I am a member of the Washington State Business and Professional Women. I am responding to the complaint of Glen Morgan. Initially, I would like to note that Washington State Business and Professional Women is a small organization comprised of volunteers.

In response to Mr. Morgan's complaint we respond as follows:

1. Late Filing. We are not addressing the issue of late filing at this time.
2. Identities of Donors. On some of our reports, some donors' contributions were lumped together, but each donor contributed no more than \$100. We will specifically list all donors in our amended reports.
3. Expenditures Reports. Through oversight and due to a change in the administration of the PAC, reports were not filed for several years. All missing reports will be filed later. All expenditures have been less than \$200 per year.
4. Use of Campaign Funds. The WSBPW PAC has not been very active. The bank records as of July 21, 2023 show a balance of \$6,599.86. Not all funds donated have been contributed to a candidate, which is why the balance has increased over the years.
