ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration was considered by the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission (PDC, Commission) on December 12, 2024, by in-person, telephonic, and online streaming access. The hearing was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and 42.17A RCW, and Chapter 390-37 WAC.

Commissioners present in-person or online were Allen Hayward, Commission Chair, J. Robert Leach (Commission Vice-Chair, presiding), and Commissioners Nancy Isserlis, Douglass North, and James Oswald. Also present online were Assistant Attorney General John S. Meader representing the Commission, and Assistant Attorney General Susie Giles-Klein, representing PDC Staff. Attorney Joel Ard, appeared in-person representing the Washington State Republican Party. Notice of the hearing was provided to both parties and each appeared through counsel. The proceeding was open to the public and recorded.

The PDC's Final Order was served on October 29, 2024. Respondent's Motion for

1	Reconsideration was received by the PDC on November 9, 2024. The PDC filed its response on
2	December 5, 2024, and the Respondent filed a reply on December 9, 2024. Argument from
3	Counsel was provided at the December 12, 2024, hearing for the Commission's consideration.
4	Pursuant to WAC 390-37-100(3)(c) the Commission has the authority to rule on procedural
5	matters, objections, and motions.

7	I. ORDER
8	The Motion for Reconsideration is DENIED. The Respondent has not met any of the
9	limited criteria under WAC 390-37-150(4) to allow for reconsideration of the
10	Commission's Final Order. The Commission's Order issued October 29, 2024, remains
11 12	the Final Order.
