ORDER ON MOTION FOR  
RECONSIDERATION

Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration was considered by the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission (PDC, Commission) on October 24, 2024, by in-person, telephonic, and online streaming access. The hearing was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and 42.17A RCW, and Chapter 390-37 WAC.

Commissioners present in-person were Allen Hayward, Commission Chair, J. Robert Leach (Commission Vice-Chair, presiding), and Commissioners Nancy Isserlis and Douglass North. Commissioner James Oswald recused himself. Also present in-person were Assistant Attorney General John S. Meader representing the Commission, and Senior Assistant Attorney General Chad Standifer, representing PDC Staff. Attorney Callie Castillo, representing Let's Go Washington, appeared through online streaming access. Notice of the hearing was provided to both parties and each appeared through counsel. The proceeding was open to the public and recorded.

1 The PDC's Final Order was served on October 9, 2024. Respondent's Motion for  
2 Reconsideration and the Declaration of Callie Castillo were received by the PDC on October 21,  
3 2024. The PDC filed its response on October 23, 2024. Argument from Counsel was provided  
4 at the October 24, 2024, hearing for the Commission's consideration. Pursuant to WAC 390-  
5 37-100(3)(c) the Commission has the authority to rule on procedural matters, objections, and  
6 motions.

7 I. ORDER

8 The Motion for Reconsideration is DENIED. The Respondent has not met any of the  
9 limited criteria under WAC 390-37-150(4) to allow for reconsideration of the  
10 Commission's Final Order. The Commission's Order issued October 9, 2024, remains  
11 the Final Order.


