I am reporting a violation of RCW 42.17A.320 for failure to include sponsor ID on Council member George Hurst's campaign for Mayor in the November 7th election. On October 20th, I received a packet of door hangers on my door. It included a flyer for George Hurst which did not state a source id. The other flyers included in the packet did include source ids that I have included below.

-Van AuBuchon Paid for by Citizens for Vote Van

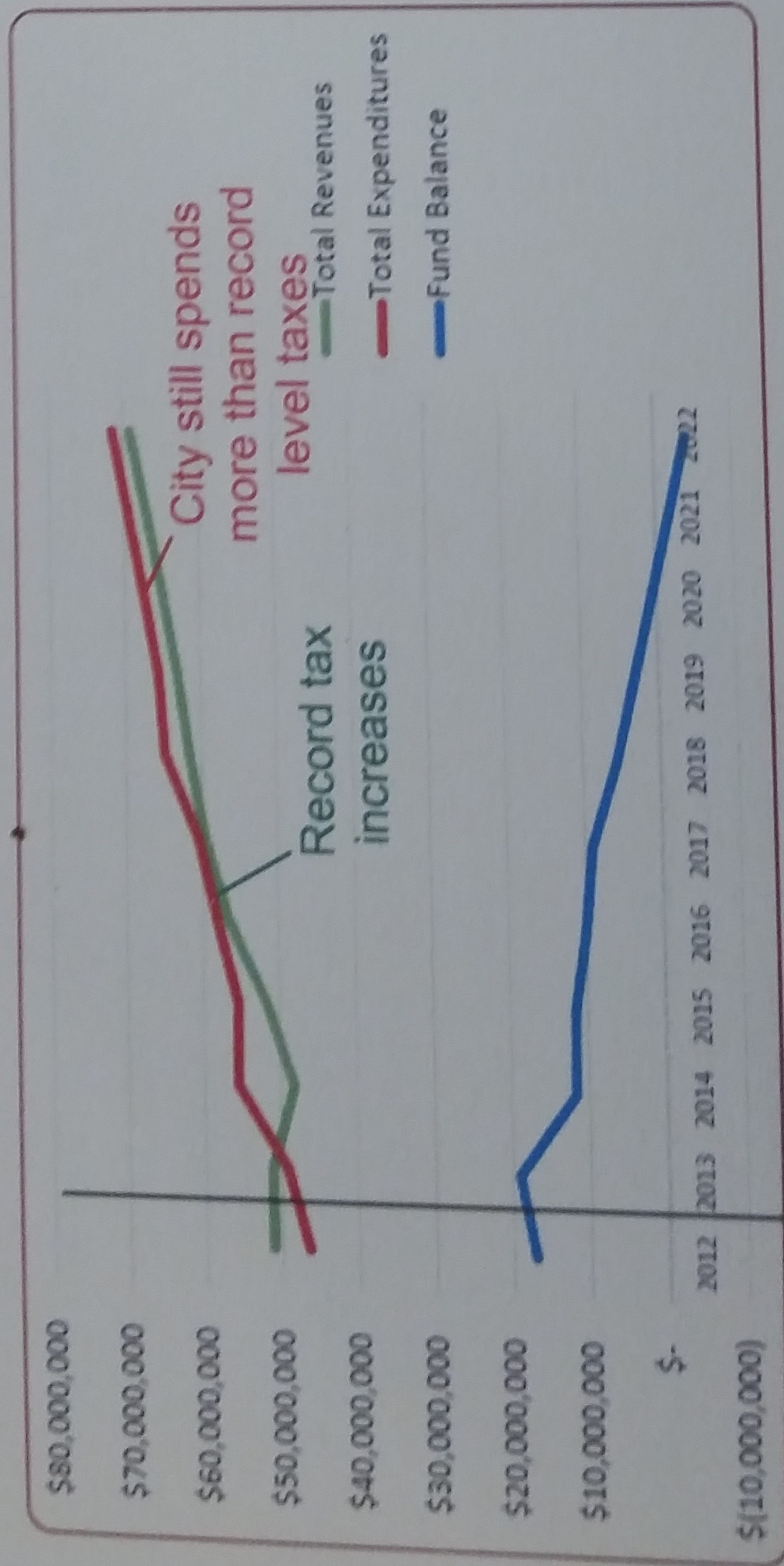

All the material appears to be printed by the same source. This source also appears to be the press for Lynnwood News and Views. I request a case to investigate if the funding for George Hurst door hangers were reported.

