<b>Complaint Description</b>
<p><u><a href="#">Glen Morgan</a></u> reported via the portal  (Mon, 28 Aug 2023 at 1:47 PM)</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that the Citizens Committee for Education – Puyallup PAC has been violating Washington State’s campaign finance laws for many years now. The details are as follows:</p> <p><b>1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, or even months to report what they did with their cash pile used to influence elections (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</b></p> <p>Even a casual review of this massive, well-funded PAC’s PDC filings reveals something seriously wrong here. It is particularly concerning since many of these reports were actually filed weeks and even months late finally revealing the reported *truth* about this PAC that was concealed from the public during various campaigns and election cycles.</p> <p>As has been my habit, I try to provide the specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers like this group use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I’ve attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone to verify the accuracy of the complaint and audit the nature of the information concealed from the public.</p> <p>A quick note again on how this report is organized. I’ve <b>organized it by latest report first</b>. You’ll note that the latest report filed by this group was 123 days late which is several months late, and almost all the late reports were unfortunately made AFTER the election was long over and therefore concealed all the information from the public during the critical 21 days before an election.</p> <p><b>I’ve color coded the most extreme late reports red, as usual, of which there are 34 with this crew.</b> Please note the majority of these involve large and massive transactions. I’ve color coded the problematically late orange, and there are only 16 of those 14-6 days late. Illegal for sure, but obviously the majority of the reports this PAC filed were extremely late. I will point out that just the problematically late reports would be enough to justify drawing attention of the PDC to this crew of lawbreakers. I also color code the sloppily late reports yellow, and there were just 13 of those – by itself I wouldn’t file a complaint on just sloppy filing. The problem here, of course, are the seriously late reports. This is a very serious and concerning pattern of behavior.</p> <p>Unfortunately, as I have discovered in the past, if a PAC like this is willing to violate the most fundamental principle of campaign finance law – revealing the truth about their attempts to influence the outcome of an election in a timely way – then they are likely to violate other aspects of the law. This PAC was no exception to this pattern.</p> <p><b>2) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 &amp; WAC 390-16-037)</b></p>

Once I realized this PAC would so egregiously violate the law with such carelessness, I started to look closer. It turns out this well-funded PAC has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course). Here **are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, both Example A and Example B:**

- On **PDC Report #110126021, attached for staff reference** – This PAC claims to have used vendor "Print NW" and reportedly **spent \$10,428.73 – on "Campaign Mailer"** but no clarification or specifics (How many mailers?) This is clearly legally required and specified in **WAC 390-16-037, example B**. In addition this PAC also claims to have **spent \$1,650.00 on Robocalls**, but again, they refused to identify how many calls were made, over what timeframe, etc (despite the fact this vendor provides this information to the PAC) – a classic violation of **WAC 390-16-037, example A**. On the same report, this PAC claims they **spent \$1,629.93** on "Vote Yes Door Tags" – again with zero legally required details like how many of these were printed? Again, another perfect example of violating **WAC 390-16-037, example B**. Another expenditure for \$1,650 for "mailers and door hangers" and again, no legally required details provided.
- On **PDC Report #110083363, attached for staff reference** – This PAC claims to have used vendor "Print NW" again and **reportedly spent \$7,564.81** for a mailer. Again zero details provided about how many were printed, despite the clear legal requirements for this as so clearly explained in **WAC 390-16-037, example B**.
- On **PDC Report # 101011702, attached for staff reference** – This PAC also claims to have used Vendor "Print NW" again, and **reportedly spent \$8,978.17** for another mailer. Again, no legally required details provided, and a perfect example of a violation of **WAC 390-16-037, Example B**.
- On **PDC Report #100948896, attached for staff reference** – This PAC claims to have **spent \$13,566.57** with vendor "Print Solutions" for "mailers" (easy to see why they switched to vendor Print NW later). Again, no details regarding how many mailers were printed as specifically required by law – **violating WAC 390-16-037, Example B**.

I'm sure there are more violations with this group that I have missed, but on first glance, these are the obvious ones I can see. Hopefully, the PDC can impose adequate sanctions and fines on this organization to encourage them to start following the law in the future. In addition, they obviously need to correct and refile the old reports with inadequate information to be able to comply with the law.

I realize that for some groups and organizations, breaking the law is just a way of life. Perhaps for some it is an addiction, like a drug addict, and I know that providing incentives for them to follow the law and break their addiction is challenging, but we have to start somewhere and we might as well start now.
