2017, Mr. Merkel did not win his bid, but he was under the obligation to file accurate reports.

- 1. There isn't any 7 Day Pre-Primary Report.
- 2. There isn't any Post-Primary Report where he should have closed the campaign since he didn't win in the primary.
- 3. There is a negative balance remaining of \$4,986.00 which is important later.
- 4. The campaign was not closed out.

2019, Mr. Merkel did not win his bid for a council seat.

- 1. No carryover of the negative balance from 2017.
- 2. No C4's were filed.
- 3. No 21 Day Pre-Primary was filed.
- 4. No 7 Day Pre-Primary was filed.
- 5. No Post Primary was filed whereby he should have closed his campaign since he did not win the primary.
- 6. Receipts totaled \$610.76 which should have reduced the 2017 negative balance of \$4,986 should he carryover the negative balance which he did not.