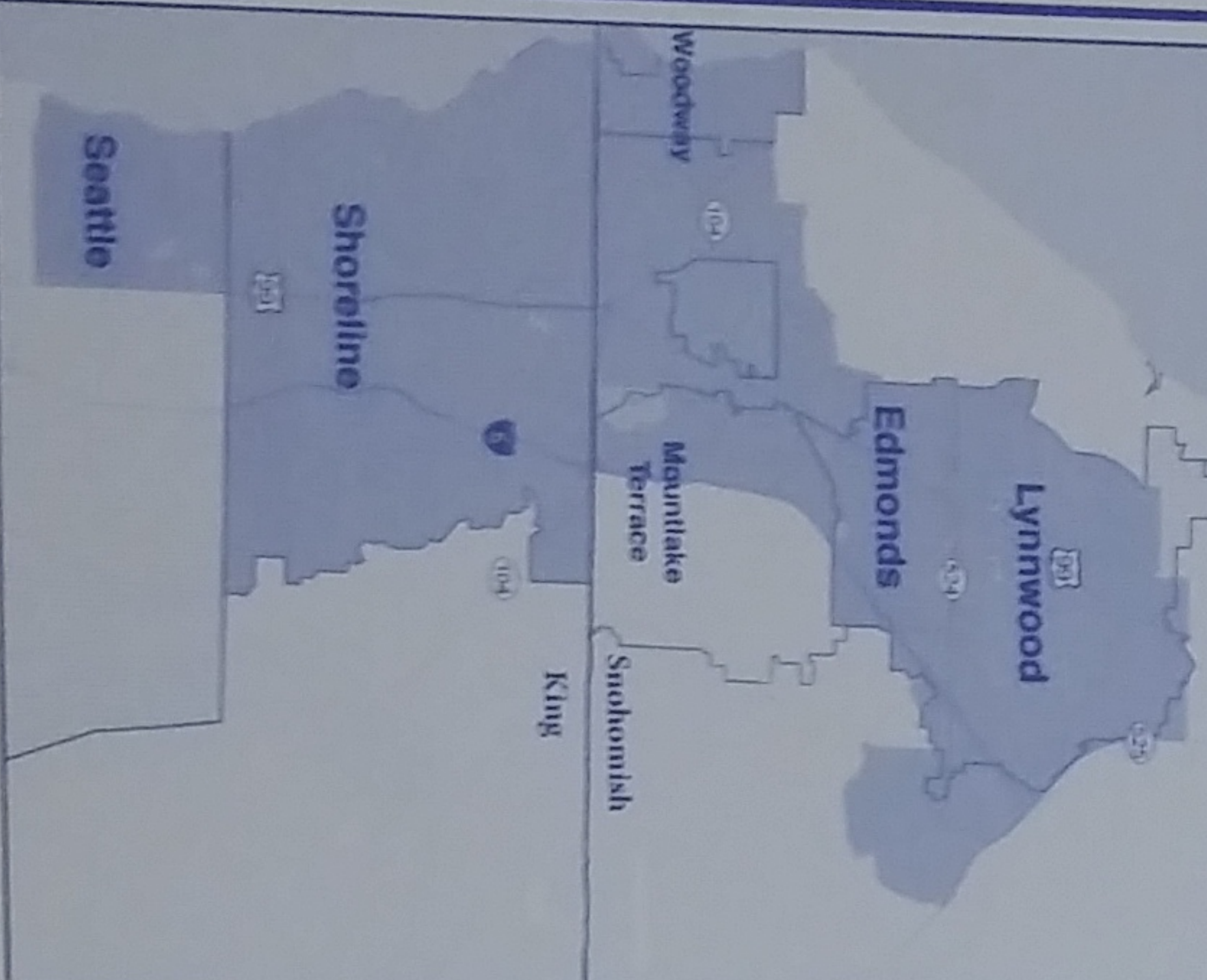

