Dear Kennewick Citizens Levy & Bond Committee:

After conducting a preliminary review and assessment of a complaint filed by Glen Morgan on August 21, 2023 concerning Kennewick Citizens Levy & Bond Committee, PDC staff opened a formal investigation and held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review) on November 16, 2023, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071.

At the hearing. it was noted that the Case Status Review is not an adjudicative proceeding, and that RCW 42.17A.755 provides PDC staff with additional tools to resolve complaints alleging non-compliance through the use of alternatives to full, formal adjudication or referral to the Attorney General's Office; these tools include resolving alleged violations by agreement through stipulation or statement of understanding, or an agreement to stay enforcement pending satisfaction of conditions of deferred enforcement. I am therefore encouraging you to work with staff on resolving this matter.
