#### **Complaint Description**

<u>Glen Morgan</u> reported via the portal

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention, that the Citizens for Schools – Walla Walla PAC has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**). The specific violations are detailed below:

1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, or months to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)

I had recently been looking into PACs that were not following Washington State law when it comes to timely filing – particularly those who appear to have engaged in a pattern of behavior concealing the truth from the public during the campaign when they are attempting to influence the public.

I try to provide specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I've attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the farright column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.

A quick note again on how this report is organized. I've **organized it by latest report first.** You'll note that the latest report filed by this group was 211 days late, which isn't the worst I've seen over the last 50 complaints or so I've filed over the past month, but it is far from compliant with Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**).

I've color coded the most extreme late reports red, as I usually do, of which there are 7 of these. That may not seem like a lot – but seriously, look at how late and how much financial influence on local elections has been concealed from the public for years. I've also included the other 10 reports which were either troublingly late (color coded orange) or sloppily late (color coded yellow). I'm not sure I would have filed this complaint with just the sloppily late reports, but the rest of them add up to enough concealment of the truth that it was worth notifying the PDC. This was clearly enough to justify filing a complaint against this group.

2) Possible theft of campaign funds, misuse of campaign funds, disappearing campaign funds for likely personal use. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.445)

Somehow this campaign, without explanation or clarity "disappeared" \$92 between the C4 (expense reports) filed for the end of 2018 and the next C4 filed. The last C4 report in 2019 claims that the campaign had \$2,844.05 in the account after expenses (See PDC C4 Report # 100881698, attached for staff reference). However, when the next C4 expense report was filed picking up from when this last one supposedly left off – this secretive PAC claims that there were \$2752.05 dollars in the bank (See PDC C4 Report # 100944146, also attached for staff reference). Where did the missing \$92 go? Did someone spend it on pot? Was it lost? Was it stolen? Did someone spend it fruitlessly on lottery tickets? Nobody knows because it has never been clarified or reported.

3) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Once I realized this PAC would so egregiously violate the law with such reckless disregard for the public to know the truth, I kept looking closer. It turns out this PAC has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course). Here **are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037:** 

- On PDC Report #100947925, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims to have spent \$5,380.15 on signs and other misc. things with vendor "Integrity Design and Copyworks", but of course, they failed to report the quantity of signs. This is an explicit violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.
- On PDC Report # 100957859, attached for staff reference, this PAC claims to have spent \$1,502.00 on radio ads. Once again, no details provided. How many? What station? Over what timeframe? This is information this PAC must report to the public, and they chose to conceal it instead. Again, another clear and obvious violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example A. (Weirdly, they did report the number of signs on THIS report, so clearly someone in this PAC knows the law, they just chose not to follow it most of the time).
- On PDC Report # 100996586, attached for staff reference, this PAC again claims to have spent \$1,490.00 on radio ads. Once again, no details provided. How many? What station? Over what timeframe? This is information this PAC must report to the public, and they chose to conceal it instead. Again, another clear and obvious violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example A.
- On PDC Report # 100873268, attached for staff reference, this PAC basically just riddled the report with classic examples of violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example A & Example B by reporting radio ads with no details, printed brochures, mailers, door hangers, and signs with no legally required details. This whole report needs to be corrected.

I'm sure there are more violations than just this, but I suspect the people who have to go back and fix these reports will read the law and figure it out so they stop their lawbreaking ways (assuming they can start filing reports on time and not lose anymore funds).

#### What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

Large, well-funded PACs like this one which push to influence local election results on tax increases for local property owners must follow the law like everyone else. They should not be allowed to conceal the truth from voters during the campaign. They must provide accurate information to the public about how they spend their ad money, and they probably shouldn't misplace, lose or let money disappear from their campaign funds.
