<b>Complaint Description</b>
<p>Glen Morgan</p> <p>Thu, 17 Aug 2023 at 1:58 AM</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that the Central Valley Citizens for Education PAC has repeatedly violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The specific violations are detailed below:</p> <p>1) Failure to timely report contributions or expenditures (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>This violation is serious. Particularly since most of the late reports this PAC filed were made AFTER the election was over. In a distressingly, all too often repeated pattern, this committee files reports late (84 reports, to be exact). Many of these reports have been filed months, or even years late. To help PDC staff properly categorize the lateness of these reports, as has been my custom recently, my attached spreadsheets provide a color-coded reference category for helpful sorting:</p> <p>Red (Extremely late – harming the public's right to know) 83 extremely late reports – up to 875 days late (or several years after the election is over). There really is no excuse for this and in fact, most of the time, this PAC chose to wait months or years to report the truth. This is frankly, absurd, but it was a consistent pattern of behavior. A terrible pattern of behavior structured to deceive the public.</p> <p>Orange (Concerningly late – delaying the public's right to know) 1 concerningly late report – this one was 12 days late. That was the best they could do. Again, not legal and not following the law, but consistent behavior in failing to follow the law.</p> <p>Again, I've provided both an Excel file and PDF version of the same file for ease of staff and the lawbreaker's reference as they re-educate themselves with Washington State's campaign finance laws and are reminded that these laws apply to them as well. They are not exempt from them as much as they might want to pretend these laws don't matter. Please note, often these reports were for expenses more than \$10,000, and typically filed years or months AFTER the election was over.</p> <p>Some notes on documenting these violations:</p>

Again, as I strive to provide the best data possible both for efficiency of staff and the lawbreakers I have identified, every report can be directly linked to the URL in the far-right hand column. The date the report was due is provided and the actual date it was finally sent to the PDC and the total number of days late for those reports is included for ease of PDC staff research effort, and to quantify the significance of these violations both individually and cumulatively with the obvious problems caused by not informing the public about the truth of their activities in a timely manner.

As a committee theoretically dedicated to supporting education for children, it is mind-boggling that they were primarily educating the children on how to break the law – something this PAC has managed to do very effectively, unfortunately. Hardly a good example for the next generation.

2) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Once I realized this PAC was breaking the law so egregiously and with such carelessness, I started to look closer at this campaign. It turns out this campaign has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently – in fact, most of the time (of course). Here are just a sampling of specific examples of failing to detail how many campaign signs or mailers were purchased – A clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B and Example A:

On January, 2021 (Example #1, #2, #3)– This PAC claims to have reportedly spent \$19,100 – on “television advertisements” but no specific details (how many ads? What date? What stations?) given as clearly legally required and specified in WAC 390-16-037, example A, also on the same report note the \$1,161 spent on “Spokesman Review” for “advertisement” and again, no details provided (how many ads, what date? What size? – just nothing) – a classic violation of WAC 390-16-037, example A. Not just this, but the third violation on the same report was when this PAC spent \$1,525.92 for “signs” – and true to form – no details – how many – a classic almost perfect violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B (See PDC Report #110012964, attached for Staff Reference for all three of these violations).

On April 2, 2021 (See PDC Report # 110077575, attached for Staff Reference), this PAC claims to have spent \$925 on “newspaper/periodical advertising” but again, no details provided (what dates? How many? What size?), another clear violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example A. Please note, on the same report, this PAC claims to have reimbursed for “Facebook Ads” to a “Narla Nunberg” \$1048.33. Again, no details provided, and not even an original in-kind vendor detail provided (what is the true source of these ads and the vendor address?) Just perpetual lawbreaking here.

On December 30, 2019 (See PDC Report # 110007721, attached for Staff reference), this PAC claims to have spent \$3,113.86 on “Signs” but as usual, no legally required details provided (how many?) – clear violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B. On the same report, this PAC claims to have spent \$464.40 on “Newspaper ad”, but again, zero legally required details provided (how many? What dates? What size?) – another violation of WAC 390-16-037 – Example A.

On January 30, 2020, (See PDC Report # 110007722, attached for Staff reference), this PAC claims to have spent \$1,160.00 on “newspaper ad” in the Spokesman Review but again they decided to violate WAC 390-16-037, Example A so clearly by failing to report how many ads, what date the ads were placed, size of the ads, etc.

On February 1, 2021 – every single expenditure reported was in violation of the law (See PDC Report # 110007727, attached for Staff Reference). Every single expenditure! “Direct Mailing” from “Tribune Publishing” – this PAC claims they spent \$4,140.58, but concealed how many pieces they sent (clear WAC 390-16-037, Example B violation). Just generic and illegally incomplete references to “advertisement”, or “Facebook ad reimbursement” or “Newspaper ads” but again no attempt to provide the legally required details (how many? What dates? Etc).

Unfortunately, this PAC has many problems with following the law. Another common law they broke involved a failure to properly report in-kind contribution true source and address of the true source of the services purchased or reimbursed or donated.

This PAC had ample resources to pay for even pretend, fake compliance assistance, but they chose to not do this and just consistently break the law at every opportunity.

The PDC should insist on a full audit of the bank records for this PAC, and verify the amounts in the bank compared to the reports filed years late by this PAC. Do they match? Is money missing? Why did they conceal the truth about their donations and expenditures for years, in many cases, and always wait until after the election? There was never any opportunity during any election in which this PAC participated that the public ever once saw a true or timely representation of the truth behind how they operated. This is not behavior the PDC should either excuse or look away from.

Let me know if you need more details or more examples of the lawbreaking with this PAC. I fear I have only scratched the surface here.
