<p>Glen Morgan reported via the portal <i>(Thu, 26 Oct 2023 at 1:17 AM)</i> To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that Jamie Smith, currently a candidate for the Pierce County Council has, once again, violated Washington State’s campaign finance laws (RCW 42.17A). The details are as follows:</p> <p>1) Total failure to file required expenditure or contribution reports (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>Jamie Smith (a candidate who has run for office on 5 separate occasions within the last 8 years) has failed to file any C3 or C4 reports since 8/30/23. She has had two PDC complaints filed against her this election cycle, one of which was resolved with a written warning (See PDC Enforcement Case #139013, warning letter attached for staff reference), and the other an ongoing investigation (See PDC Enforcement Case #141807, original complaint attached for staff reference). Based on these cases, her extensive recent experience in the last 5 campaigns, presumably she is aware of the existence of the PDC and the fact that she has to at least go through some kind of motions to pretend to follow the law.</p> <p>However, even in the middle of the current investigation and despite the “naughty, naughty” letter sent by the PDC recently, this politician refuses to follow the law. At a minimum she was required to file:</p> <p>1) a C4 covering 9/1/23 to 10/16/23 on 10/17/23. 2) a C4 covering 7/25/23 to 8/31/23 on 9/11/23.</p> <p>But she has failed to do so. Likely she failed to file C3s between 8/30/23 and present as well. Who really knows what is happening with this campaign and we are only a few days away from the election.</p> <p>Obviously, in this case warning letters have failed to inspire compliance or even a pretense of compliance by this professional politician.</p> <p>I don’t know what else to say here. The violations continue to be obvious, and while this candidate may be laughing at the impotence of the PDC, I am not sure that this is a great outcome for showcasing what enforcement actually looks like. Without monetary penalties of some kind in this case and probably a subpoena of the bank records here, nobody can possibly know what is happening with this political campaign.</p> <p>Let me know if you need more, but I’m sure she will continue to break the law and I’ll keep the PDC informed.</p> <p>Best Regards,</p> <p>Glen Morgan</p> <p>(For Internal PDC Staff reference – based on my written testimony submitted to the PDC last month, I am counting this as complaint #10 for October)</p>
What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?
The public has a right to know what is happening with a politician's campaign right in the middle of an election cycle. Why isn't Jamie Smith filing the legally required reports? What is she hiding? How many contributions has she received in the last few months? How has she squandered the cash that she has received? Presumably she knows she has to follow the law - in the last 8 years she has run for office as a professional politician 5 times. What is she hiding from the public now?

<p>Glen Morgan reported via the portal (Sat, 26 Aug 2023 at 5:42 PM) To whom it may concern,</p> <p>It has come to my attention that failed legislative candidate Jamie Smith has repeatedly violated Washington State's campaign finance laws every time she has run for the legislature in 2018, 2020, and in 2022 plus the current 2023 campaign for the Pierce County Council. The details are as follows:</p> <p>1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, months, or more to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)</p> <p>First, let's just review the late reporting, which is essentially an effort by this serial failed political candidate to conceal the truth from the public for as long as she believes she can. Even a casual review of this politician's campaigns reveals something is wrong here. It is particularly concerning since many of these reports were actually filed weeks and even months late finally revealing the reported truth about this campaign that was concealed from the public during the campaign itself – many late reports were filed after the election was over.</p> <p>As usual, I try to provide the specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I've attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.</p> <p>A quick note again on how this report is organized. I've organized it by latest report first. You'll note that the latest report filed by this guy was 140 days late which is many months late. There is always something wrong when a candidate is filing many reports months later.</p> <p>I've color coded the most extreme late reports red, as usual, of which there are 27. I've color coded the problematically late orange, and there are 29 of those 14-5 days late. Illegal for sure, but also the vast majority of these problematically late reports were concealing information from the public during the last 21 days before an election – strategically organized to conceal the truth from the public when they are most likely to be looking. Even just these reports alone would justify notice to the PDC, but when combined with the the more egregious volume of super late reporting color coded red in the attached spreadsheets – this is a real concerning pattern of behavior.</p> <p>I've color coded the sloppily late reports yellow, and there are only 9 of those – all 4 days late. If this campaign had just been typically sloppy with their reporting, I wouldn't have filed this complaint. So, it appears that when this politician want to break the law, she just goes for weeks and months and conceals everything from the public. The attached spreadsheet and PDF file of this information should be adequate to verify this allegation. I'm sure every one of these violations has a story behind it – and it would be good to get a complete picture of the stories and yarns she will spin to explain this pattern of troubling illegal behavior.</p> <p>By the way, this extensive and exhaustive list of violations clearly indicates that it is highly likely the reports recently filed and not yet refiled are inaccurate, and it would not a bad idea for PDC staff to subpoena the bank records and see how far off the C4 reports have been when filed on behalf of this politician.</p>

