<b>Complaint Description</b>
<p><a href="#">Glen Morgan</a> reported via the portal (Fri, 18 Aug 2023 at 9:35 PM)</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention, once again, as it frequently has in the past, that the Pierce County Democrats, as they are inclined to do, have violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (<b>RCW 42.17A</b>). The specific violations are detailed below:</p> <p><b>1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, months, or more to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</b></p> <p>I realize this allegation doesn't surprise anyone who has paid any attention to this shady and prolific law-breaking crew over the past few years. This crew was caught breaking this exact law last time (<b>PDC Enforcement Case #46474 and was formally sanctioned with a Warning Letter at the time – See attached Warning Letter and original complaint I filed against this crew in early 2019, and also PDC Enforcement Case #44695, for which they also received a Warning Letter, and PDC Enforcement Case #18611, which triggered an AG lawsuit and settlement of \$38,520 – See Thurston Superior Court #17-2-04616-34, also attached for Staff Reference</b>). Of course This group apparently enjoys breaking the law, so I thought I would revisit their activities once again and help the PDC address this troubled group and their wayward ways.</p> <p>First, let's just review the late reporting, which is essentially an effort by this secretive, repetitively lawbreaking PAC to conceal the truth from the public for as long as they believe they can. Even a casual review of this crew's history shows they do this all the time, I've caught them multiple times and filed complaints multiple times, and the State Attorney General even sued them for this lawbreaking, but they can't seem to help themselves.</p> <p>As usual, when I'm revisiting the frequent lawbreaker club, and the Pierce County Democrats are at the top of this list, I try to provide the specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I've attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.</p> <p>A quick note again on how this report is organized. I've <b>organized it by latest report first</b>. You'll note that the latest report filed by this group was 517 days late – which is pretty late.</p> <p><b>I've color coded the most extreme late reports, of which there are 24.</b> I've color coded the problematically late orange, and there are only 7 of those 14-6 days late. Illegal, but not as egregious as most of them. I've color coded the sloppily late reports yellow, and there are only 10 of those. I also want to note, <b>I've highlighted in yellow the late reports which were filed AFTER the last warning letter was sent to this group. Obviously, they didn't take the many warning letters from the PDC very seriously</b></p>

and instead they decided to just keep breaking the law like the warning letters and AG lawsuit never happened.

## 2. Failure to list the vendor and the address of the vendor for in-kind contributions, therefore concealing from the public the true source of these contributions (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235)

When an individual or entity makes a donation of goods or services to a political committee so that the committee may attempt to sell these goods or services to others in exchange for money, this is an in-kind contribution.

I want to draw attention to the PDC's own website recommendations for how PACs and campaigns need to report this information.

Specifically, I want to draw attention to the PDC's specific requirements of reporting:

*"In-kind donations that are not incidental **must** be fully reported in Part 1 of Schedule B to the C-4 **with the following details:** the date the contribution was received; the name and full address of the contributor; **if the in-kind contribution is a good or service purchased from a vendor, include the name and address of the vendor;** a brief description of the contribution; its fair market value; the cumulative total this contributor has given for the primary or general election, whichever applies; a designation whether this contribution is for the primary or general election; and if the contributor is an individual who has cumulatively given more than \$250 to the campaign, including both primary and general contributions, identify the individual's employer (by name, city and state) and occupation."*

This committee has failed to do this for both auction items and regular in-kind contributions.

For both staff and the lawbreaker's reference, **I will detail just a few of the many deficient examples provided**, so that the obvious lawbreaking can be more efficiently spotted and hopefully corrected in the future to prevent the need to file complaints like this one:

- **Violation Example #1, #2**- Multiple In-Kind Contributions were made – one for "picnic donation" for \$75.00 and another for "food for picnic" for \$150 (**PDC Report #110044563, attached for staff reference**), the address for the vendor where generous in-kind contributors Ericka Buckley and Kathy Orlando purchased the goods is not provided, despite the crystal-clear legal requirement to do so. Another odd thing is the perfectly rounded numbers here would indicate a lack of receipts and accuracy. This is a real problem for this PAC.
- **Violation Example #3** - On **PDC Report #101011283, attached for staff reference**, this group claims they received an in-kind contribution valued at \$360 from the Washington State Democratic Party. Of course, **according to WAC 390-16-037, Example B**, this PAC must report how many signs (and signs for who?) plus they are clearly required to report where these signs originally came from – the vendor – as the PDC so clearly requires.
- **Violation Example #4, #5, #6** – On PDC Report #110127829, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims they received three different in-kind contributions, none of which provide the true source of

the items donated – including name of the vendor, and address. A clear series of violations documented here.

