To whom it may concern,

It has recently come to my attention that Dontae Payne, both in his 2021 campaign for Olympia City Council and also in his current Mayoral campaign has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**). The details of these violations are as follows:

# 1) Attempt to conceal legally required information from the public by refusing to share this information on his financial affairs reports (Violation of RCW 42.17A.710)

The first violation I noticed was the fact this candidate has concealed a significant source of corporate income from his financial affairs report. Specifically, this income should be reflected, but was kept secret from the public on Mr. Payne's three F-1 reports on file with the PDC. This includes the one filed on 7/11/2021, on 3/27/2022, and on 4/3/2023. I've attached all three for Staff reference.

According to all three of Mr. Payne's filed F1s, he indicates that he has a spouse or registered domestic partner named Jason Weigold. While this corporation was listed on Payne's F1s, strangely he failed to report the income from this spousal/domestic partner corporation. I've attached a screen capture from the Secretary of State's website, just verifying this corporation exists and that Jason Weigold is the principal Governor of that entity. State law clearly requires this to be reported in the Income section of the F1s, and Mr. Payne will need to go back and correct all three historic F1s as well as correctly reveal the truth on future F1s he files with the commission.

# 2) Failure to timely report contributions or expenditures (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)

I realized after recently identifying the egregious nature of late reports I have documented from the Thurston County Democrats, the Thurston County Democratic Women's PAC, and the North Thurston Citizens for Schools PAC that I better start looking closer at the terrible pattern of behavior by some of our local candidates in Thurston County.

I reviewed the history of late reports for this well-funded politician, which requires a fairly extensive comparison between when the reports are due and when they were actually filed. A distressing pattern of behavior has been uncovered by doing this simple research for both political campaigns in which he has been on the ballot the last few years. Clearly it might be

more transparent for this politician to start filing their reports in a timely manner on a more frequent basis. In a distressingly, all too often repeated pattern, this candidate files reports late (21 reports, to be exact). Many of these reports have been filed weeks and even months late, and many of them (I have highlighted these in red for PDC Staff to easily review) concealed significant financial transactions over \$1000 in totals for these egregiously late illegal reports. In an effort to help PDC staff properly categorize the lateness of these reports, and the sloppiness of this organization's operation, my attached spreadsheets provide a color-coded reference category for helpful sorting. Please keep in mind, so far, this is the worst violator I have uncovered for this type of violation in the state this month:

- Red (Extremely late harming the public's right to know) 6 extremely late reports up to 140 days late (over a year!). There really is no excuse for these extremely late reports to have concealed so much critical information from the public for so long.
- Orange (Concerningly late delaying the public's right to know) 8 concerningly late reports up to 12 days late. Again, clearly not legal and not following the law.
- Yellow (Sloppily late delayed reporting) 8 sloppily late reports up to 4 days late. These could just be mistakes, sloppy bookkeeping, and written off as typical fumbling around by the treasurer, however, I'm including them in this report so that PDC staff can put this general widespread pattern of lawbreaking in proper context.

Again, I've provided both an Excel file and PDF version of the same file for ease of staff and the lawbreaker's reference as they re-educate themselves with Washington State's campaign finance laws and are reminded that these laws apply to them as well. They are not exempt from them as much as they might want to pretend these laws don't matter.

#### Some notes on documenting these violation:

Again, as I strive to provide the best data possible both for efficiency of staff and the lawbreakers I have identified, every report can be direct linked to the URL in the far right hand column. The date the report was due is provided and the actual date it was finally sent to the PDC and the total number of days late for those reports is included for ease of PDC staff research effort, and to quantify the significance of these violations both individually and cumulatively with the obvious problems caused by not informing the public about the truth of their activities in a timely manner.

# 3) Total concealment of all donors, expenditure information from the public (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, 42.17A.235)

In addition to the other violations I have documented in this complaint, this candidate clearly failed to report the filing fee for this office in 2023. They did report the filing fee when they ran for the City Council seat in 2021, but for some reason, failed to do so in the current 2023 race. There is no good reason or excuse to conceal this information from the public. Yet, this has been concealed from the public by a veteran politician and they have violated the law. For clarification of the need to report this expenditure, I've attached the relevant AGO (**AGO 1974:16 attached**) which clearly spells this out as it applies in this case.

