<u>Glen Morgan</u> reported via the portal (Fri, 18 Aug 2023 at 12:28 PM)

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention (once again) that the Lewis County Democrats are violating Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**). The specific violations are as follows:

1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, months, or more to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)

I realize this allegation doesn't surprise anyone who has paid any attention to this shady group over the past few years. This crew was caught breaking this exact law last time (PDC Enforcement Case #26735 and was formally sanctioned with a Warning Letter at the time – See attached Warning Letter and original complaint I filed against this crew in late 2017). This group apparently enjoys breaking the law, so I thought I would revisit their activities once again and help the PDC address this troubled group and their wayward ways.

PDC Staff note: It appears, just like in a few other enforcement cases I've referenced to the PDC recently, Case #26735 is incorrectly organized with the named Treasurer as the Respondent rather than the PAC name, which has become the normal naming convention for the past 10 years. It is possible someone on the IT side of things might want to make that correction).

As has been my habit lately, I've attached a spreadsheet with color-coded sorting for the egregiously late reports (red). Normally, for variety sake at least, I'd also highlight the problematic late reports (orange), and the sloppily late reports (yellow). However, everything they did was way out of compliance and not even close to the legal requirements on timeliness of reporting, so everything is red.

Frankly, this was impressive that after receiving their last warning letter from the PDC based on my last complaint, it just looks like they decided to escalate their break their lawbreaking. I don't quite understand that behavior, but it seems to be common – maybe all the cool kids are doing it? This is even more impressive considering the fact this group had shifted from mini-reporting to full reporting just a few years ago and then promptly decided to break the law on a regular basis (go back and read the last warning letter they got). Weird, I know, but I have found some of these guys just enjoy violating Washington State's campaign laws out of habit and almost like an addiction, and this group seems to fall into that category.

Again, I've provided both an Excel file and PDF version of the same file for ease of staff and the lawbreaker's reference as they re-educate themselves with Washington State's campaign finance laws and are reminded that these laws apply to them as well. They are not exempt from them as much as they might want to pretend these laws don't matter or apply to them.

Some notes on documenting these violations:

Again, as I strive to provide the best data possible both for efficiency of staff and the lawbreakers I have identified, every report can be directly linked to the URL in the far-right hand column. The date the report was due is provided and the actual date it was finally sent to the PDC and the total number of days late for

those reports is included for ease of PDC staff research effort, and to quantify the significance of these violations both individually and cumulatively with the obvious problems caused by not informing the public about the truth of their activities in a timely manner.

2. Failure to timely update C1pc to include current officers, essentially keeping the true officers of this PAC secret from the public (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205(2))

I will note for the record that this PAC has struggled in the past with timely filing and updating of their C1PC registration forms (this came up in the last PDC enforcement case against this crew (**See PDC Enforcement Case #26735 warning letter attached for staff reference**).

However, this list of officers on the current C1PC on file with the PDC seems to be outdated and not consistent with the list of officers promoted on their own website (**screen capture attached for staff reference**). This group may also be responsible for the great crime of misgendering one of their officers who appears to be non-binary on their website, but then, consistent with patriarchal hierarchy and probably a bit of latent racism and homophobia tossed into the mix this political group decided to conceal some of the truth on their actual C1PC filings. I'm not here to judge their racism, homophobia, sexism, or misgendering problems and theoretically the PDC doesn't have authority over that anyway, however these types of discrepancies might clearly indicate they need to update their C1PC filings with the PDC so that the public can know the truth about exactly who or what is running this operation.

3. Failure to list the vendor and the address of the vendor for in-kind contributions, therefore concealing from the public the true source of these contributions (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235)

When an individual or entity makes a donation of goods or services to a political committee so that the committee may attempt to sell these goods or services to others in exchange for money, this is an in-kind contribution.

I want to draw attention to the PDC's own website recommendations for how PACs and campaigns need to report this information.

Specifically, I want to draw attention to the PDC's specific requirements of reporting:

"In-kind donations that are not incidental **must** be fully reported in Part 1 of Schedule B to the C-4 **with the following details:** the date the contribution was received; the name and full address of the contributor; **if the in-kind contribution is a good or service purchased from a vendor, include the name and address of the vendor**; a brief description of the contribution; its fair market value; the cumulative total this contributor has given for the primary or general election, whichever applies; a designation whether this contribution is for the primary or general election; and if the contributor is an individual who has cumulatively given more than \$250 to the campaign, including both primary and general contributions, identify the individual's employer (by name, city and state) and occupation."

This committee has failed to do this for both auction items and regular in-kind contributions.

For both staff and the lawbreaker's reference, I will detail just one of the many deficient examples **provided**, so that the obvious lawbreaking can be more efficiently spotted and hopefully corrected in the future to prevent the need to file complaints like this one:

• Violation Example #1- \$161.59 on 4/4/2023 (PDC Report #100880069, attached for staff reference), the address for the vendor where generous in-kind contributor Carol Brock purchased the goods is not provided, despite the crystal-clear legal requirement to do so.

There are numerous other examples of this failure to follow the law with most of the in-kind contributions this PAC has reported, but fortunately, this PAC can easily go back and correct these reports to get back to at least a pretense of compliance.

The Lewis County Democrats – a strange history of lawbreaking continues

As referenced earlier in this complaint, this shady political group has a history of breaking the law, even when they are filing as mini-reporting, which frankly takes a lot of work. I've already attached the Warning letter from a few years ago based on my complaint filed against this group in 2017 (See **PDC Enforcement Case #26735**, attached for **PDC staff reference**).