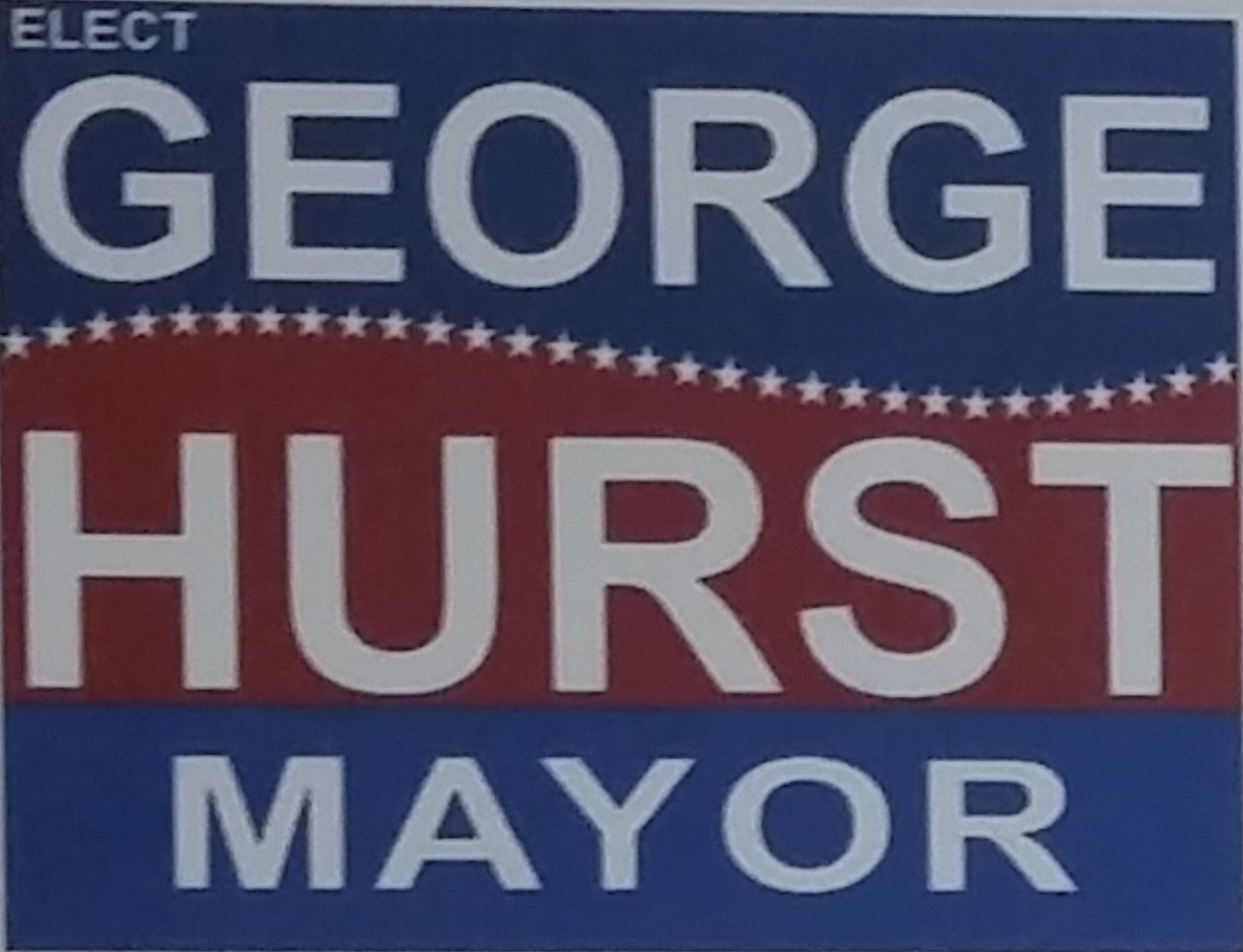

