<p><u>Joann E Law</u> reported via the portal (Fri, 10 May 2024 at 3:00 PM)</p> <p>Mr. Boudreau knowingly and willfully accepted a gift of \$200.00 for Longview Centennial Gala Tickets on or about 08/01/2023. The gift came from an unknown and undisclosed donor. The gift amount exceeds the \$50.00 limit imposed by RCW 42.52.150. Mr. Boudreau willfully neglected and failed to report the gift on his 2024 F1 financial disclosure filed with the PDC on 03/18/2024 in violation of RCW 42.17A.700 (6). Mr. Boudreau knowingly made a false report in violation of RCW 42.20.040 and violated RCW 42.20.100 by willfully neglecting to perform a duty to accurately disclose this financial gift.</p>
What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?
<p>The respondent has accepted a large gift from an unknown source. The public is injured. The people have the right to expect from their elected representatives at all levels of government the utmost of integrity, honesty, and fairness in their dealings. The people shall be assured that the private financial dealings of their public officials, and of candidates for those offices, present no conflict of interest between the public trust and private interest. Our representative form of government is founded on a belief that those entrusted with the offices of government have nothing to fear from full public disclosure of their financial and business holdings, provided those officials deal honestly and fairly with the people. Public confidence in government at all levels is essential and must be promoted by all possible means. Public confidence in government at all levels can best be sustained by assuring the people of the impartiality and honesty of the officials in all public transactions and decisions. The public's right to know of the financing of political campaigns and lobbying and the financial affairs of elected officials and candidates far outweighs any right that these matters remain secret and private. Mindful of the right of individuals to privacy and of the desirability of the efficient administration of government, full access to information concerning the conduct of government on every level must be assured as a fundamental and necessary precondition to the sound governance of a free society.</p>