There are numerous other examples of this failure to follow the law with most of the in-kind contributions this PAC has reported, but fortunately, this PAC can easily go back and correct these reports to get back to at least a pretense of compliance.

**The Pierce County Democrats – a Study of an addiction to lawbreaking and how some people will never learn – no matter how many breaks they get**

In many ways, the Pierce County Democrats are one of the most prolific violators of Washington State's campaign finance laws in the last 8 years at least. The Spokane County Democrats might be the only crew more out of control, but Pierce County certainly can hold their own in the lawbreaking sweepstakes.

First, **I filed my first PDC complaint against this group in 2017** (attached for staff reference), which became **PDC Enforcement Case #18611**. I documented so many late reports, so much information concealed from the public, and such a massive pattern of deception and dishonesty, this **forced the Washington State Attorney General to file a lawsuit against the Pierce County Democrats** (also attached for staff reference, and since the PDC claims they don't have access to this original document, it can be added to the case file for 18611 or the AG lawsuit case file on the PDC's Enforcement Case list). In the end, **this \$38,520 friendly settlement was given the most favorable terms possible by Washington State Attorney General Bob Ferguson**. I will note for the record that the attorney for the Pierce County Democrats was the recently resigned Executive Director of the Public Disclosure Commission – Evelyn Lopez (you can see her signature on the final settlement document when she signed on behalf of the Pierce County Democrats). The **most unique aspect of this settlement was the fact that for the first time in state history, since the campaign finance laws were approved by citizens initiative in 1972, the Attorney General approved a payment plan for the judgement with this group**. The AG later settled cases in the same way with similar payment plans, but the Pierce County Democrats were first.

If that was all, this trip down memory lane would end now, but of course, it isn't. The Pierce County Democrats immediately started breaking the same laws again after the AG settlement and while they were still making their regular payments on the original fine. I caught them filing late reports again and again (just like now), and this became **PDC Enforcement Case #46474** and I also caught them failing to update their C1PC documents (which became **PDC Enforcement Case #44695**). Despite violating the law, repeatedly during their probationary period from the AG, **this PAC was able to skate by with just a few Warning Letters** issued by the PDC for their continuing lawbreaking (I've attached this for PDC staff reference).

Clearly, lawbreaking is a way of life for the Pierce County Democrats and with no consequences for breaking the law – why not? I'll just continue to do my best to document it all so that the public can be aware of this pattern of behavior.

Let me know if you need any more details on this report, and PDC staff is welcome to post up the original settlement documents from **Thurston County Superior Court Case #17-2-04616-34, which I have attached for reference**. If this helps complete some missing information on the PDC Enforcement lists, then I'm happy to help with that as well.

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaints you filed on October 23, 2018 and January 3, 2019. Your complaints alleged that the Pierce County Democratic Central Committee (PCDCC), a bona fide political party committee may have violated: (1) RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), disclosing contributions and expenditures undertaken by the Campaign; and (2) RCW 42.17A.205 by failing to timely file an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) within ten days disclosing any material change in the committee information.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations listed in the two complaints you filed; the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the response provided by Dominick Bergeron, former Treasurer for Pierce County Democratic Central Committee; the applicable PDC reports filed by Respondent; and queried the Respondent's data in the PDC contribution and expenditure database, to determine whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On September 10, 2018, Pierce County Democratic Central Committee (Committee) filed an amended C-1pc report as a Continuing Bona Fide Political Party Committee selecting the "Full Reporting" option and listing Tim Farrell as Chair and Committee Manager, Dominick Bergeron as Committee Treasurer, Angel Swanson as Vice-Chair, and Patricia Dailey as Secretary.
- On January 7, 2019, PCDCC filed an amended C-1pc report listing Kathy Orlando as Chair and Committee Manager, Rick Offner as Committee Treasurer, Eric Herde as Vice-Chair, and Diane Sandowski as Secretary.