2) Apparent theft of campaign funds, misuse of campaign funds, disappearing campaign funds for likely personal use (Violation of RCW 42.17A.445)

This is one of those violations that should not happen in any real campaign run with even amateur treasurers and unserious candidates. Nobody should be disappearing, losing, or pocketing campaign cash with no explanation. Everyone should take these types of violations seriously. Yet, that is exactly what appears to have happened here, based upon the admittedly, illegally late and very deficient reporting made by this politician.

First, it appears that **approximately \$4,170.19 has vanished**. The last C4 (expenditure report) this campaign filed for their failed 2020 campaign reported they had \$14,502.48 cash on hand (see line 18) (See **PDC Report # 110003777, attached for staff reference**). The first C4 (expenditure report) this campaign filed in 2022 (See **PDC Report # 110113067, attached for staff reference**) claims that they had \$10,332.29 on hand – presumably left over from the failed 2020 campaign. **However, what happened to the missing \$4,170.19? We can only speculate because this campaign hasn't told us. Did the candidate spend it at the local pot shop? Did they take a trip to Mexico? Who knows, but the public needs to know, and this issue should be resolved.**

3) Failure to accurately describe expenses, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)

Once I realized this politician would so egregiously violate the law with such reckless disregard for the public to know the truth, in every single campaign in which she participated and lost, I kept looking closer. It turns out this serial politician has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course). Below **are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037.**

- **On PDC Report # 100882351, attached for staff reference** in addition to being months late (filed in January 2019 – months after the 2018 election was lost) **Every single expenditure was reported was lacking in any of the required details**. Tens of thousands of dollars in expenditures for "online" (presumably online advertising) – no details about how many ads, over what timeframe, where they ran, etc. Zero legally required information. Plus printing, postcards, etc. No details provided. **This is a textbook example of a total violation of WAC 390-16-037, example A and example B**, plus hiding the truth for months.
- **On PDC Report # 100882347, attached for staff reference** in addition to being many months late (filed in January 2019 – again, months after the 2018 election was lost). This politician claims they spent \$2,143.50 on "signs" but **no legally required details** about how many signs they purchased, assuming anything else on this report is accurate. **Another explicit violation of WAC 390-16-037, Example B.**
- **On PDC Report # 100882352, attached for staff reference**, again months late and no details for almost anything. For example, this politician claims they spent thousands of dollars described as "online" presumably on online ads, but again, no details, how many ads? Which platforms? How many impressions? Over what timeframe? All details concealed from the public. Also, \$3,000 was reportedly given to vendor "Keanan Taute" for "service." What type of service? Was it payment for stealing her opponents yard signs? For hacking her opponents Facebook Page? What type of "service." More details are legally required for this type of transaction. Same with over a thousand dollars of late reported expenditures to a vendor called "Toskr" in Oakland, California. What were these payments for? PI work digging up dirt on political opponents? Zero description provided – despite the legal requirement to do so. Also, this candidate claims that they paid themselves \$288.99 for "supplies" but never identified where these supplies came from (what was the original source – the real vendor), what

type of supplies are we talking about here (magazine subscriptions? Beer for the road? Box cutters to deface her opponents campaign signs? What was it. Again, **this entire report reads like a classic violation of WAC 390-16-037.**

- **On PDC Report # 100882350, attached for staff reference**, again months late after the election was over and again, almost every single expenditure lacking in the basic required details mandated by law – “printing” and “advertising” are **perfect examples of violations of WAC 390-16-037 both example A & B.**

There appear to be many similar violations like the ones I have detailed above throughout the campaigns this politician has fumbled through over the past few years.

