in the last few years on various successful and unsuccessful races, so there is bound to be excess cash secreted away somewhere. Maybe there was some interest in using a surplus account?

D. It turns out there is a Michael Steadman Surplus account. It was established shortly after Steadman's failed 2020 campaign for the Thurston County Commissioner (Position 3) race. \$1,000 appeared in this account on February 10, 2022 (PDC C4 Report # 110073720 see attached), however it isn't clear where these funds came from or who put them here. Additionally, it doesn't appear that these funds have been used to explain the mystery appearing funds referenced above because according to the last C4 filed in this Surplus account, \$950 are still there (PDC C4 Report # 110099148 see attached). It isn't clear what happened to the missing \$50, which remains unaccounted for as well.

All the mystery disappearing and reappearing cash amounts detailed above indicate shady activity and a possible effort to deceive the public on source of funds or where the funds vanish. It is likely the PDC staff will find additional violations if they look a bit closer here. Due to incomplete, inaccurate, or missing information caused by this candidate's failure (and the failure of their treasurers) to follow the law, I'm not sure it is possible for anyone in the public to figure this out without PDC staff involvement and possible use of subpoena powers

to review actual bank account balances and transaction history at various time in this candidate's recent campaign history.

I want to point out, for PDC staff reference, there are also orphaned campaigns under Michael Steadman's name that may or may not still have cash in them or these are secret funds that have also vanished into the unknown. For example, there is an odd 2018 campaign for Lacey City Council which reported about \$3k in contributions and \$5.7k in expenditures, but which still supposedly has \$888.23 left in it, according to the last filed C4 (PDC C4 Report # 100873599, see attached). What the heck is this, why was it created since this candidate had a successful 2017 and 2021 campaign for a Lacey City Council seat and a failed 2020 campaign for Thurston County Commissioner Position 3 race in 2020? Are these funds missing now too? How do you get a balance of \$888.23 when only \$3k was reported as donations and expenses were \$5,700? Even with Common Core math games, it is hard to come to that final conclusion.

Steadman - A History of Lawbreaking

I will point out for the record that Michael Steadman has been caught by PDC staff breaking the law in the past, and he has been fined \$100 for failing to file his financial affairs information with the PDC (See PDC Enforcement Case #93216 – 2021, see attached MOU from that case). This politician just doesn't seem to care about the public's right to know and this history of lawbreaking is evident in just the basic information I uncovered in a few minutes casually reviewing his campaigns.

Clearly, the various Michael Steadman campaigns deserve a deep dive audit to sort out the missing funds, source of mystery cash, and the compliance with basic Washington State campaign finance law. It looks messy and sketchy to me, but I'm confident the PDC staff has the expertise, ability and tools to get to the bottom of this mess.

Feel free to let me know if you want any more details.

I'm filing this complaint now, not because I'm done identifying violations committed by this candidate, but because I ran out of time and need to go feed the chickens and clean some chicken coops. I hope this was enough to get you started.