**Summary of PDC Case 42704**

- Staff's review of the spreadsheet attached to the complaint alleging late filed C-3 and C-4 reports, is broken down as follows:

1. The Committee submitted 22 initially filed C-3 reports, and seven amended C-3 reports; and six initially filed C-4 reports, and 16 amended C-4 reports.
  2. The majority of the alleged late filed C-3 and C-4 reports filed by the Committee included both initially and amended C-3 and C-4 reports covered the period of December 8, 2016 through October 23, 2018.
  3. Staff believes that the allegations concerning those late filed reports are covered by the Settlement agreement that was entered into between the PCDCC and the Attorney General's Office (AGO) and are not subject to additional state action by the PDC for both Pre and Post passage of 2938.
  4. Staff's review of the remaining C-3 and C-4 reports, and the response from PCDCC, found that eight of the alleged late filed C-3 and C-4 reports were submitted as amendments to correct previously disclosed information that had been discovered during an internal audit conducted by PCDCC.
  5. Some of the amended filings only reflected changes in the aggregate totals due to corrections and amendments made to previous reports.
  6. Ten of the alleged late filed C-3 and C-4 reports involved technical issues requiring assistance from PDC Staff in order to complete the filing, and the late filed reports disclosed mostly small contributors and proceeds from low-cost fundraisers and committee expenditures for rent.
- In his response, Treasurer Dominick Bergeron, stated that errors occurring after the date of the settlement referenced above, were "minor technical errors, which were communicated to the PDC at the time, insignificant in amount or impact on any campaign outcome, or just minor human error." In addition, he described the high turnover rate with committee treasurers which he stated is partially due to "the anxiety associated with the zero-tolerance provision of the settlement."
  - Staff's review found three of the alleged filed C-3 and C-4 reports were filed without having any relevant mitigating factors or circumstances and included one C-4 reports that disclosed \$193.65 in expenditures for insurance and internet and two C-3 reports that disclosed \$666.97 in proceeds from a low-cost fundraising event and two individual donations totaling \$140. The C-3 and C-4 reports were filed between five and twelve days late.

### **Summary of PDC Case 44695**

- The complaint included a December 9, 2018 announcement posted by the newly elected Chair, Kathy Orlando, on the Pierce County Democrats Facebook page entitled "your new PCDCC officers" as evidence of the allegation regarding failure to file an amendment to the C-1pc within ten days as required by law.
- On January 7, 2019, the Committee filed an amended C-1pc report disclosing the newly elected Committee officers for 2019 including the Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. The amended C-1pc report was filed 15 days late.

Based on staff's review, the alleged late and incomplete filed C-3 and C-4 reports cited in the two complaints were primarily caused by a Committee reorganization and changes in officers, but we noted that the Committee implemented additional internal controls to ensure compliance by creating an oversight committee, by conducting an internal audit, and additional training.

These steps were taken, in part, by the Pierce County Democratic Central Committee to comply with the provisions of the settlement agreement.

Based on these findings staff has determined that, in this instance, failure to timely and accurately file 19 filed C-3 and C-4 reports, including amendments, mostly disclosed little monetary activity, or were filed as a result of an internal audit process conducted by PCDCC, and therefore does not warrant further investigation or enforcement action.

Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(b), the PCDCC will receive a formal written warning concerning failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities and failure to timely file an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) disclosing material changes. The formal written warning will include staff's expectation that PCDCC timely file accurate and complete C-3, C-4 and C-1pc reports in future years in accordance with PDC laws and rules. The Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).

To Whom it May Concern –

It has come to my attention that the Pierce County Democratic Central Committee has violated multiple provisions of **RCW 42.17A**.

**1) Failure to timely file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)**

State law requires that candidates and committees file frequent, accurate, and timely reports of contributions, expenditures, in-kind contributions, and debt. Unfortunately, the Pierce County Democratic Central Committee failed on numerous occasions to do this. Additionally, they may have failed to timely deposit contributions within 5 business days. Please see **Exhibit A “Illegal Late Reported/Deposited Contributions by Pierce County Democrats”** and **Exhibit B “Illegally Late Reported Expenditures by Pierce County Democrats”**

Additionally, the Pierce County Democratic Party has **failed to submit a single contribution (C3) or expenditure (C4) report in 2017**, despite having received many contributions and making many expenditures during the relevant time period. This needs to be corrected immediately.

There are numerous irregularities on the Pierce County Democratic Central Committee's filings, including contributions from themselves and illegal donations from other candidate authorized committees. The irregularities and illegal contributions must be rectified immediately.