This history of lawbreaking is impressive considering the smaller volume of cash they reportedly process and the lack of political success this group experiences on a regular basis. It is possible people can find their identity in a variety of ways, and perhaps the non-binary approach this group is taking is an effort to see what laws they can break without getting caught. I don't judge, I just expose the truth, and I encourage PDC staff to provide more aggressive guidance with this group and recognize that, based on recent history here, it appears almost certain that whatever has been reported to the PDC probably doesn't match the actual facts of what is in their bank account or how they have spent it.

In the end, I'm optimistic this group can start to follow the law with enough sanctions and fines to remind them.

It has come to my attention that the Lewis County Democratic Central Committee has habitually and willfully committed frequent and multiple violations of **RCW 42.17A.**

1) Failure to file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

On their most recent C1-pc forms (for both their exempt and non-exempt accounts), the Committee opted for the "full-reporting" option, requiring them to file frequent, accurate reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, and debt. Unfortunately, the Lewis County Democratic Central Committee has failed on numerous occasions to do this. *See attached C1-pc documents.*

As you can see from this link, the Committee has been making multiple donations with their money, as recently as March of 2017:

This is clearly an active Committee that has hidden its financial activity from the public for a period spanning nearly half of a decade. The Lewis County Democratic Central Committee must immediately begin filing reports for the period of time they failed to file reports.

2) Failure to timely update C1-pc. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205(4))

State law requires that any material change in information previously submitted in a statement of organization shall be reported to the commission within the ten days following the change.

On information and belief, numerous changes in the information included on the 2009 statements of organization have changed. This includes, but is not limited to, the officers of the committee and the committee treasurer.

These statements must be amended immediately to reflect accurate information.

The PDC should investigate the possibility that the Lewis County Democratic Central Committee committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c). If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you need any additional information.

Below is a copy of an electronic letter sent to Glen Morgan concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC).

As noted in the letter to Glen Morgan, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1) and will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.

However, pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(b), this letter serves as a formal written warning concerning the Lewis County Democratic Central Committee's (LCDCC) failure to comply with the requirement to report contributions and expenditures under the full reporting option under RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 from 2010-2017, even though the LCDCC likely qualified to report under the Mini Reporting Option during those years. Staff expects the LCDCC to file timely and complete reports in future years in accordance with PDC laws and rules.

The Commission will consider this formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed October 27, 2017. Your complaint alleged the Lewis County Democratic Central Committee (LCDCC) may have violated: (1) RCW 42.17A.205 by failing to timely file an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) updating committee information; and (2) RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 by failing to timely file complete and accurate Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Receipts & Expenditures reports (C-4 reports).

PDC staff reviewed your allegations; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the response from Sheila Johnson-Teeter, LCDCC treasurer; the applicable campaign finance reports filed by the LCDCC; and the PDC's Open Data for contributions made by or received from the LCDCC.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- The LCDCC is a bona fide county political party organization that has been registered and reporting with the PDC dating back to at least 1996.
- In February 2018, the LCDCC treasurer died suddenly and unexpectedly.
- Current party officers are not able to determine why no reports were filed from 2010-2017.

- A C-4 report filed by the LCDCC was submitted electronically on September 7, 2010, disclosing no contribution or expenditure activities for the reporting period, and showing cumulative annual contributions totaling \$4,364 and cumulative expenditures totaling \$4.011.
- Based on available records, current LCDCC leadership believes the committee stayed within the contribution and expenditure limits of the mini reporting system during the period of non-reporting and could have properly requested the Mini Reporting Option and been relieved of filing C-3 and C-4 reports (although it did not in fact do so).
- Current treasurer Sheila Johnson-Teeter attended training at the PDC on July 18, 2018.

Allegation One: Violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 for failing to timely and accurately file C-3 and C-4 reports.

- The complaint alleged that the LCDCC failed to timely and accurately file C-3 and C-4 reports from 2010-2017.
- PDC staff's investigation and review determined the LCDCC filed C-3 and C-4 reports through September 2010. The next C-3 was filed June 19, 2018.

Allegation Two: Violation of RCW 42.17A.205 for failing to file an amended statement of organization (C-1pc) with updated information, including making an annual selection of a reporting option.

- The LCDCC filed for both its exempt and non-exempt accounts in July 2009, choosing the full reporting option.
- In November 2017, the LCDCC (non-exempt account) filed a C-1pc, choosing the Mini Reporting Option. The C-1pc was then amended in June 2018 and again in August 2018 with updated treasurer information.
- The LCDCC filed its annual C-1pc January 15, 2019, choosing mini reporting.

Based on these findings, including that the Committee likely qualified for the Mini Reporting Option from 2010 to 2017, staff has determined that in this instance, the failure to file an annual C-1pc between January 1 and January 31 of each year, selecting the Mini Reporting Option, does not amount to an actual violation warranting further investigation.

However, pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1), the Lewis County Democratic Central Committee will receive a formal written warning concerning its failure to comply with the requirement to report contributions and expenditures under the full reporting option under RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 from 2010-2017, even though it likely qualified to report under the Mini Reporting Option. The formal written warning will include staff's expectation that the Lewis County Democrat Central Committee file timely and complete reports in future years in accordance with PDC laws and rules. The Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