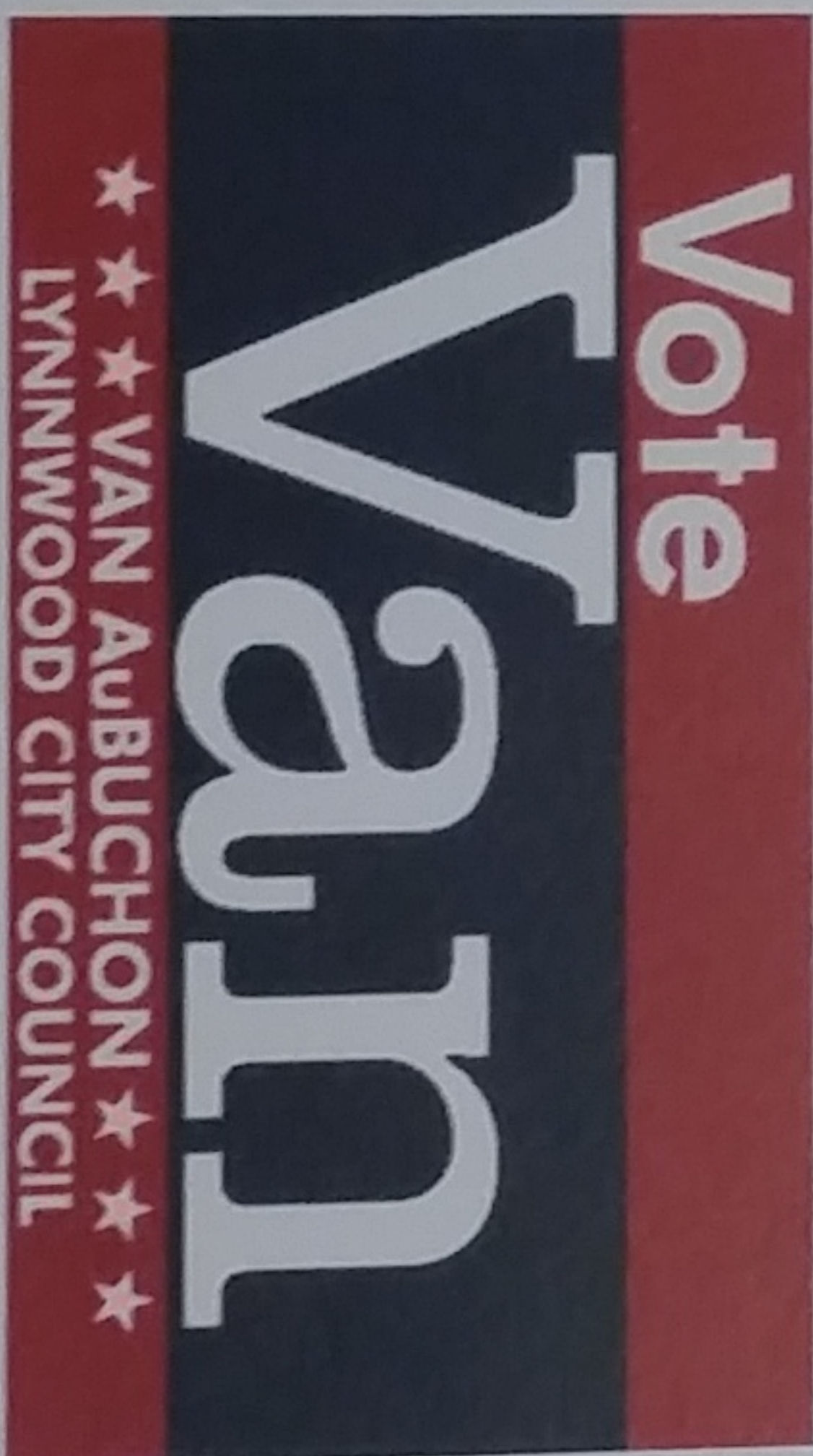
