Subject: Initial Hearing (Case Status Review) After Opening a Formal Investigation, Washington Education Association Political Action Committee (2), PDC Case 141529

Dear Abby Lawlor,

After conducting a preliminary review and assessment of the complaint filed by Glen Morgan on August 20, 2023 and updated on September 17, 2023, alleging that Washington Education Association Political Action Committee (2) may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 from 2018-2023 by failing to timely disclose contributions and expenditures, PDC staff opened a formal investigation and held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review) on November 17, 2023, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071. Thank you for participating in the hearing today.

At the hearing it was noted that the Case Status Review is not an adjudicative proceeding and that RCW 42.17A.755 provides PDC staff with additional tools to resolve complaints alleging non-compliance, including resolving alleged violations by agreement through stipulation or statement of understanding, or an agreement to stay enforcement pending satisfaction of conditions of deferred enforcement, and I am encouraging you to work with staff on resolving this matter.