I was about to file an additional allegation about the apparent illegal transfer of funds between the 2022 failed state legislature race to the current 2023 campaign for Pierce County Council, but I realized the PDC is already looking into this campaign for that specific allegation (See **PDC Enforcement Case #139013**, based on a complaint filed last month by Robert Parker). So, I will ignore that allegation because it appears there is some effort to address that issue currently underway.

My additional allegations might be worth addressing under the same Enforcement Case action just for PDC staff efficiency, or due to the length of time between the original complaints in this case, staff may choose to treat this one as an independent complaint. Regardless of which choice PDC staff take, I'll be available to provide more details if it is necessary.

As noted in the letter to Mr. Parker, the PDC has dismissed this matter following RCW 42.17A.755(1) and will not conduct a more formal investigation into these allegations or take further enforcement action in this matter.

However, per WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), this serves as a formal written warning concerning RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), showing contributions and expenditures undertaken by the 2023 Campaign and failure to accurately transfer funds between the 2022 Campaign and the 2023 Campaign per RCW 42.17A.490. Staff expects you to provide better oversight of campaign staff, specifically supervision of the campaign Treasurer, and moving forward accurate and timely reporting of contributions and expenditures in the ORCA system will occur. If violations of PDC laws or rules occur in the future, the Commission will consider this formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action.

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review and assessment of the complaint you filed on June 10, 2023. The complaint alleged that Jamie Smith, a candidate for Pierce County Council, may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), showing contributions and expenditures undertaken by the 2023 Campaign and transfer of funds between the 2022 Campaign and the 2023 Campaign.

PDC staff reviewed the allegation(s); the applicable statutes, rules, and reporting requirements; the response(s) provided by the Respondent; the applicable PDC reports filed by the Respondent; the Respondent's data in the PDC contribution and expenditure database; and other relevant information, to decide whether the record supports a finding of one or more violations.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- Jamie Smith has been a candidate of multiple campaigns for State Representative of the 25th Legislative District including the years 2016, 2018, 2020 and 2022. Between the years 2018 to 2020, and 2020 to 2022 Ms. Smith's campaigns had surplus funds and transferred those funds from year to year per RCW 42.17A.430.
 - A second complaint against the Respondent, filed in September 2023, about issues related to campaign reporting for 2018, 2020 and 2022 will be addressed under case #141807.
 - Prior to this case review, and related to this complaint, between the 2020 and 2022 campaigns, a required C4 showing the carry forward of surplus funds was unreported. On August 29, 2023, the Respondent filed C4 #110168824 reporting \$10,332.29 paid on May 15, 2022, from the 2020 to the 2022 campaign. This report was fourteen months late.
 - C3 reports identifying who the contributors from the 2020 campaign to the 2022 campaigns are not required because the transfer was between two campaigns for the same office.