**2) Failure to report occupation and employer information for donors over \$100. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, WAC 390-16-037)**

Washington's campaign finance law requires a campaign to timely report contributions received. The information required to be disclosed includes the name and address of the source of contributions that exceed \$25 in the aggregate, and the employer and occupation of any individual contributor giving more than \$100 in the aggregate. Unfortunately, the Pierce County Democratic Party failed to include this information for the following contributions:

LEIGHTON JUSTIN 6/8/2016 \$250.00 N TACOMA WA 98405

**3) Failure to accurately, timely report debt. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240 (8), see WAC 390-05-295)**

State law requires that the name and address of any person and the amount owed for any debt, obligation, note, unpaid loan, or other liability in the amount of more than two hundred fifty dollars or in the amount of more than fifty dollars that has been outstanding for over thirty days. Per **WAC 390-05-295**, this includes any oral or written order placed, debt or obligation to purchase goods or services or anything of value, or any offer to purchase advertising space, broadcast time or other advertising related product or service.

The Pierce County Democratic Central Committee failed to illegally report the following debts on preceding C4s: (See **Exhibit C “Illegal Failure to Report Debt by Pierce County Democrats”**)

**4) Failure to properly break down expenses. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, see WAC 390-16-205)**

State law requires that expenditures made on behalf of a candidate or political committee by any person, agency, firm, organization, etc. employed or retained for the purpose of organizing, directing, managing or assisting the candidate's or committee's efforts shall be deemed expenditures by the candidate or committee. In accordance with WAC 390-16-037, such expenditures shall be reported by the candidate or committee as if made or incurred by the candidate or committee directly.

The Pierce County Democratic Party illegally failed to break down the following expenses: (See **Exhibit D "Illegal Failure to break down expenditures by Pierce County Democrats"**)

**5) Failure to list committee officers. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205 (2)(c), see WAC 390-05-245.**

The Pierce County Democratic Party failed to list following individuals as officers, as required by **RCW 42.17A.205(2)(c)**:

**Treasurer: Yolanda Rucker**  
**State Committeeman: Eric Herde**  
**State Committeewoman: Anita Latch**  
**Membership/Asst. Treasurer: Jordan Waits**  
**Sergeant at Arms: Julian Wheeler**

Only the following individuals were accurately listed on the 2017 C1PC. :

**Chair: Gina Bua**  
**Vice Chair: Tim Farrell**  
**Secretary: Patti Dailey**

Alarminglly, the true treasurer was not even listed on the committee's C1PC form.

**WAC 390-05-245** defines committee officer as: "...any person designated by the committee as an officer on the C-1 or C-1pc registration statement and any **person** who alone or in conjunction with other persons makes, directs, or authorizes contribution, expenditure, strategic or policy decisions on behalf of the committee" .

Please note that **RCW 42.17A.005 (35)** defines "person" as: "...an individual, partnership, joint venture, public or private corporation, association, federal, state, or local governmental entity or agency however constituted, candidate, committee, political committee, political party, executive committee thereof, or any other organization or group of persons, however organized."

**6) Illegal unauthorized expenditure of funds by an individual not listed as an officer on C-1 form. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.425)**

State law requires that: "No expenditures may be made or incurred by any candidate or political committee unless authorized by the candidate or the person or persons named on the candidate's or committee's registration form..."

I have reason to believe the following individuals have made illegal expenditures for the committee, in violation of state law:

**Treasurer: Yolanda Rucker**  
**State Committeeman: Eric Herde**  
**State Committeewoman: Anita Latch**  
**Membership/Asst. Treasurer: Jordan Waits**  
**Sergeant at Arms: Julian Wheeler**

The PDC should investigate the possibility that the Pierce County Democratic Party committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per **RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c)**. If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately.

3 STIPULATION

4 The parties to this stipulation, Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON (STATE), and the  
5 Defendant, PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE, a Washington  
6 registered political committee, desiring to resolve all claims arising out of the State's  
7 complaint, hereby enter into the following stipulation:

8 1. Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE agrees to pay  
9 the State within 30 days of the date of entry of this Judgment an assessed civil penalty in  
10 the amount of \$31,780 with one-half suspended for four years, for its violations of RCW  
11 42.17A for failing to timely disclose contribution and expenditure reports for election years  
12 2015, 2016, and through the date of this agreement for 2017.

13 2. The parties agree that \$15,890 of the assessed civil penalty will be suspended based on the  
14 following terms and conditions:

15 a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the  
16 Judgment. During the period of suspension, Defendant PIERCE COUNTY  
17 DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE agrees that it will not violate any  
18 provision of RCW 42.17A.

