Complaint Description
<p><u>Glen Morgan</u> reported via the portal <i>Thu, 24 Aug 2023 at 10:15 AM</i> To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention, that the Lake Washington Citizen's Levy Committee PAC has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The specific violations are detailed below:</p> <p>1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, months, or even years to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>I try to provide specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I've attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.</p> <p>A quick note again on how this report is organized. I've organized it by latest report first. You'll note that the latest report filed by this group was 515 days late, which is significant for a well-funded PAC like this one</p> <p>I've color coded the most extreme late reports red, as I usually do, of which there are 25 of these. That may not seem like a lot – but seriously, look at how late and how much financial influence on local elections has been concealed from the public for months and over a year. It is some impressive lawbreaking here. This alone was enough to justify filing a complaint against this group. As staff can verify from the attached spreadsheet, these are significant violations, and they consist of most of the violations documented under this specific allegation. I have also indicated that there are 4 disturbingly late reports (color coded orange), but those are not the majority of the violations of this large complaint.</p> <p>Due to the large size and number and lateness of these reports, it seems highly likely that the current reports sitting on the PDC website are probably concealing the truth from the public as well, but I suspect that PDC staff could save themselves some time by simple subpoenas of bank accounts and see how far off these reports are from the actual bank accounts.</p>

2) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Once I realized this PAC would so egregiously violate the law with such reckless disregard for the public to know the truth, I kept looking closer. It turns out this PAC has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course). Here **are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037:**

- On **PDC Report #110124675, attached for staff reference**, this PAC claims to have **spent \$12,400 on texts** with vendor A4 Media on "digital advertising", but of course, they failed to report the legally required details for these. How many digital advertisements were made? Over what timeframe? How many types? Also, this PAC on the same report, \$158.57 on "robocalls" but again, they don't provide the legally required details – how many? Over what timeframe? In both these examples, the vendors used provide very detailed reports providing all these details. They are not secret, unless this PAC conceals it from the public as they have in this case. These are both **explicit violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example A.**
- On **PDC Report # 100925237 , attached for staff reference**, this PAC **claims to have spent \$1,348.56 on texting on robocall.** Once again, no details provided. These companies all provide the number of calls they make, etc. This is information this PAC must report to the public, and they chose to conceal it instead. Again, another **clear and obvious violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example A.**
- On **PDC Report #100925236, attached for staff reference**, this secretive lawbreaking PAC claims to have **spent \$7,661.71 on "mailer"**, but once again, of course, they failed to report when, how many ,etc , which is an **explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.**
- On **PDC Report #100925233, attached for staff reference**, this PAC **claims to have spent \$8,873.59 on "levy signs, flyers, buttons,"** yet, in a disturbing pattern, once again, they have failed to report how many signs, fliers or anything else. Frankly, it makes more sense for this MEGA PAC to file separate line items of each of these large purchases for maximum transparency, but **instead they decided to just go full dark and hide all details, which is an explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.**
- On **PDC Report # 100925234, attached for staff reference**, this PAC **claims to have spent \$14,500 on "mailer, digital ad"** and once again, of course, they failed to report either the numbers of mailers or the date, quantity, and platform for the digital ads, all of which are **explicit violations of WAC 390-16-037, both Example A and B violations.**
- On **PDC Report # 100928460, attached for staff reference**, this PAC **claims to have spent \$25,524.38 on "Robocalls and Digital Ads."** Again, these are completely dark and lacking legal details of any kind. Again, **as has been customary at this PAC, these are explicit violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example A.**

It seems likely, in light of this PACs tendency to conceal so much for so many years from the public with their late reports, that these additional examples of lawbreaking are probably very limited and there are likely to be even more violations if PDC staff look closer.

Once again, I do strongly suggest that the PDC gets a subpoena for the bank records on this PAC and see how far off the bank account records are from the public reports filed by this entity. It seems like you could save a lot of time and hassle taking this approach.

Regardless, it is a shame a well-funded PAC like this can't follow the law.
