Complaint Description
<p>Glen Morgan reported via the portal (Mon, 21 Aug 2023 at 9:58 AM)</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It recently came to my attention that the Kennewick Citizens Levy and Bond Committee PAC has committed violations of Washington State’s campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The details of these violations are as follow:</p> <p>1) Attempt to conceal the truth from the public for weeks and months – often after an election by filing a massive quantity of reports late – concealing thousands of dollars in election influence peddling from the public (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>I recently reviewed the WEA-PACs filings and was shocked at how egregious their violations have become. This made me realize I haven’t paid much attention to some of their locally supported Levy & Bond PACs around the state. As I looked around, unfortunately, it looks like many of them are also not following the law very well.</p> <p>I try to provide the specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers like this to use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I’ve attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.</p> <p>A quick note again on how this report is organized. I’ve organized it by latest report first. You’ll note that the latest report filed by this group was 384 days late – over a year, and a possible record for this PAC during the last few years, but hardly unique in itself.</p> <p><u>I’ve color coded the most extreme late reports red, of which there are 64. This isn’t a “mistake” or a “technical problem.” This is pattern of behavior and a serious violation of Washington State’s laws.</u> I’ve color coded the problematically late orange, and there are only 7 of those 14-5 days late. Illegal, but not as egregious as most of their reports. I’ve color coded the sloppily late reports yellow, and there are only 7 of those. So, it appears that when they want to break the law, they just go for months or wait over a year and conceal everything from the public in most cases. The attached spreadsheet and PDF file of this information should be adequate to verify this allegation and the egregious pattern of behavior for the extensive lawbreaking committed by this crew.</p>

Once I confirmed this PAC was willing to violate the most fundamental organizing principle of Washington State's campaign finance laws – inform the public about the truth about how they spend and raise money in a timely manner, I looked deeper to see what other laws they are violating, and of course, I found more...

2) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Once I realized this PAC would so egregiously violate the law with such carelessness, I looked closer at their reports (as late as they were finally submitted). It turns out this PAC has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently. Here are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B:

- On PDC Report # 110089996, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims to have spent \$2,854.01 on signs with vendor "Fast Signs" and they might have been fast, but of course, this PAC still failed to report how many signs, which is an explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.
- On PDC Report # 110090000, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims to have spent \$6,873.36 on "postcards." No details of how many postcards were mailed was provided, which, again, is an explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.
- On PDC Report #110093528, attached for staff reference, this Pac claims to have spent \$323.93 on more levy signs, but once again, of course, they failed to report how many signs, which is an explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.
- On at least 4 different occasions (See PDC Report # 110067243, #110067224, #110067244, #100962936, all attached for staff reference), this PAC weirdly made identical purchases for \$529.75 each (total of \$2,119) for nebulous and completely undefined "Gift Cards" without explaining where these cards were purchased, for what purpose, and why the same guy "Kevin Veleke" was paid for all of them. This is also a violation of the statute in the lack of details and possibly even concealment of the true source of these "gift cards."
- On PDC Report # 110152664, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims to have spent \$3,528.40 for "printing postcards", but again, they failed to report how many postcards were printed, which is an explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.
- On PDC Report # 10152696, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims to have spent \$1,378.44 and ALSO \$489.76 for "robocalls", but again, they failed to report how many robocalls were made, which is an explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example A. I will note for the record, they used a shady outfit out of Seattle that certainly knows the law and has this information, but is often involved in secretive, law-breaking crews like this one.

- On **PDC Report #100872411, attached for staff reference**, this PAC claims to **have spent \$4,208.25 for “yard signs”**, but again, they failed to report how many yard signs were printed, which is an **explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.**
- On **PDC Report #100883666, attached for staff reference**, this PAC claims to **have spent \$4,015.52 for “door hangers”**, but again, they failed to report how many door hangers were printed, which is an **explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.** Just for reference, on this same filing, the Treasurer clearly proved they knew the law and had the capacity to follow it by reporting correctly and legally the number of post cards they printed, which is further evidence that they can’t claim they “didn’t know.” They clearly did, but they just chose to break the law anyway.
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This was not a comprehensive list of these types of violations, which are found throughout this PACs filings (assuming any of them are remotely accurate since most seem to be concealed from the public for so long – some probably never get reported). However, this should serve as a good baseline for someone to use and go back and correct all the illegal reports made in the past. This PAC appears to be not compliant with the statute at all.

In addition, it came as a pleasant surprise to me that the PDC itself filed a separate complaint against this group and is currently investigating them under **PDC Enforcement Case #139467**. I have outlined many additional violations in this complaint than what has been apparently addressed in that initial investigation, and perhaps this complaint can assist PDC staff in their efforts to find compliance in Kennewick with this secretive, well-funded PAC.
