

File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that Nathan Choi, a failed candidate for the Court of Appeals, Division 1, District 1, Position 2, committed frequent and multiple violations of **RCW 42.17A** throughout his failed 2016 campaign..

1) Failure to file C1 within 2 weeks of becoming a candidate. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205)

Nathan Choi filed public office in May of 2017, starting the 2 week period for him to timely file his C1 statement of registration.

Unfortunately, he failed to file his C1 until October 16th, 2017. This is well past the statutory deadline.

2) Failure to file frequent, accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235).

When Choi did file his C1, he selected the full-reporting option on his C1. This option obligated him to file frequent, detailed, and timely C3 and C4 reports.

Despite his earlier non-filing of a C1, Choi was still obligated to file C3 and C4 reports, but failed to do so.

Ultimately, Choi failed to file reports of expenditures and contributions for the entirety of the 2017 election cycle.

This is a serious violation and a complete mockery of state law. This is particularly egregious as this violation of the law was committed by someone claiming to be qualified to hold the position of judge on the Washington State Court of Appeals.

It is worth noting the total lack of documentation throughout this campaign drew the scrutiny of the Seattle Times and local bar association:

The PDC should investigate the possibility that Nathan Choi committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per **RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c)**. If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately.
