To whom it may concern,

It has recently come to my attention that the SEIU 775 Quality Health Care PAC corporation violated campaign disclosure laws per RCW 42.17A, during the recent 2023 primary campaign for the city of Burien City Council races. The violations are as follows:

1) Failure to provide legally required details on Independent Expenditure Forms (Violation of RCW 42.17A.260(3)(C), WAC 390-16-037, 42.17A.240, 42.17A.305)

It appears that this mega secretive dark money corporate PAC has expended over \$30,000 to influence the outcome of the 2023 primary election results in the City of Burien for one city council seat alone. Unfortunately, they have chosen to also conceal the critical legally required details about these expenditures from the public by failing to provide details on their C-6 reports influencing this race as clearly required by RCW 42.17A.260.

This well-funded PAC, which has the resources to hire professional compliance, legal, and treasurer support and which is very familiar with Washington State's campaign finance laws for many years of political activity still chose to knowingly break the law. This is all the more shocking considering the fact this professional, corporately funded PAC was found guilty by the PDC staff for previous violations of Washington's Campaign Finance Laws and they were forced to pay a penalty, with a balance on this penalty suspended if they would only decide to stop breaking the law (See attached – PDC Enforcement Case #107108)

The date of all these expenditures, which concealed critical information from the public, clearly fell within the critical 21 day window of the August election as referenced in RCW 42.17A.260(1)(a). I will also note for the record, this PAC colluded to break the law with known campaign finance lawbreaker Moxie Media (See AG Stipulated Judgement from 2011 with a \$250,000 fine attached for reference)

Specifically, I will list the wide range of violations committed by this secretive dark money corporat PAC below:

This appears to have been a willful violation committed in an effort to conceal this critical information from the public over the final few weeks of the campaign so that the public would not be aware of the details involved in this dark money funding flowing into this small city by outside sources. This is a knowing, willful violation of the campaign finance laws by experienced insiders who know better and appear willing to mock the process, the PDC, the law, and the public with their deceptive efforts.

The next logical question when investigating this mega-corporate PAC, of course, is logical. What else are they concealing?

Please note, this PAC has violated Washington State's election laws in the past, as I detailed above. I'm sure they will continue to break the law in the future.

I believe I have provided enough detail and evidence for the PDC staff to pursue this complaint effectively. However, please let me know if you need further information on this issue.

Pursuant to the brief enforcement hearing (brief adjudicative proceeding) notice sent to SEIU 775 Benefits Group on April 18, 2022, a brief adjudicative proceeding was held on May 19, 2022, remotely from Olympia, WA by live audio and online transmission, to consider whether the Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.630 by failing to file a Lobbyist Employer's Annual Report (L-3 Report) as a lobbyist employer for the 2021 calendar year. The L-3 report was due to be filed by February 28, 2022.

The hearing was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 RCW and 42.17A RCW and Chapter 390-37 WAC. Commission Vice Chair Nancy Isserlis was the Presiding Officer. Commission staff was represented by Tabitha Townsend, Jordan Campbell, and Tabatha Blacksmith, Compliance Coordinators. The Respondent participated in the hearing via videoconference.

Having considered the evidence, the Presiding Officer finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Respondent was a registered lobbyist employer in the State of Washington during calendar year 2021.
- 2. As a registered lobbyist employer, the Respondent was required to file an L-3 report by February 28, 2022, disclosing lobbying expenditures made during 2021.
- 3. The Respondent filed the missing L-3 report for 2021 prior to the date of the hearing.
- 4. The Respondent has no prior violations.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the above facts, as a matter of law, the Presiding Officer concludes as follows:

- 1. This matter was duly and properly convened and all jurisdictional, substantive, and procedural requirements have been satisfied.
- 2. The Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.630 by failing to file the L-3 report by February 28, 2022 as required.

ORDER

On the basis of the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law,

- 1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent is assessed a total civil penalty of \$150, in accordance with the L-3 penalty schedule set forth in WAC 390-37-143, of which \$150 is suspended.
- 2. It is further ordered that \$150 of the \$150 penalty is suspended upon the following condition(s):
 - a. The Respondent is not found to have committed any further violations of Chapter 42.17A RCW or Title 390 WAC within four years of the date of this Order. The suspended penalty shall not be assessed based solely upon any remediable violation, minor violation, or error classified by the Commission as appropriate to address by a technical correction.



ORDERED that Defendants, jointly and severally, are hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$250,000, and \$40,000 in attorneys fees and costs, under the provisions of RCW 42.17, payable to the State of Washington. It is further

ORDERED that the amount of \$140,000 of the assessed penalty is hereby suspended until December 31, 2015 contingent upon Defendants' compliance with the provisions of RCW 42.17/RCW 42.17A. Until the end of the suspension period, if any Defendant is found to have violated RCW 42.17/RCW 42.17A, the suspended portion of the penalty of \$140,000 shall immediately become due and payable without further intervention of the Court. It is further

ORDERED that Defendants shall pay to the State of Washington the unsuspended portion of the assessed civil penalty (\$110,000) in the following manner: \$35,000 no later than December 31, 2012; \$35,000 no later than December 31, 2014. It is further

ORDERED that Defendants shall pay to the State of Washington the amount of \$40,000 as attorney fees and costs no later than December 31, 2011. It is further