19 b. In the event Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL

21 committed a violation of RCW 42.17A during the suspension period, the suspended





**JUDGMENT**

THIS MATTER came on regularly before the undersigned judge of the above-entitled Court. Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON (STATE), appearing through its attorneys of record, ROBERT W. FERGUSON, Attorney General and LINDA A. DALTON, Senior Assistant Attorney General, and Defendant, PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE appearing through its attorney, EVELYN FIELDING LOPEZ, apprised the Court of their agreement to the entry of this judgment for the purpose of settling and compromising this action brought under RCW 42.17A. The Court, having reviewed the records and files herein, and having found the settlement to be a just and proper resolution of this matter, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE is hereby assessed a civil penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A, in the amount of \$31,780 payable to the State of Washington.
2. The amount of \$15,890 of the assessed penalty is hereby suspended upon Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE's compliance with the following court-ordered conditions:
  - a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the Judgment. During the period of suspension, Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE agrees that it will not violate any provision of RCW 42.17A.
  - b. In the event Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE is found by the Public Disclosure Commission or a court to have committed a violation of RCW 42.17A during the suspension period, the suspended penalty of \$15,890 will immediately become due and payable within 30 days of such finding without further intervention of the Court.

1 c. If Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE is not  
2 found to have committed violations of RCW 42.17A by the Public Disclosure  
3 Commission or a court for conduct during the suspension period, then the suspended  
4 portion of the penalty will be set aside.

5 3. Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE shall pay to the  
6 State of Washington the amount of \$5,000.00 as attorney fees, \$240 in court costs, and  
7 \$1,500 in costs of investigation as authorized under RCW 42.17A.765.


8 4. Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE shall pay the  
9 State the unsuspended portion of the civil penalty (\$15,890) and fees and costs (\$6,740) in  
10 installments of \$3,000 each on January 1 and July 1 each year starting on January 1, 2018  
11 until paid in full. Failure to timely make any installment shall result in the remainder of the  
12 unpaid portion to be due within 30 days of the missed installment.



I. NATURE OF ACTION

Plaintiff State of Washington (State) brings this action to enforce the State's campaign finance disclosure law, RCW 42.17A. The State alleges that Defendant, PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE (the Committee), a Washington registered political committee, violated provisions of RCW 42.17A by: 1) failing to timely report contributions it received, and 2) failing to timely report expenditures it made including debts and obligations with the State Public Disclosure Commission. The State seeks relief under RCW 42.17A.750 and .765, including penalties, costs and fees, and injunctive relief.

## II. PARTIES

2.1 Plaintiff is the State of Washington. Acting through the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission, Attorney General, or a local prosecuting attorney, the State enforces the state campaign finance and disclosure laws contained in RCW 42.17A.

2.2 Defendant PIERCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE is registered with the state Public Disclosure Commission as a continuing bona fide political party committee. As the term is used under RCW 42.17A.005(6)(c), it is the county central committee for the Washington State Democratic Central Committee in Pierce County, Washington.

## III. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

3.1 This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over the present case in accordance with RCW 42.17A. The Attorney General has authority to bring this action pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.

3.2 This Court has personal jurisdiction over Defendant, a registered Washington State political committee. Additionally, the acts alleged below occurred in whole or in part in Thurston County, Washington.

3.3 Venue is proper in this Court pursuant to RCW 4.12.020(1).

## IV. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

4.1 RCW 42.17A declares as a matter of public policy "[t]hat political campaign and lobbying contributions and expenditures be fully disclosed to the public and that secrecy is to be avoided." RCW 42.17A.001(1). Further, the statute provides that the provisions of the law "shall be liberally construed to promote complete disclosure of all information respecting the financing of political campaigns. . . ."

4.2 Washington's campaign finance law requires a campaign to timely report contributions received. The information required to be disclosed includes the name and address

1 of the source of contributions that exceed \$25 in the aggregate, and the employer and  
2 occupation of any individual contributor giving more than \$100 in the aggregate.  
3 RCW 42.17A.240; WAC 390-16-037. Contribution disclosures are reported on a Public  
4 Disclosure Commission (PDC) form "C3" which is called the "Cash Receipt Monetary  
5 Contributions" form. Each week's contributions must be reported on the following Monday  
6 during the five months prior to a general election. RCW 42.17A.235(3).