Other expenditures may be concealed from the public by this candidate, but this one just stood out as obvious.

4) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Once I realized this politician would break the law with such carelessness, I noticed that this candidate had used WinPower Strategies as a consultant in the 2021 race, and the violations became more understandable. This disregard for the law is common for candidates using this consultant, I have found. So I started to look closer at this campaign. It turns out this campaign has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course).

Here are just five specific examples of failing to detail how many campaign signs or mailers were purchased – A clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B:

- On October 18, 2021 This candidate claims to have used shady vendor "WinPower Strategies Inc" and reportedly spent \$4,742.30 on "Graphic Design Mailpiece" but no amount for the mailpieces given as clearly legally required and specified in WAC 390-16-037, example B (See PDC Report #110058716, attached for Staff Reference). Also, please note, even this vendor can't pretend they charged over \$4700 just for "graphic design," so the failure to breakdown the true costs of the mailer itself is problematic as well.
- On May 6, 2021 This candidate claims to have used vendor "WinPower Strategies Inc" (again) and reportedly spent \$3,423.50 on "Yard Signs, Thank You Cards, and Web Development" but no amount for the signs was given as clearly legally required and specified in WAC 390-16-037, example B (See PDC Report # 110025850, attached for Staff Reference) For the record on THIS C4 (for the council seat in 2021, they DID report the state filing fee, so this candidate knows the law he just chose to ignore it in 2023 when he ran for mayor).
- On July 30, 2021 This candidate claims to have used vendor "WinPower Strategies, Inc" (of course) and reportedly spent \$2,866.21 on "graphic design and printing" but, again, no clarification of what what printed, how many were printed, or what the heck this really was. This is despite being clearly legally required and specified in WAC 390-16-037, example B (See PDC Report #110046810, attached for Staff Reference).
- On July 13, 2021 This candidate claims to have used vendor "WinPower Strategies, inc" (who else?) and reportedly spent \$2,000 on "Digital Advertising/Banner Ads" but, once again, no details provided, despite the clear legal requirements to do so. Where did the ads run? How many were produced? Did they launch the ads on PornHub? This lack of transparency despite being so clearly legally required and specified in WAC 390-16-037 (See PDC Report #110036893, attached for Staff Reference).
- On October 28, 2021 This candidate claims to have used (and probably really did) vendor "WinPower Strategies Inc" and reportedly spent \$1,141.00 on "Doorbelling Lit Reprint" but no amount given, despite how clearly this was legally required and specified

# in WAC 390-16-037, example B (See PDC Report #110065993, attached for Staff Reference).

- To be fair to this campaign, the solution to this violation is at a minimum (in addition to whatever sanctions the PDC chooses to impose, this campaign must go back and correct all these legally deficient C3 reports. It may be years late, but at least the truth can finally be known to the public. Truth denied or concealed for so long is bad enough, but at least it can finally be corrected by this lawbreaking crew.
- I'm sure I can find more violations as this campaign fumbles forward, but this is enough for the evening, and enough to get the investigation started.
- Let me know if you want any more violations or details related to this candidate or these two campaigns.

A candidate for elective office who is required to pay a filing fee under RCW 29.18.050 must treat that fee as an expenditure under the campaign expenditure reporting requirements of Initiative No. 276.

#### Dear Sir:

By letter previously acknowledged the commission has requested our opinion on a question which we paraphrase as follows:

Must a candidate for elective office who is required to pay a filing fee under RCW 29.18.050 treat that fee as an expenditure under the campaign expenditure reporting requirements of Initiative No. 276?

We answer this question in the affirmative for the reasons set forth in our analysis.

#### **ANALYSIS**

Your question involves the campaign financing provisions of Initiative No. 276 (now codified as chapter 42.17 RCW), insofar as they relate to expenditures by candidates or [[Orig. Op. Page 2]] political committees. 1/

This new disclosure law, which was approved by the voters at the November, 1972, state general election, contains several provisions relating to the reporting of political campaign

expenditures. First, § 8 (now codified as RCW 42.17.080) provides that when a campaign treasurer is designated by a candidate or political committee there must be filed a "report of all contributions received and <u>expenditures made</u> in the election campaign prior to that date." (Emphasis supplied.) Then, RCW 42.17.090 (codifying § 9) sets out the general requirements for the reporting of such expenditures. Among the items of information that must be reported pursuant to this section are "the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of \$25.00 or more, and the amount, date and purpose of each such expenditure." (RCW 42.17.090(1) (f).) Further, subsection (1)(g) of RCW 42.17.090 requires the continual reporting of the total sum of a candidate's campaign expenditures.

