| <p>Glen Morgan reported via the portal (Wed, 30 Aug 2023 at 11:55 PM)</p> <p>To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention, that the Mead Citizens Advisory Committee PAC has violated Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A) quite egregiously. The specific violations are detailed below:</p> <p>1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, months or even years to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>I had recently been looking into PACs that were not following Washington State law when it comes to timely filing – particularly those who appear to have engaged in a pattern of behavior concealing the truth from the public during the campaign when they are attempting to influence the public.</p> <p>I try to provide specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I've attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.</p> <p>A quick note again on how this report is organized. I've organized it by latest report first. You'll note that the latest report filed by this group was 584 days late (this group had two reports filed this late), which isn't the worst I've seen over the last 50 complaints or so I've filed over the past month, but it is one of the worst school levy committees I've found in the last month, and this is not even close to being compliant with Washington State's campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A).</p> <p>I've color coded the most extreme late reports red, as I usually do, of which there are 64 of these. That is a lot – plus, look at how late and how much financial influence on local elections has been concealed from the public for years. This is an exceptionally large volume of late filings containing (and concealing for a long time from the public) a lot of large dollar expenditures and contributions. I've also included the other 6 reports which were troublingly late (color coded orange). I'm not sure I would have filed this complaint with just the sloppily late reports, but the cumulative total of all these late reports of them add up to way more than enough concealment of the truth that it is worth notifying the PDC. This was clearly enough to justify filing a complaint against this group, but unfortunately, it is not the</p> <p>2) Mystery campaign funds appearing randomly with no clear explanation on various C4 expenditure reports. Clearly missing many C4 reports (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, .235)</p> <p>On many occasions, this well-funded PAC had massive "surprise" influxes of cash, with radical differences between C4s from one year to the next. As PDC staff is well aware, any campaign must file C4 reports month to month if there are any significant changes in the financial status of the campaign (expenditures OR contributions). However, this PAC clearly paid no attention to the law, which produces some of these eye-</p> |

popping appearances of large sums of cash used to influence elections and raise taxes. Here are some of the more shocking examples:

Somehow this campaign, without explanation or clarity “discovered” \$17,516.39 between the C4 (expense reports) filed for the end of 2018 and the next C4 filed for the start of the 2019 campaign . The last C4 report from 2018 **claims that the campaign had \$35,953.69 in the account** after expenses (See **PDC C4 Report # 100964688 , attached for staff reference**). Please note this was **filed two years late**. Also, when the next C4 expense report was filed – **only two months late this time**, theoretically picking up from when this last one supposedly left off – **this secretive PAC claims that there were \$53,470.08 dollars in the bank** (See **PDC C4 Report # 100958527 , also attached for staff reference**). **Where did the missing \$17,516.39 come from? Who kicked in the cash? When did the cash appear? Is it even real?** There is a reason why the PDC enforces the timeliness of reports because when they don't exist, strange outcomes like this happen. Mystery cash falling from heaven just appears in the bank account. There is nothing transparent or open about that.

There is a pattern here. Worse than the above mismatched, extremely late reports, if you look at the last C4 filed for the 2019 campaign – a few months late as usual (See **PDC Report #100958527, attached for staff reference**), this math challenged PAC claims that they had \$9,876.89 in the bank (line 18), however at the very first C4 filed for the 2021 campaign with \$55,093.87 in the bank (See **PDC Report # 110010105, attached for staff reference**). **Where did the bonus, mystery \$45,216.98 come from? Who kicked in the cash? Why were none of the reports filed when these secret deposits were made? Clearly a lot of information is still missing from this PAC**, and nobody trying to look at the already egregiously late reported information can even begin to figure it out. **Between these three campaigns (2018/2019/2021) there appears to be at least \$62,793.37 completely unexplained, unjustified, and it has mysterious origins.** This is just a rat's nest to untangle for some unlucky future treasurer, or for PDC staff to sort out with bank subpoenas (if you are lucky). That may be the only way to sort out this mess.

I'm sure this is just scratching the surface here. It is likely to get much, much worse as we look closer.

3) Failure to accurately describe expense, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Very predictably, as always, once I realized this PAC would so egregiously violate the law with such reckless disregard for the public to know the truth, I kept looking closer. It turns out this PAC has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course). Here **are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037:**

- On **PDC Report # 100956187, attached for staff reference**, this PAC claims to have **spent cash on signs, mailers and door hangers and other misc. things** (we don't need to know how many donuts they got) ,but of course, they failed to report the quantity of signs, mailers, or door hangers. This is an explicit **violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.**
- On **PDC Report # 100964688 , attached for staff reference**, this PAC **claims to have spent \$3,571.21 on a mystery mailing.** Once again, no details provided. How many? This is information this PAC must report to the public, and they chose to conceal it instead. Again, another **clear and obvious violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.**
- On **PDC Report # 100961616 , attached for staff reference**, this PAC again **claims to have spent tens of thousands of dollars on mailers, signs, levy mailers, and billboard signs.** Once again, no details provided. How many? What billboards? Over what timeframe? This is information this PAC must report to the public, and they chose to conceal it instead. Again, another **clear and obvious violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example A and B. All these reports will need to be corrected.**

- **On PDC Report # 100958525 , attached for staff reference,** this PAC basically just riddled the report with classic examples of **violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example A & Example B** by claiming to pay for billboards with no details, printed brochures, mailers, with no legally required details. This whole report needs to be corrected.

I'm sure there are more violations than just this, I know there are, but PDC staff can clearly see where this is going – these guys are not reporting much, skipping a lot of reports they should be filing, if they bother to file anything – they wait months or years to do it. None of the information provided is done in a legal way, and anyone with a basic level of education can realize that you'd be crazy to trust anything these guys have told you. Sometimes some groups just should have their keys taken away and not be allowed to drive the car if all they are going to do is crash it. This crew is in desperate need of a professional treasurer, but I'm not sure they care. They've been getting away with illegal activity like this for years and until this complaint was filed, nobody probably knew. I suspect the people who have to go back and fix these reports will read the law and figure it out so they stop their lawbreaking ways (assuming they can start filing reports on time).

This is one of those bid dollar PACs that should serve as a poster child example for why the PDC can issue \$10,000 fines.

This is a completely messed up, well-funded, secretive PAC that clearly has no intention of following the law and there is zero chance any member of the public can understand what this PAC is doing by looking at the late reports. Even groups like this need to follow the law, or at least pretend like they care about the law. This is a terrible example of egregious lawbreaking by a well-funded group that should know better