- Jamie Smith is currently a candidate in the 2023 election year and is running for a different office than attempted in her past campaigns. Per PDC Interpretation No. 23.01, the transfer of funds between the 2022 campaign and the 2023 campaign is subject to RCW 42.17A.490.
 - Prior to this case review, the campaign had failed to file required C4 and C3 reports accurately showing the transfer of funds from the 2022 campaign to the 2023 campaign, and they had also failed to get permission from the contributors to transfer the funds between the two campaigns for different office.
 - In the 2022 reporting, C4 #110168194 filed on August 25, 2023, showed a transfer of \$600 from the 2022 campaign to the 2023 campaign, paid on May 18, 2023. This report was two months late.
 - In the 2022 reporting, C4 #110168195 filed on August 25, 2023, showed a transfer of \$1,530 from the 2022 campaign to the 2023 campaign, paid on June 5, 2023. This report was one month late.
 - In the 2023 reporting, C3 #110164537 filed August 7, 2023, for period 5/18/23-5/18/23, amended by C3 #110168823 filed August 29, 2023, reported the \$600 transfer from 2022 campaign to the 2023 campaign and corresponds to C4 #110168194. This report was two months late. In this instance the campaign transferred funds before they had permission from the contributor to transfer between the two campaigns for different office. The campaign has since received permission from the contributors and provided the PDC with copies of those permissions.
 - In the 2023 reporting, C4 #110150194 filed on June 5, 2023, for period 5/18/23-5/31/23 incorrectly showed carry forward from the earlier campaign of \$11,900. The amended C4 #110168155 filed on August 24, 2023, shows no carryforward but rather cash received of \$600 as reported in C4 #110168823 for the 2022 campaign transfer. The C4 also shows an in-kind expenditure by the candidate for filing fees paid on May 18, 2023, and website domain costs paid on May 31, 2023, that were previously unreported. This unreported information was two months late.
 - In the 2023 reporting, C3 #110163925 filed on August 4, 2023, for period 6/5/23-6/5/23, amended by C3 #110169004 filed on August 30, 2023, shows \$1,530 received, as reported in C4 #110168195 for the 2022 campaign transfer. This report was two months late. In this instance the campaign transferred funds before they had permission from the contributor to transfer between the two campaigns for different office. The campaign has since received permission from the contributor and provided the PDC with copies of the permission.
 - In the 2023 reporting, C4 #110157600 filed July 10, 2023, for period 6/1/20-7/10/23, incorrectly showed 2022 carryforward but C4 #110168154 filed August 24, 2023, fixed the carryforward issue.
- The Respondent does not have other similar warnings or violations of PDC requirements.

The campaign Treasurer stated that a lack of experience, and not an attempt to be dishonest, is the cause of the errors and late reporting. The campaign incorrectly assumed the remaining

balance of the 2022 campaign account was theirs to access and proceeded to get permission from the 25th Legislative District (LD), as the largest contributor in total across the multiple campaigns, to transfer \$11,900 of the remaining funds from the 2022 to the 2023 campaign. The LD approved the transfer of funds and the campaign provided proof of that approval; unfortunately, this transfer did not follow PDC guidance of first-in, first-out accounting which requires the contributions received latest in the year for 2022, and then those in 2020 if necessary, to be used and those contributors were the entities the campaign actually needed permission from in order to use the previously contributed funds in the 2023 campaign. The campaign has worked effectively with PDC staff to better understand what is and is not allowed regarding the transfer of surplus funds and the Treasurer has been diligent in working with PDC filer assistance staff to correct reports across multiple campaigns. It is also worth noting the current Treasurer is working to correct reporting for prior campaigns that she was not the original Treasurer.

Based on our case review staff has determined that, in this instance, failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), showing contributions and expenditures undertaken by the 2023 Campaign and transfer of funds between the 2022 Campaign and the 2023 Campaign, does not amount to a finding of a violation that calls for further investigation.

Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), however, Jamie Smith will receive a formal written warning concerning RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failure to timely and accurately file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports), showing contributions and expenditures undertaken by the 2023 Campaign and failure to accurately transfer funds between the 2022 Campaign and the 2023 Campaign per RCW 42.17A.490. The formal written warning will include staff's expectation that Jamie Smith provide better oversight of campaign staff, specifically supervision of the campaign Treasurer, and moving forward accurate and timely reporting of contributions and expenditures in the ORCA system will occur. If violations of PDC laws or rules occur in the future, the Commission will consider this formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action necessary and has dismissed this matter per RCW 42.17A.755(1).
