To Whom It May Concern:

This letter responds to the complaint from Mr. Glen Morgan that the Commission received on July 31st, 2023. Mr. Morgan alleges that the committee has violated reporting requirements. Below I address the alleged violation identified in Mr. Morgan's complaint.

## **Missing Employer and Occupations**

Mr. Morgan identified eight donors whose employer and occupation information was requested and not received. These donations totaled \$1,775 out of a \$5.5 million campaign. The campaign used its best efforts to collect this information from donors.

## Failure to report in-kind contributions

The committee reported all debts and inkinds. There have been no changes.

## **Debts Details**

At the time of the filing, the state's filing software was character limited. All debts were reported, however this limitation truncated the purpose descriptions.