The term "expenditure" itself is defined in § 2 of the act (RCW 42.17.020(12)) as meaning:

"... a payment, contribution, subscription, distribution, loan, advance, deposit, or gift of money or anything of value, and includes a contract, promise, or agreement, [[Orig. Op. Page 3]] whether or not legally enforceable, to make an expenditure. The term 'expenditure' also includes a promise to pay, a payment or a transfer of anything of value in exchange for goods, services, property, facilities or anything of value for the purpose of assisting, benefiting or honoring any public official or candidate, or assisting in furthering or opposing any election campaign."

In other words, an expenditure, for the purposes of the act, includes any transfer or payment of anything of value which is made for the purpose of assisting a public official or candidate in furthering his election campaign. This leads us to your present question; i.e., whether the statutory filing fee provided for in RCW 29.18.050 constitutes such an "expenditure."

Insofar as is here material, this statute provides as follows:

"A fee of one dollar must accompany each declaration of candidacy for a precinct office without salary; a fee of ten dollars for any office with a compensation attached of one thousand dollars per annum or less; a fee equal to one percent of the annual compensation for any office with a compensation attached of more than one thousand dollars per annum."

The significance of this filing fee will readily be seen when the foregoing statute is read in conjunction with RCW 29.18.030, which provides that:

"The name of no candidate shall be printed upon the official ballot used at a state primary, unless not earlier than the last Monday of July nor later than the next succeeding Friday, a declaration of candidacy is filed in the form hereinafter set forth . . ."

Although situated in a chapter of the election code dealing with partisan primaries and elections, these two statutes (RCW 29.180.030 and 29.18.050) apply not only to elections for partisan offices but, as well, to elections for nonpartisan offices under chapter 29.21 RCW. See, RCW 29.21.020. In [[Orig. Op. Page 4]] AGO 1974 No. 12 [[to A. Ludlow Kramer, Secretary of State on June 28, 1974]], copy enclosed, however, we recently advised that the filing fee requirement of RCW 29.18.050 is no longer constitutionally enforceable, in view of a recent United States Supreme Court decision, in the case of indigent persons who are financially unable to pay the fee required for the particular office they are seeking.

With this exception, however, it is readily to be seen that for the purposes of the election law, a person seeking election to a particular office for which a filing fee is prescribed may not become an official candidate unless he has paid the required filing fee in conjunction with the filing of his

declaration of candidacy. From this it follows, in our opinion, that the filing fee <u>does</u> constitute an "expenditure," for the purposes of Initiative No. 276, in view of the definition contained in § 2 (RCW 42.17.020(12)), supra.

In simplest terms, this payment (in those cases in which it is required) is a necessary part of the candidate's financial outlay if he is to have his name appear on the ballot and, in that manner, become eligible to be elected to the office he is seeking. Moreover, the payment is very clearly a transfer of something of value and it cannot be doubted that it is for the purpose of assisting the candidate and furthering his election campaign. Payment of the filing fee is thus precisely within the broad definition of "expenditure" as set forth above. We must therefore answer your question, as above paraphrased, in the affirmative.

We trust the foregoing will be of assistance to you.

 $\underline{1}$ /The terms "candidate" and "political committee" are defined in RCW 42.17.020(5) and (22), respectively, as follows:

- "(5) 'Candidate' means any individual who seeks election to public office. An individual shall be deemed to seek election when he first:
- "(a) Receives contribution or makes expenditures or reserves space or facilities with intent to promote his candidacy for office; or
  - "(b) Announces publicly or files for office.

"...

"(22) 'Political committee' means any person (except a candidate or an individual dealing with his own funds or property) having the expectation of receiving contributions or making expenditures in support of, or opposition to, any candidate or any ballot proposition."