7 4.3 Washington's campaign finance law also requires political committees to timely  
8 report expenditures related to state campaigns, including any debts incurred by the political  
9 committee. RCW 42.17A.235, .240(8); RCW 42.17A.005(20). The PDC form to report  
10 expenditures is called a "Summary, Full Report Receipts and Expenditures" and is a form  
11 "C4." An expenditure is defined to include "a *promise to pay*, . . . . For the purposes of this  
12 chapter, agreements to make expenditures, contracts, debts, and promises to pay may be  
13 reported as estimated obligations until actual payment is made." RCW 42.17A.005(20).

14 4.4 The Committee is a bona fide political party committee as the term is used in  
15 RCW 42.17A, and is more specifically, a county central committee of the Washington State  
16 Democratic Central Committee. As such, the Committee routinely raises funds in order to  
17 support various democratic candidates and ballot propositions. Since 2015, the Committee  
18 received contributions and made expenditures, all of which were required to be reported in  
19 accordance with RCW 42.17A.

20 4.5 The activities of the Public Disclosure Commission, including its receipt and  
21 compilation of reports required by law, are conducted in and about Thurston County.

22 4.6 On May 18, 2017, the Attorney General's Office received a citizen action notice  
23 alleging that the Committee had failed to timely file reports of contributions received and  
24 expenditures made, including debts and obligations, for the years 2015, 2016, and 2017.

25 4.7 In May 2017, the Committee elected a new treasurer.  
26

1     Failure to Timely Report Contributions Received

2     4.8     The Committee failed to timely disclose contributions it received as required by  
3 law on a C3 report. Specifically, the Committee failed to timely file and disclose \$51,817 in  
4 contributions received during 2015 and 2016 on 30 separate C3 reports. These reports ranged  
5 from eight to 179 days late, representing a collective total of 2,402 days late.

6     4.9     In 2015, \$33,217 of the late-reported contributions was disclosed from 76-172  
7 days and not until after the general election.

8     4.10    For the year 2017, the Committee failed to file any C3 reports until after the  
9 citizen action notice received by the Attorney General's Office and complaint to the Public  
10 Disclosure Commission was provided to it.

11    4.11    The following chart summarizes the total deposits received by the Committee,  
12 the number of reports affected by the late reporting, and the cumulative days late for 2015,  
13 2016, and 2017:

18     Failure to Timely Report Expenditures

19    4.12    In 2015, 2016, and 2017, the Committee failed to timely disclose expenditures  
20 made as required by law on a C4 report. Specifically, the Committee failed to timely file and  
21 disclose \$84,230 in expenditures made during 2015 and 2016 on 11 separate C4 reports. These  
22 reports ranged from 1 to 171 days late, representing a collective total of 611 days late.

23    4.13    For the year 2017, the Committee failed to file any C4 reports until after the  
24 citizen action notice received by the Attorney General's Office and complaint to the Public  
25 Disclosure Commission was provided to it.



4.14 The following chart identifies for each untimely report the amount of expenditures, and the number of days late for C4 reports due during 2015, 2016, and 2017:

Failure to timely report debts and obligations

4.15 On information and belief for the year 2016, the Committee failed to timely report debts and obligations it incurred during one reporting period but did not report until an invoice was paid. The unreported debts included expenses incurred for party convention and caucus events during 2016. The Committee did not dispute this allegation during the investigation period; rather, the Committee chose to place responsibility for this failure on its former chair and treasurer.

**V. CLAIMS**

The State re-alleges and incorporates by reference all the factual allegations contained in the preceding paragraphs, and based on those allegations, makes the following claims:

5.1 First Claim: The State reasserts the factual allegations made above and further asserts that Defendant, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240, failed to timely disclose to the state Public Disclosure Commission contributions it received during 2015, 2016, and 2017.

5.2 Second Claim: Plaintiff reasserts the factual allegations made above and further asserts that Defendant, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240, failed to timely and completely disclose and describe expenditures it made, including debts and obligations, during 2015, 2016, and 2017 to the state Public Disclosure Commission.

**VI. REQUEST FOR RELIEF**

WHEREFORE, the State requests the following relief as provided by law:

6.1 For such remedies as the court may deem appropriate under RCW 42.17A.750, including but not limited to imposition of a civil penalty, all to be determined at trial;


6.2 For all costs of investigation and trial, including reasonable attorneys' fees, as authorized by RCW 42.17A.765(5);

6.3 For temporary and permanent injunctive relief, as authorized by RCW 42.17A.750(1)(h); and

6.4 For such other legal and equitable relief as this Court deems appropriate.
