In response to Case Number 147918, we recognize that the 21-day pre-election C4 was not filed by the required deadline. In addition, timely C3 reports were not filed. Our campaign committee has had a significant change in leadership recently and no one, unfortunately, had any experience in PDC reporting. It took some time to learn the registration and report filing process.

However, we are making every effort to have reports filed in a timely manner going forward in order to ensure that we are accountable to the public. Thank you for sending the 2024 Special Election Key Reporting Dates for our reference.

You will see both C3 and C4 reports have been filed and the next reports were due on February 6. These reports account for all contributions and expenditures to date. The required reports were filed on February 5, prior to the deadline.

We appreciate the concern of voters wanting to analyze expenditures to ensure they are being spent according to state law.

Please let us know if there are any other reports necessary to ensure that we are in compliance with the Public Disclosure Commission, as our goal is to be transparent with our voters.
